**Patterns:** The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

**Stitches** are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

**Exception:** For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively ( or ) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

### IF YOU KNIT WITH THE FORM COMPUTER

Enter the measurements of your test square as follows :

- A Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of your test square  
 B Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 sts of your test square  
 C Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of the band. Note :  
 It is possible for 'C' to appear twice in a programme, in which case the same measurement has to be entered twice.

#### Flashing figures :

The general meaning of the flashing figures is as follows :

- 1 Cast on over the indicated number of needles on the front bed.
- 2 Transfer from band to pattern.
- 3 Divide work into two equal halves for neck opening.
- 4 End of first shoulder, to knit second shoulder press key GO.
- 5 End of knitting.

If there is no programme for neck or armhole band, or front bands of a jacket, then use the following programme for "straight knitted band" :

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always enter the same measurement in both places.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

 Test square : 100 sts = 40 cm, 100 R = 28 cm  
 Pattern : Back = stocking st. Front = cable : acc. to nd-diagram.  
 Welt = 1:1 rib. Armhole band = K/K. Neckband = tubular.

**Binding :** Burgundy, beginning with contrast yarn.  
 Open cast on for half tubular. Knit RC 18, then RC 2 with St.S 5/2, RC 18 with St.S 5. End with a few rows contrast yarn, release. For front edge : knit twice with 106 sts each time. Armhole : knit twice with 140 sts each time. Collar : knit once with 156 sts.

**To make up :** Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew shoulder seam. Fold collar in half, sew binding to outside edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, attach on inside. Sew collar to neck edge as far as 6 cms from front edge. With right sides facing sew lapel to neck edge. Bind armhole as shown in photo, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, first on outside then on inside. In the same way, bind front edge, sewing lapel in one single operation. Attach sleeve to main part sewing along the same stitch row as binding. Sew side seams. Neaten buttonholes. Attach buttons.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Join first shoulder seam. Sew neckband to outside neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew into position on inside. Join second shoulder seam. Sew on sleeve, making seam 5 cm from sleeve edge which will make the edge roll to the outside. Join side seams.

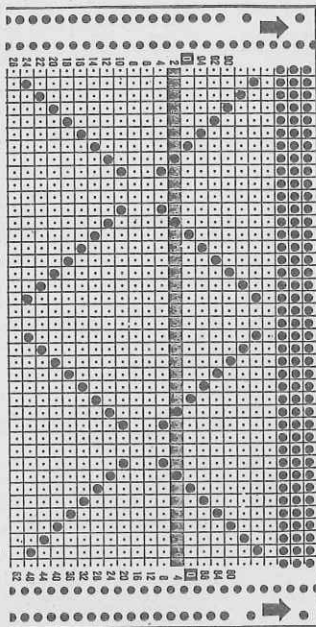
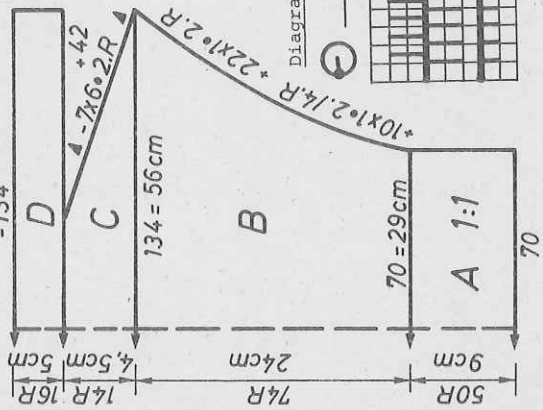
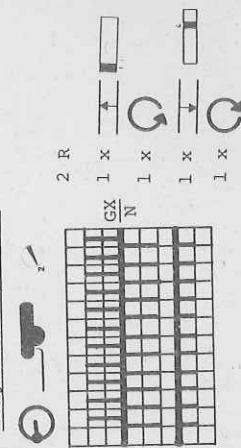

 Pattern 2 = 100 sts (back) = 39 cm, RC 100 = 20 cm  
**Pattern:** Pattern 1 + 2 acc. to needle diagram 1 + 2. Bands = 1:1 rib. Silky binding = half tubular.

**Fig. Ia : Front and back part**

A = tubular cast on, 6 R Lock CX for K/K, col 1. Transfer sts to back bed, knit acc. to nd-diagram 1 and col. sequence, inc. at each end. B = inc. at each end. C = dec. at right, inc. at left. D = dec. at right. Knit E, F, G, H in reverse order and shapings, knitting 2 R less at the end, then knitting 4 R st.st. on back bed. Cast off loosely.

**Fig. Ib : Front and back part**

A = tubular cast on, 6 R Lock CX for K/K, col 1. Transfer sts to back bed, cont. to knit acc. to nd-diagram 1 and col. sequence, inc. at right, dec. at left. B = inc. at right, dec. at left. C = inc. at right, dec. at left. D = dec. at left. Knit E, F, G, H in reverse order and with reversed shapings, at the end knit 2 R less, then knit 4 R st.st. on back bed. Cast off loosely.

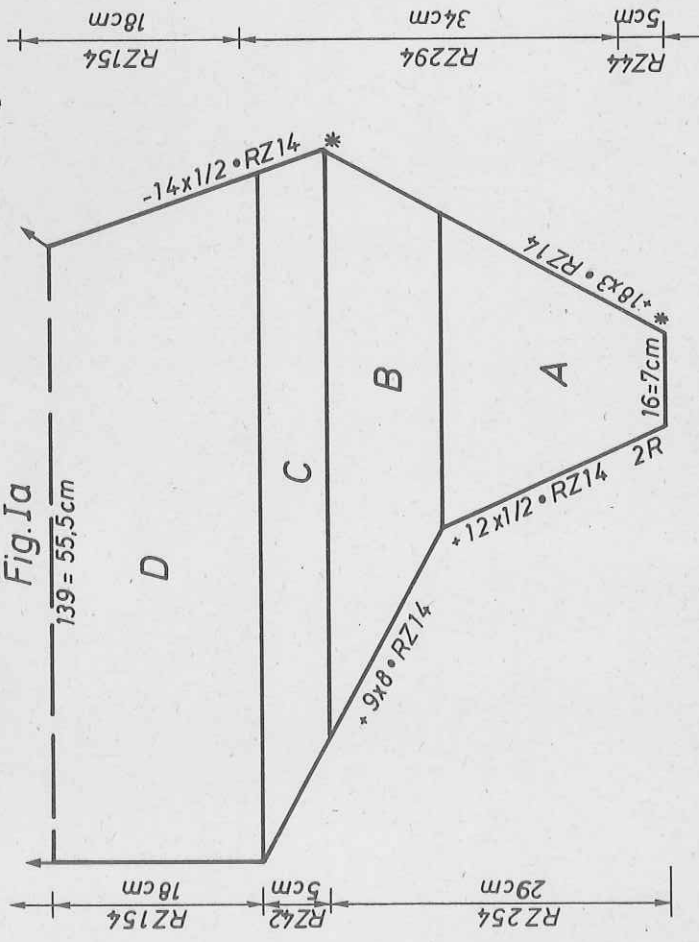
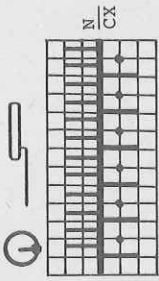
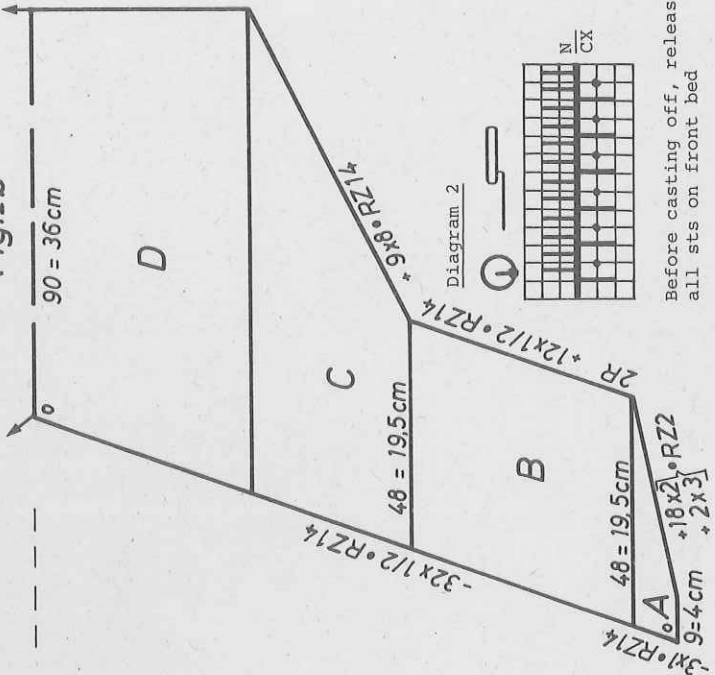

**To make up :** Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Join panels. Mattress stitch together silky binding, then bind diagonal panels with binding, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew binding in place on inside. Bind neck opening (Fig. Ia) in the same way. Pin diagonal panel to Fig. Ia + Ib, make sure that both sides of the neck opening have the same length, loosely sew to back of binding (with backstitch). Sew welt and sleeve bands in place, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Sew side seams.

Sew button/buttonhole band to front edges, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, then sew loosely to inside. Neaten buttonholes. Sew side seams. Sew sleeve seam leaving 5 cms open at the top. With right sides facing, set in sleeves, matching armhole and open top part of sleeve. Attach buttons.

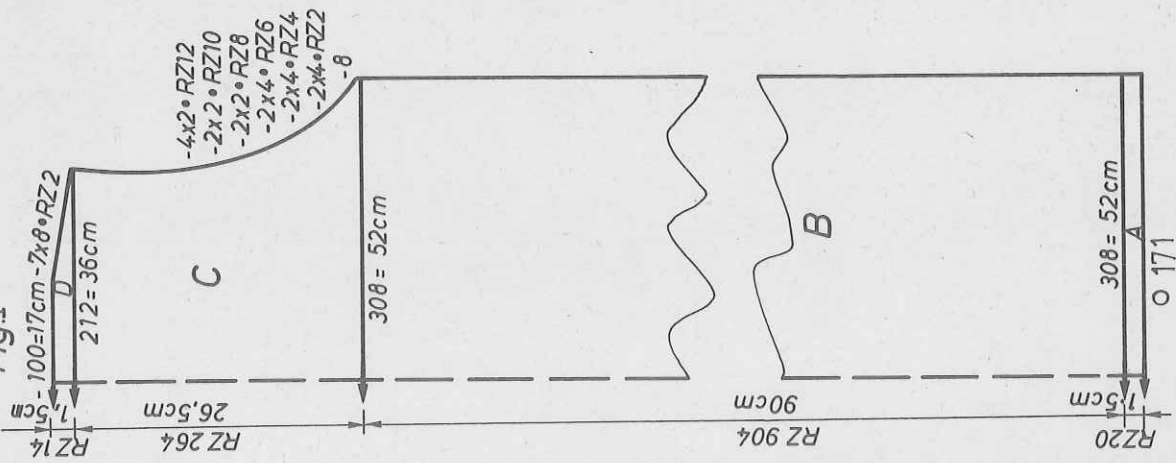

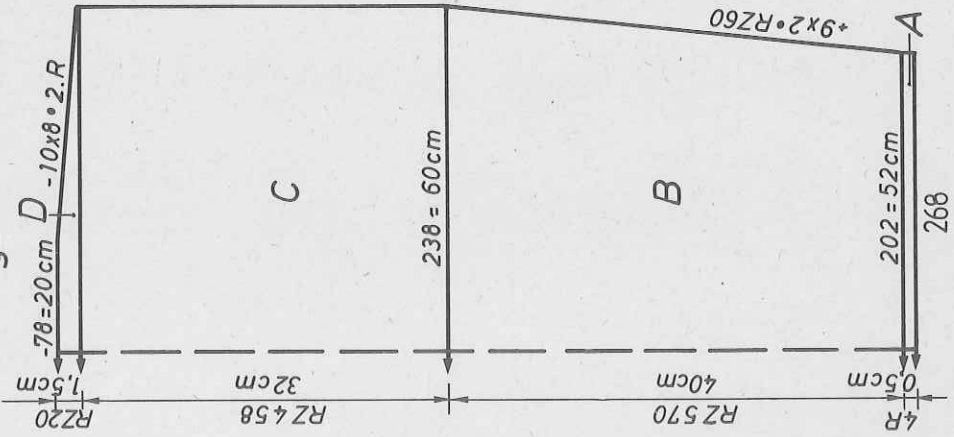

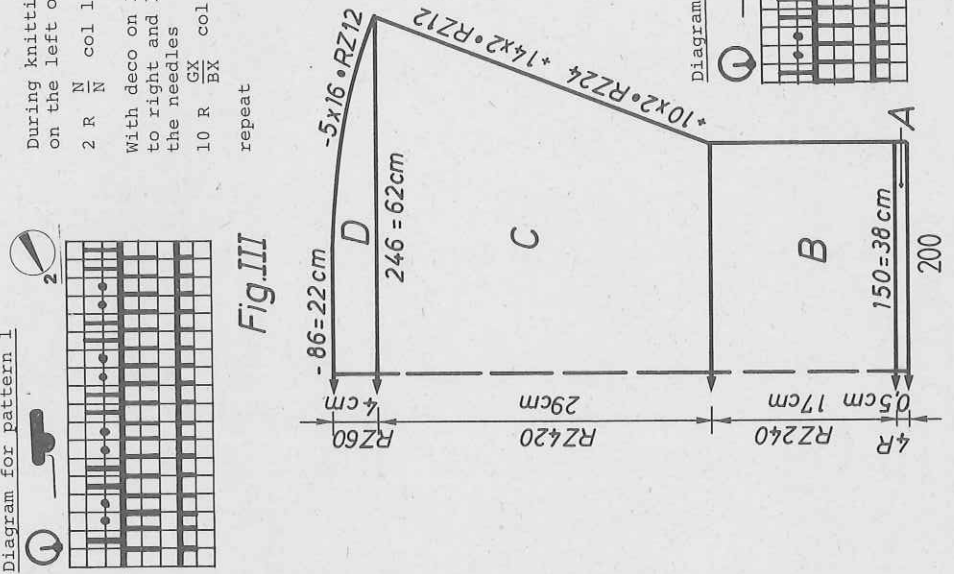

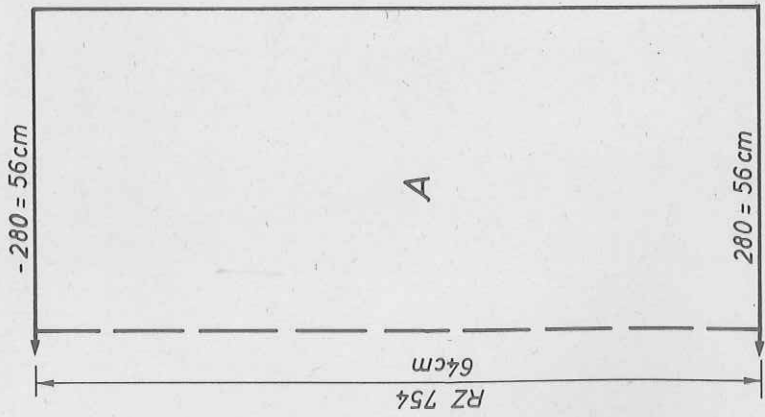

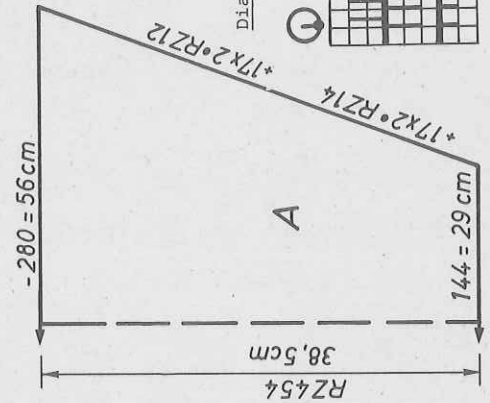
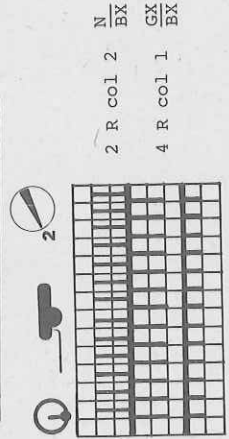


Diagram for embossed pattern

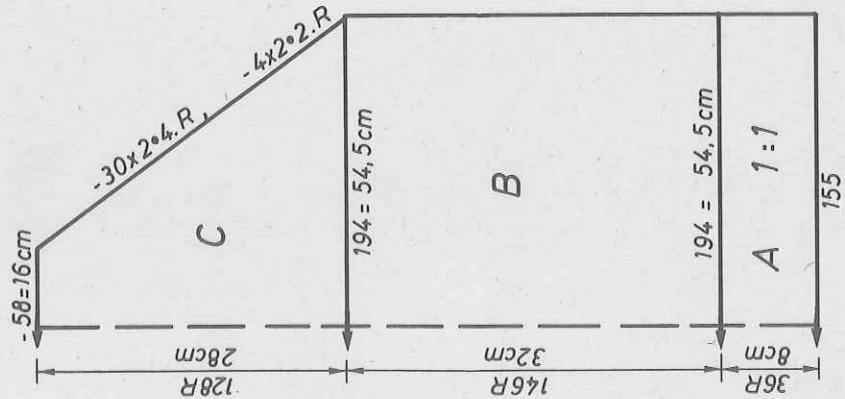

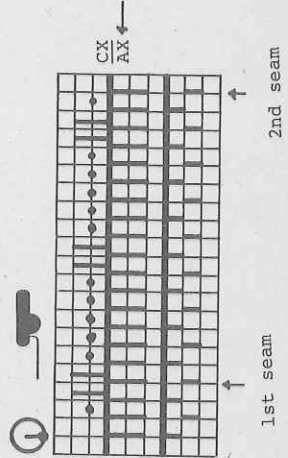

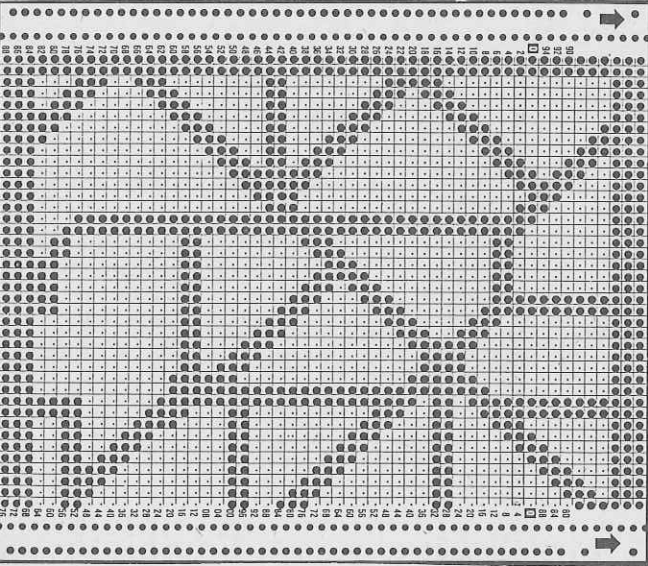
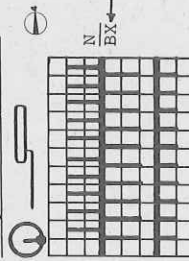


Diagram for pattern

- Material : 370 g fine Mohair with Silk (maybe pearly beads)
- Stitch size : Stocking stitch = 6 1/2. Pattern = front 6 1/2, back 7.
- Stitch square : 1:1 rib bands = 3 1/2. Neckband = 7.
- Pattern : Stocking stitch : 100 sts = 38 cm, 100 R = 29 cm
- Note : The pattern part will give another test square.
- Back in stocking stitch. Sleeves and front acc. to diagrams 2 + 1.

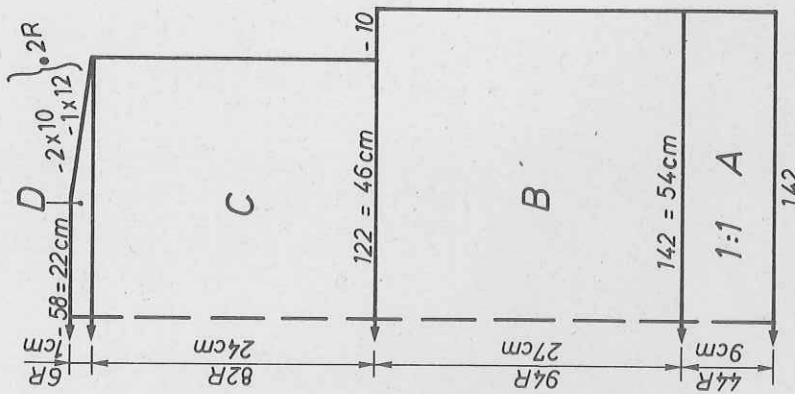

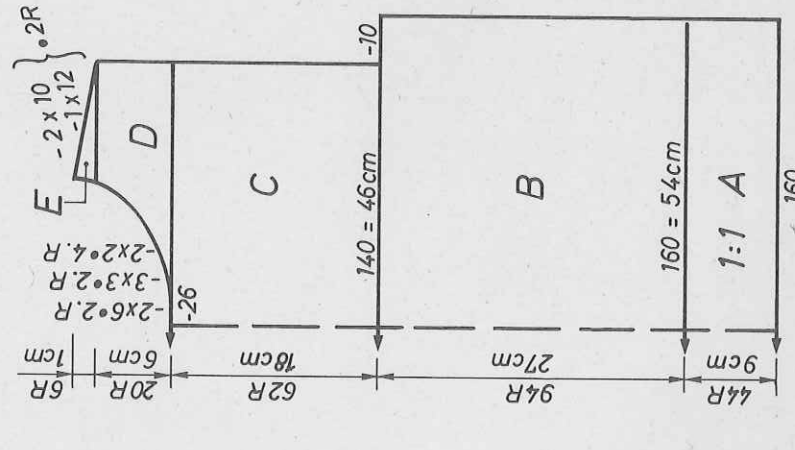

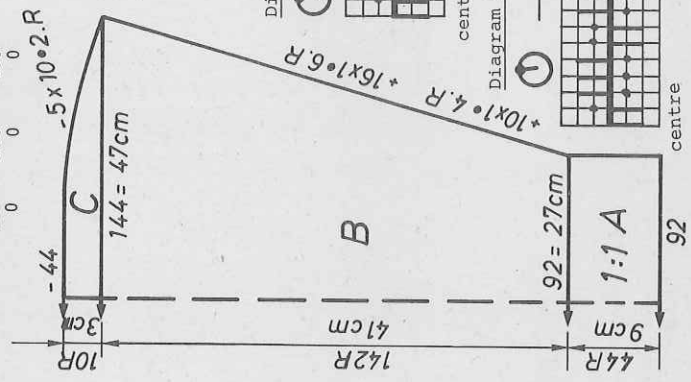
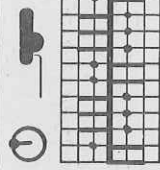
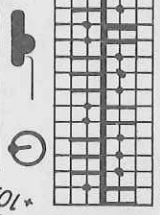


Diagram 2 for pattern
