Please note the new abbreviations for the pattern descriptions

- 2 R Knit 2 rows
- 4 R Knit 4 rows
- 1  Racking handle one full turn to the right
- 2  Racking handle two full turns to the right
- 1  Racking handle one full turn to the left
-  Transfer stitches from back to front
-  Transfer stitches from front to back

Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i. e. first knit one part according to diagram (increasing or decreasing at right), then the second part the opposite way (decreasing or increasing at left).

Abbreviations:

- = tubular (or) = half tubular
- = every (in every row)
- X = times
- + = increase
- = decrease, cast off
- ▲ = graduations (short rows)

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

First increase or decrease always occurs in the first row of a section.

- + 3 × 2 · 8 · R means: increase 2 stitches 3 times in every 8th row (1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front).
- 19 × 3 · 7 · R means: decrease 3 stitches 19 times in every 7th row (back 2 stitches, front 1 stitch or vice versa).
- 17 × 1 · 2 / 3 · R means: decrease 1 stitch 17 times, alternately once after 2 rows and once after 3 rows.
- ▲ - 4 × 8 · 2 · R means: work graduations, i. e. short rows (on DUO with pushers and lock BX). Step by step put 8 nds (and their respective pushers) into Rest Position 4 times after every 2nd row (for double bed 4 nds each back and front). Once all graduations are finished, continue knitting normally, i. e. all nds in Working Position (pushers in Neutral Position).

Graduations can be knitted two ways, either from outer edge towards centre (gradual decreasing with the minus-sign "-" after the black triangle) or from the centre towards outer edge (gradual increasing with the plus-sign "+" after the black triangle.)

Number of stitches and centimetres :

- 136 = 20cm means: a total of 136 sts (for K/K 68 stitches each on back and front) make a width of 20 cm.
- 146 = 43cm means: cast on 146 sts each on back and front bed for tubular which makes a width of 43 cm.

Stitch size: These indications are only recommended by us. They must always be tested by you, by making your own test square for your own wool.

IF YOU KNIT WITH THE FORM COMPUTER

Enter the measurements of your test square as follows :

- A Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of your test square
- B Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 sts of your test square
- C Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of the band. Note :
It is possible for 'C' to appear twice in a programme, in which case the same measurement has to be entered twice.

Flashing figures :

For the flashing figures 1 to 5 you will no longer find separate explanations in the descriptions. What has to be done when these flashing figures appear, you have to look up in the general explanations which you should in any case study carefully before you start to knit.

The general meaning of the flashing figures is as follows :

- 1 Cast-on over the indicated number of needles on the front bed.
- 2 Transfer from band to pattern.
- 3 Divide work into two equal halves for neck opening.
- 4 End of first shoulder, to knit second shoulder press key GO.
- 5 End of knitting.

For many garments you will find for the neck or armhole band, or even front bands for a jacket, the remark :

"Use the programme for straight knitted band", which is the following programme :

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always enter the same measurement in both places.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

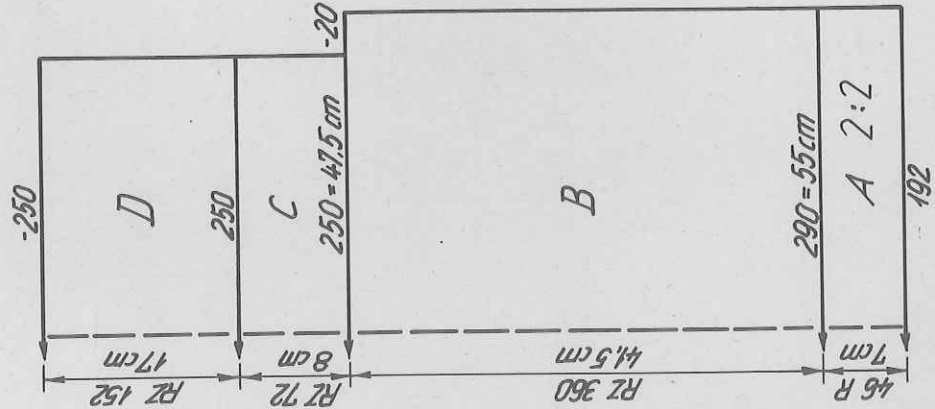

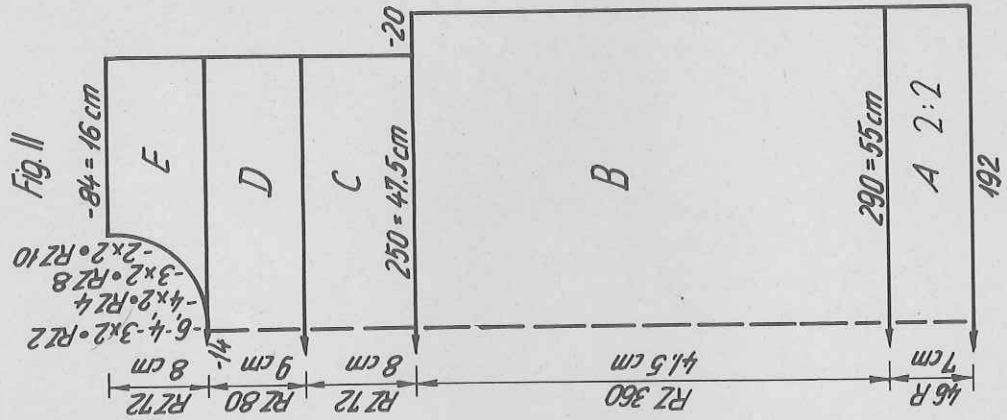

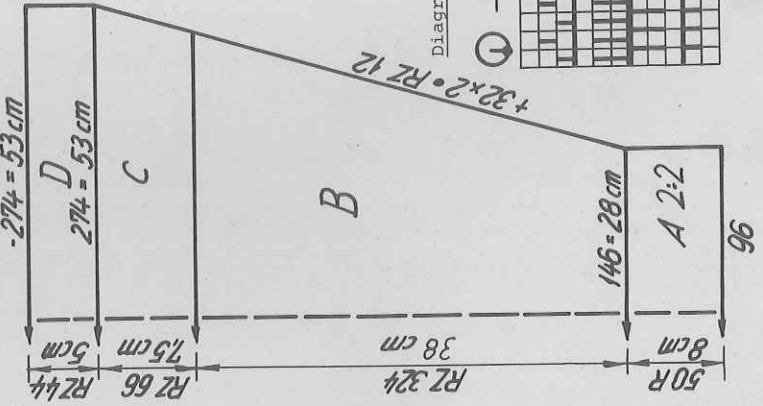

Neckband:
Tubular cast on für 2:2 rib with 148 sts over a width of 111 nds, knit 38 R, a few rows with contrast yarn, release.

To make up:
Pin out parts to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Join shoulder seams. Attach neckband to outer neck edge, st by st, with backstitch. Join short edge of neckband with mattress stitch. Attach on inside. With right sides facing, sew sleeves to front and back. Join side seams. Fold waist and sleeve bands in half to inside and hem into place.

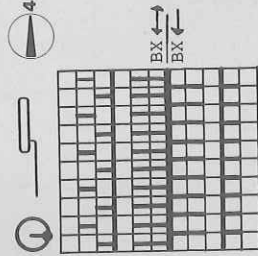

Join right shoulder seam up to beginning of collar. Neaten buttonholes, sew on buttons. Sew on sleeve bands, st by st, backstitching through open loops, and unravelling contr. yarn. To make up:

Pin out parts to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew sleeves to front and back, join shoulder seams. Sew neckband to outer neck edge, st by st, with backstitch, unravelling contrast yarn. Attach on inside.

Attach waist band and sleeve borders, st by st, with backstitch, unravelling contrast yarn. Join side seams.

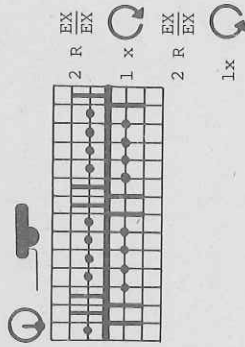

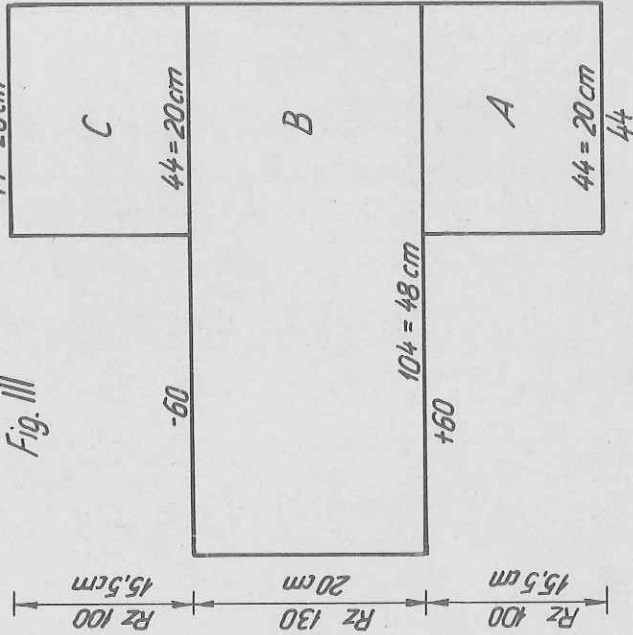

Put yarn into the following non-working nd, bring 2 pushers at right into WP, knit 1 row, put yarn into the right non-knitting nd, cont. in this way until you have reached the whole width.

Fig. II : Front

As for Fig. I, but using col 4 instead of col 1.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two parts with reversed shapings. A = (cast on at right of needle bed), tubular cast on for K/K, cont. to knit in Fisherman's rib. B = inc. at left, i.e. place the sts of an old test square on the nds of the machine, cont. to knit straight. C = dec. at left, cont. to knit straight. Cast off loosely.
Welt : Tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 148 sts over a width of 111 nds, knit 48 rows. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release. Knit 2 parts.
Neckband : Knit 2 parts. Tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 86 sts over a width of 64 nds, knit 20 rows. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Stocking stitch parts with wrong side out, pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Join neckband to short edge of sleeve, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, first to outside then to inside. With right sides facing, sew sleeves to front and back parts and 2 cms along the neck facing. Sew on welt, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Join side seams. Fold neck facing to inside and slip stitch in position.

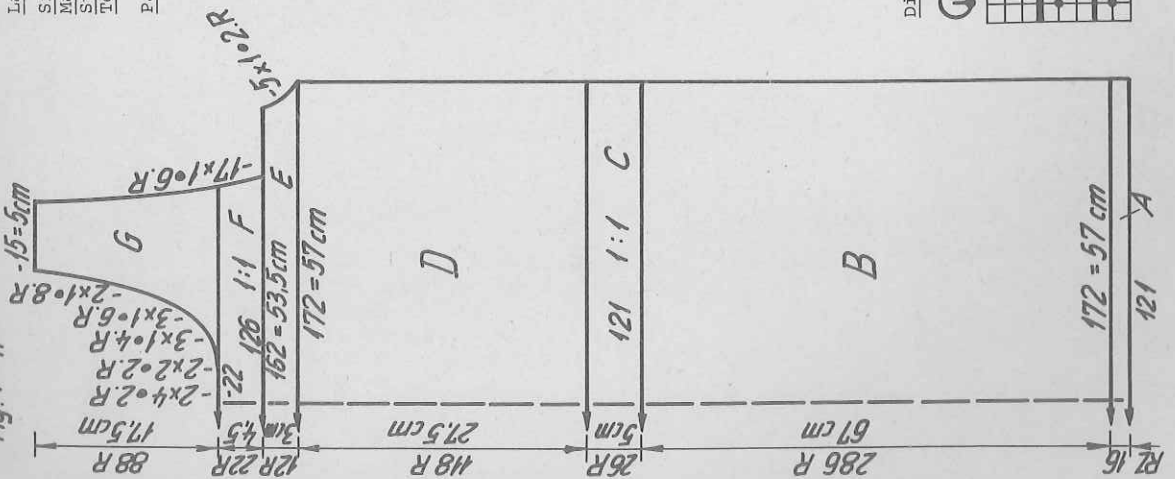

Belt : Cast on for tubular, 11 sts at front, 9 sts at back, Lock front CX, back N. Knit approx. 160 cms. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

Belt loops : Knit 6 times
Cast on for tubular, 4 sts at front, 3 sts at back, Lock front CX, back N. Knit RC 28. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Graft shoulder seams. Bind neck edge and armhole with binding, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, then sew to inside. Join side seams. Attach belt loops at regular intervals around waist.

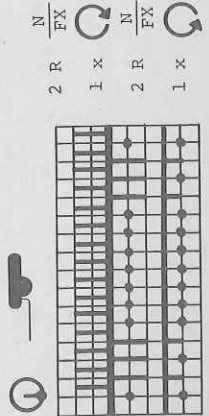

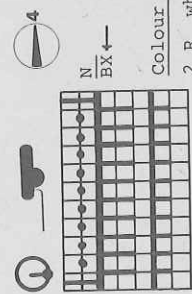

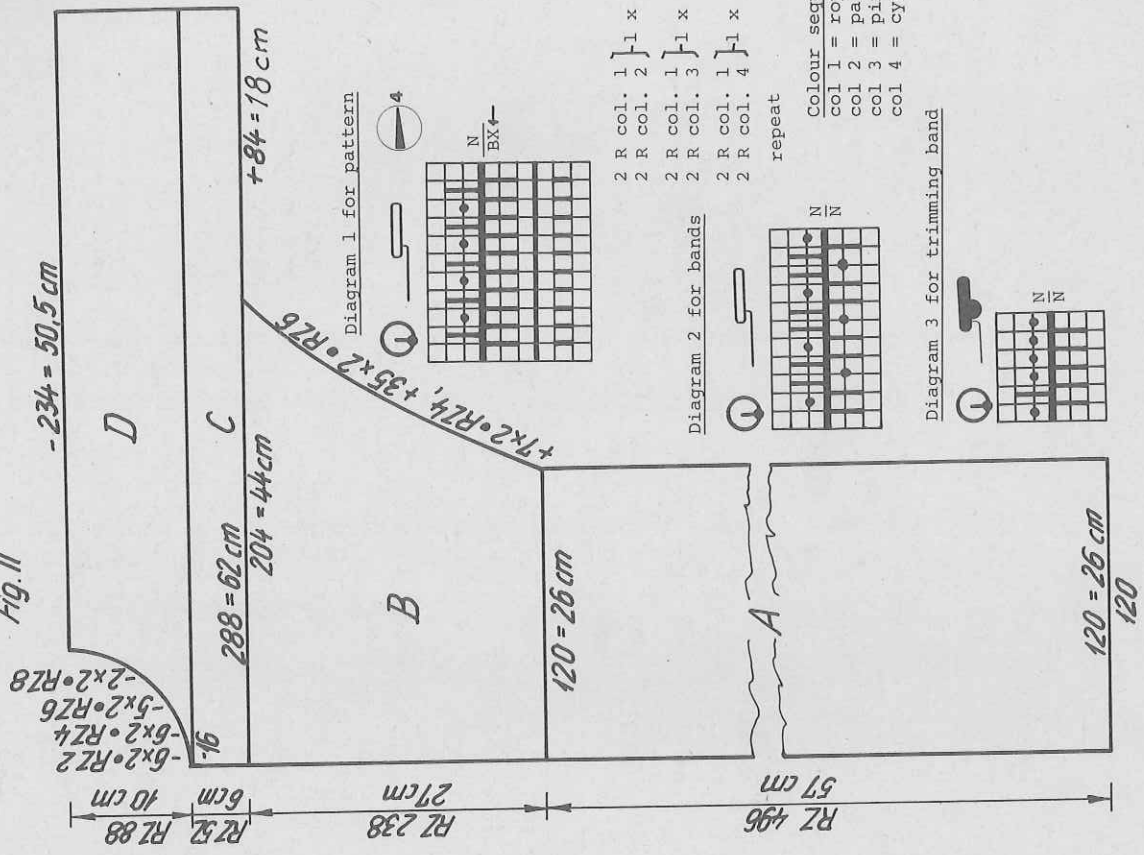
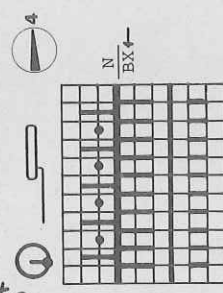


Diagram 1 for pattern

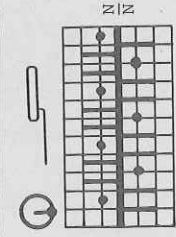

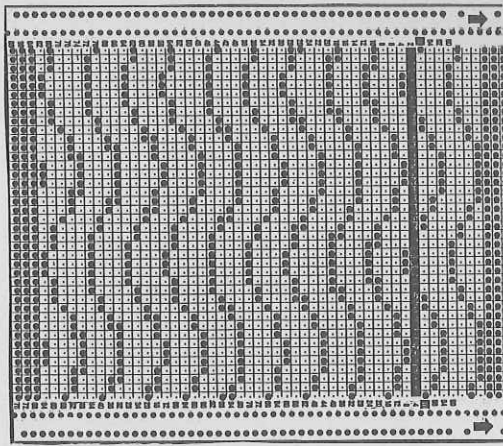
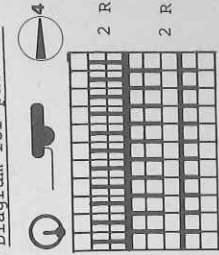


Diagram for pattern

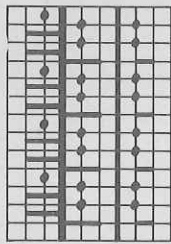
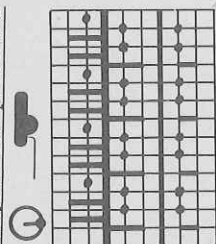


Diagram for pattern 2
