! QUICK AND EASY TO KNIT !

Please note the new abbreviations for the pattern descriptions

2 R	Knit 2 rows
4 R	Knit 4 rows
1 	Racking handle one full turn to the right
2 	Racking handle two full turns to the right
1 	Racking handle one full turn to the left
	Transfer stitches from back to front
	Transfer stitches from front to back

Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i. e. first knit one part according to diagram (increasing or decreasing at right), then the second part the opposite way (decreasing or increasing at left).

Abbreviations:

○	= tubular (or) = half tubular	+	= increase
●	= every (in every row)	-	= decrease, cast off
X	= times	▲	= graduations (short rows)

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

First increase or decrease always occurs in the first row of a section.

+ 3 × 2 · 8 · R	means: increase 2 stitches 3 times in every 8th row (1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front).
- 19 × 3 · 7 · R	means: decrease 3 stitches 19 times in every 7th row (back 2 stitches, front 1 stitch or vice versa).
- 17 × 1 · 2./3 · R	means: decrease 1 stitch 17 times, alternately once after 2 rows and once after 3 rows.
▲ - 4 × 8 · 2 · R	means: work graduations, i. e. short rows (on DUO with pushers and lock BX). Step by step put 8 nds (and their respective pushers) into Rest Position 4 times after every 2nd row (for double bed 4 nds each back and front). Once all graduations are finished, continue knitting normally, i. e. all nds in Working Position (pushers in Neutral Position).

Graduations can be knitted two ways, either from outer edge towards centre (gradual decreasing with the minus-sign "-" after the black triangle) or from the centre towards outer edge (gradual increasing with the plus-sign "+" after the black triangle.)
Number of stitches and centimetres :

136 = 20cm	means: a total of 136 sts (for K/K 68 stitches each on back and front) make a width of 20 cm.
○ 146 = 43cm	means: cast on 146 sts each on back and front bed for tubular which makes a width of 43 cm.

Stitch size: These indications are only recommended by us. They must always be tested by you, by making your own test square for your own wool.

IF YOU KNIT WITH THE FORM COMPUTER

Enter the measurements of your test square as follows :

- A Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of your test square
- B Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 sts of your test square
- C Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of the band. Note : It is possible for 'C' to appear twice in a programme, in which case the same measurement has to be entered twice.

Flashing figures :

For the flashing figures 1 to 5 you will no longer find separate explanations in the descriptions. What has to be done when these flashing figures appear, you have to look up in the general explanations which you should in any case study carefully before you start to knit.

The general meaning of the flashing figures is as follows :

- 1 Cast-on over the indicated number of needles on the front bed.
- 2 Transfer from band to pattern.
- 3 Divide work into two equal halves for neck opening.
- 4 End of first shoulder, to knit second shoulder press key GO.
- 5 End of knitting.

For many garments you will find for the neck or armhole band, or even front bands for a jacket, the remark :

"Use the programme for straight knitted band", which is the following programme :

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always enter the same measurement in both places.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

Lady's offwhite jacket

Size : 88 to 92 cm bust
 Material : 1100 g fairly thick Merino-Wool (Merino-Luxe by Triol).
 4 buttons. Welt and sleeve band = 5. Collar

Stitch size : Pattern = 7 1/2. Welt and sleeve band = 5. Collar and pocket = 7 1/2.

Test square : Pattern : 100 sts = 42 cm, RC 100 = 20 cm
 Collar : 100 sts = 38 cm, RC 100 = 14 cm
 Pocket : 100 sts = 38 cm, 100 R = 28 cm

Pattern : Half fisherman's 1:1 rib. Collar in half tubular (stocking stitch). Pocket in stocking stitch. Welt and bands in 1:1 rib.

 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = cont. to knit straight in half fisherman's rib in 1:1 division. C = dec. at each end. Cont. straight. D = shape shoulder at each end. Cast off remaining sts loosely.

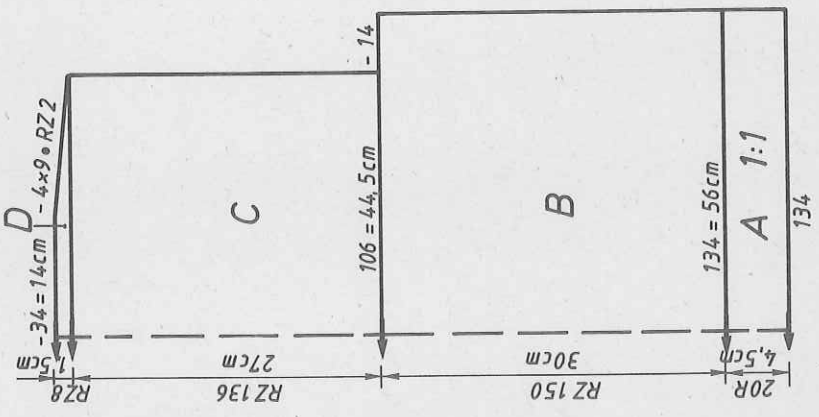

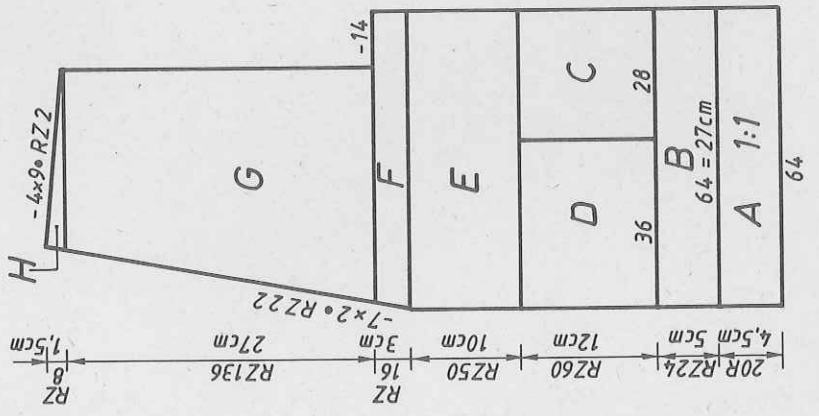


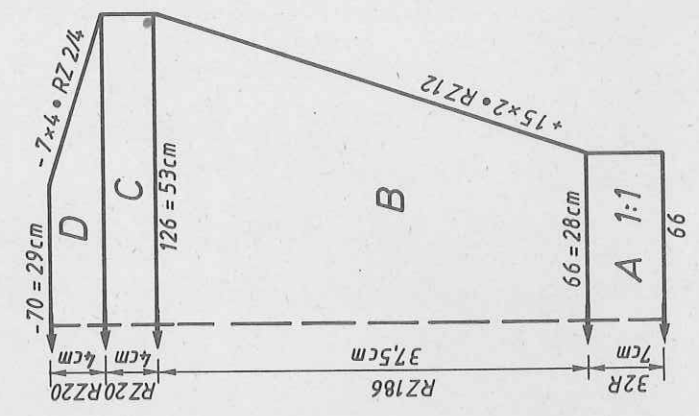
Fig. III : Front, knit two pieces with reversed shapings.

 D = place left part back onto nds of machine and cont. to knit straight.
 E = shape neck at left. G = dec. at right, cont. to knit, continuing to dec. at left. H = shape shoulder at right.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two alike
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = cont. to knit in half fisherman's rib in 1:1 division, inc. at each end. C = cont. to knit straight. D = dec. at each end. Cast off remaining sts loosely.

Fig. IV : Collar, knit two parts with reversed shapings.
 A = cast on for half tubular, open at right, cont. to knit in half tubular, at the same time working buttonholes on front and back bed always across needles 6 to 10 counting from the right, at RC 18, 90, 162, 234. B = inc. also inc. on back bed with triple decker. C = broken line = this means, dec. on each bed with graduations. F = cont. to knit straight, E = End with a few R contrast yarn, release. For 2nd part omit buttonholes.

Fig. VI : Pockets, knit two parts with reversed shapings
 A (pocket band) = closed cast on for tubular, cont. to knit tub. B (inside pocket) = Lock setting front GX, back N, knit a few R with contrast yarn, release at the back. Lock setting front N, back GX, inc. at each end, cont. to knit st.st. Cast off loosely.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew pocket band to slit on front part, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Fold inside pocket in half, and with right sides facing sew to second slit edge. Close pocket sides. Sew shoulder seams. Join collar with mattress stitch, unravelling contrast yarn. Sew collar to jacket parts, sew in position on inside. Neaten buttonholes. With right sides facing, set in sleeves. Sew side seams. Attach buttons.

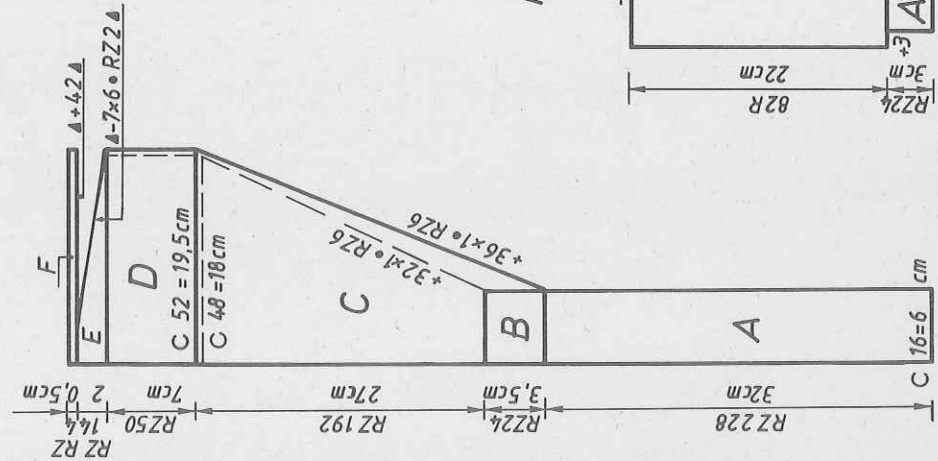
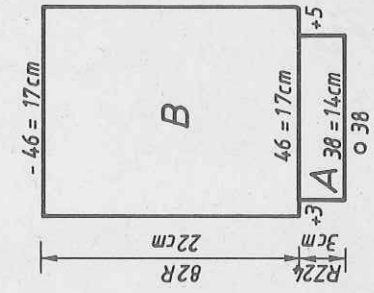

 Stacking stitch = 6 1/2. Front panel = 5. Welt = 3 1/4. Binding = 6 1/2.
 Test square : 100 sts = 37 cm, 100 R = 25 cm. Pattern for Fig. IIb :
 100 sts = 31 cm, RC 100 = 12 cm
 Pattern : Stocking stitch. For front panel = acc. to needle diagram and colour sequence with self-punched deco card (see no. 4303). Bands in 1:1 rib.

Fig. I : Back
 A = tubular cast on in 1:1 rib, then transfer sts for stocking stitch, cont. to knit in st.st., inc. at right. B = inc. at right (i.e. place an old test square on the nds of the machine), cont. to knit straight. Knit B and A in reverse order and with reversed shapings. Cast off loosely.
 Fig. IIA : Front, knit two pieces with reversed shapings.
 A + B as for Fig. I. C = dec. at left with short rows (graduations). D = knit straight with all nds, working four rows of eyelet holes acc. to diagram at Rows 1, 8, 16 and 24. Knit 4 more R, cast off loosely.
 Fig. IIB : Front panel
 A = tubular cast on in 1:1 rib, then transfer sts for st.st., knit acc. to nd-diagram in col. sequence and with deco card, inc. at each end (begin with cotton yarn). B = st.st. with cotton yarn, but not in pattern. Cast off loosely.
 Back neckbinding : Closed cast on for tubular with 45 sts, knit RC 16. End with a few R contrast yarn, release.

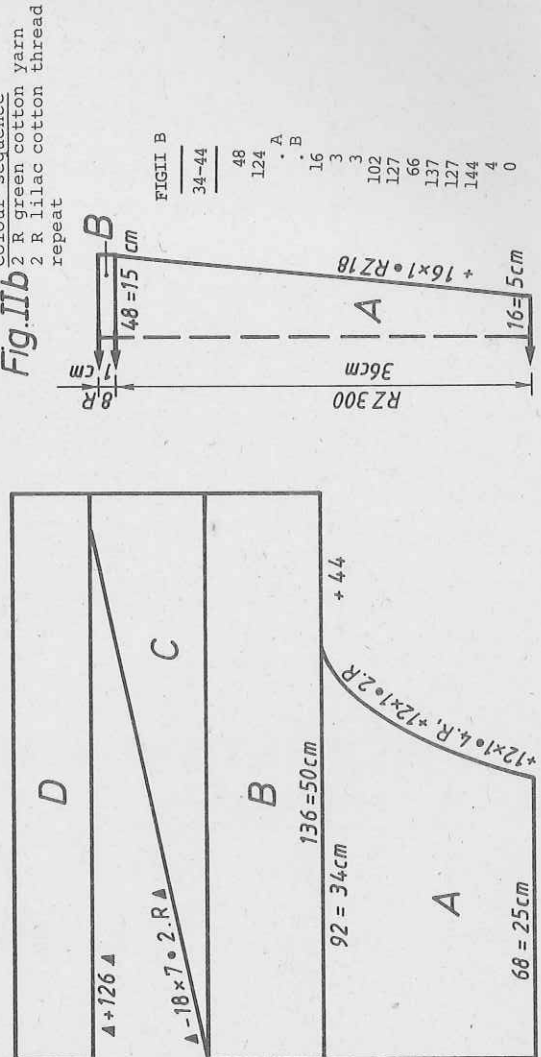
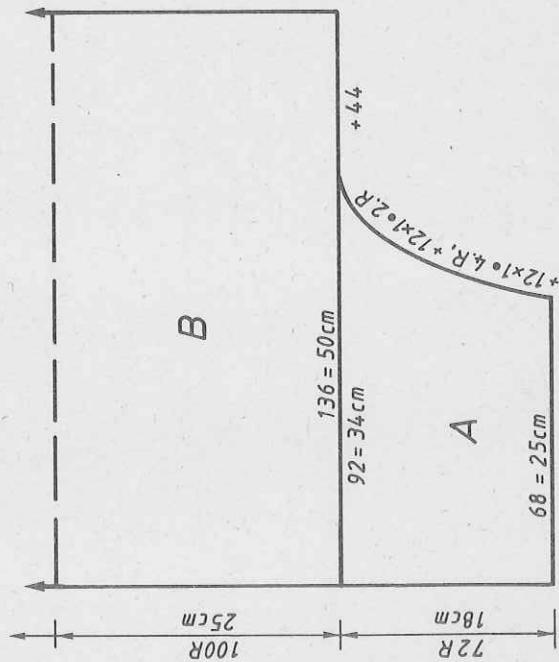

Welt : Knit two pieces Tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with 166 sts, knit 50 R, end with a few R contrast yarn, release.
 To make up : Pin parts out to size and press lightly. With purllside worn as right side, set in front panel between the to front parts, remembering that 2 cms of the front edge will be folded to the inside so that the last two rows of eyelet holes will match. Let the top edge of the front panel roll to the inside. Draw ribbon through the holes as shown in photo. Sew binding to back neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew in place on inside. St by st, backstitching through the open loops, sew welt in position. Sew shoulder and side seams.

Diagram for eyelet holes

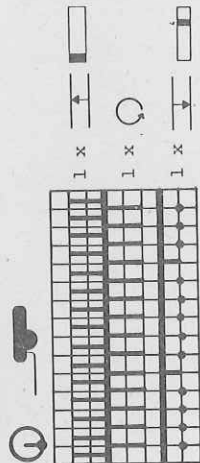
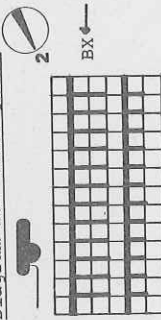


Diagram for front panel

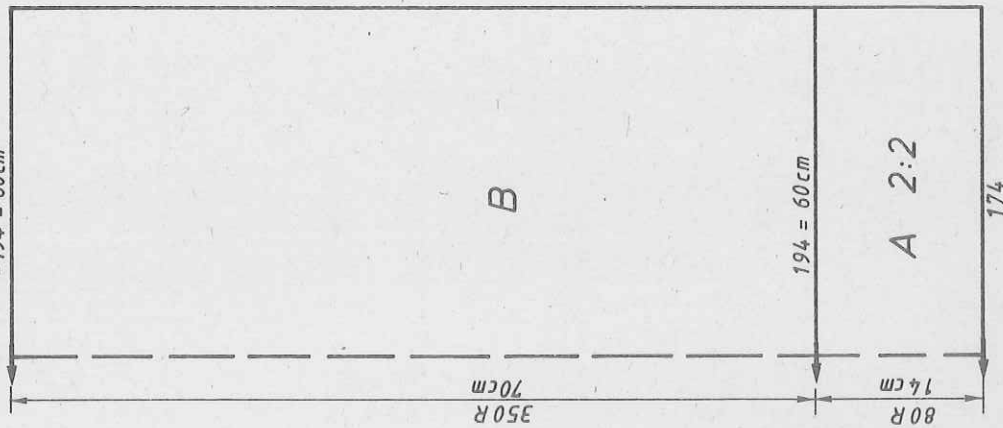

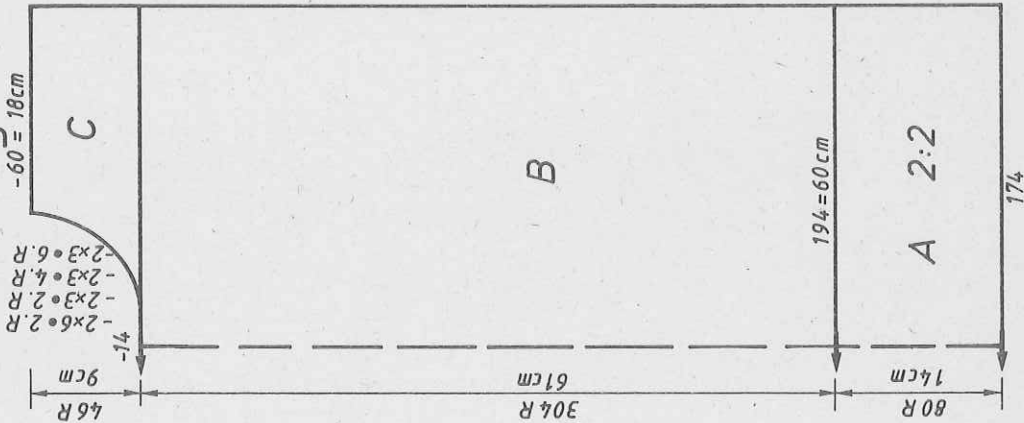
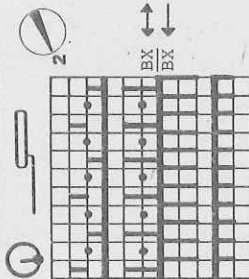

Size : 88 to 92 cm bust
Material : 370 g chunky cotton yarn (Ribonette by Schaffhauser Wool), 250 g fairly fine wool (Belfina by Trio), 190 g fine Rayon.
Pattern : front = 7 1/2, back = 6.
Welt : 4. Sleeve and neck bands = 5. 100 sts = 31 cm. 100 R = 20 cm.
Pattern : diagram and colour sequence with self-punched deco card.
Welt in 2:2 rib.
Sleeve and neck bands in half Fisherman's rib with all needles.

Fig. I : Back

A = tubular cast on in wool for 2:2 rib with 174 sts over a width of 130 nds.
 B = transfer sts acc. to nd-diagram, cont. to knit acc. to nd-diagram and col sequence with deco card, straight. Cast off loosely.

Fig. II : Front

A + B = as for Fig. I. C = divide work, make note of pattern position, place left half onto dekercombs. Cont. to knit right half : shape neck at left, cast off loosely. Place left half back onto nds of machine and knit with reversed shapings.

Sleeve band : Knit two pieces

Tubular cast on for K/K with wool, 200 sts, knit 100 R in half Fisherman's rib. End with a few R contrast yarn, release.

Neckband : Knit one piece

As given for sleeve band but with 170 sts knit 100 R.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew shoulder seams. Join collar on the wrong side, then sew to outside neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, fold in half to inside and sew in place. Sew sleeve band to front and back parts along 35 cms from the shoulder seam, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn. Sew side seams and join lower end of sleeve band. Fold sleeve band in half to inside, sew in position.

Pattern : Acc. to needle diagram with self-punched deco card. Bands and collar : K/K.

 194 yds per 1 oz
 10 cm = approx. 4"

Fig. I : Back

A = tubular cast on for K/K, dark green, using the knitting in elastic together with the yarn for the welt. B = cont. to knit acc. to nd-diagram and colour sequence with deco punchcard A. C = cont. to knit with deco punchcard B. D = dec. at each end. E = cont. to knit with deco card A. F = shape shoulders at each end. Cast off remaining sts loosely.

Fig. II : Front

As for Fig. I, but dividing work at section C. Place left half onto decker-comb. Cont. to knit right half, shaping neck at left. Place left half back onto nds of machine and knit with reversed shapings.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two

A = tubular cast on for K/K, dark green together with knitting in elastic for the band. B = cont. to knit acc. to nd-diagram and col sequence with deco card A, inc. at each end. C = cont. to knit with deco card B, cont. to inc. at each end. D = cont. to knit with deco card A. Cast off loosely.
 Neckband : Knit two pieces
 Tubular cast on for K/K, dark green, with 224 sts, knit 60 R. End with a few R contrast yarn, release.

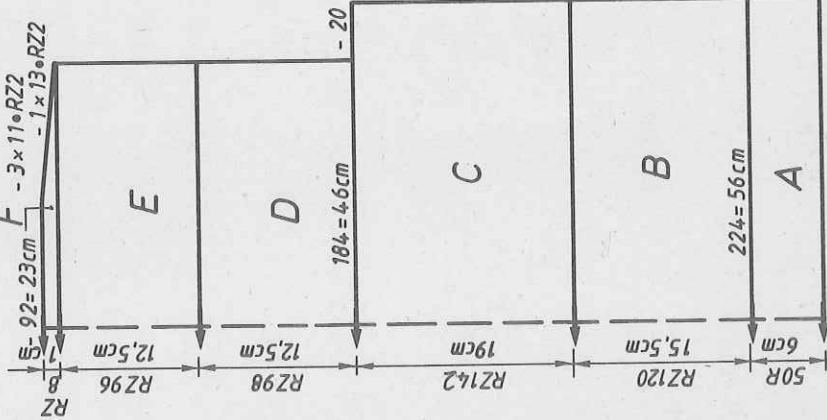

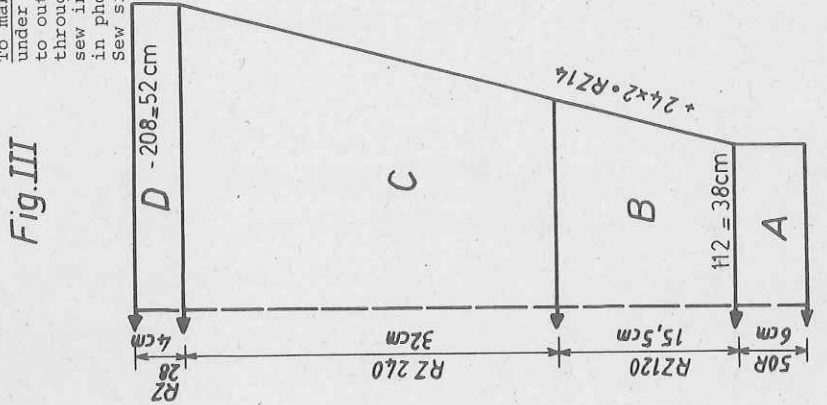
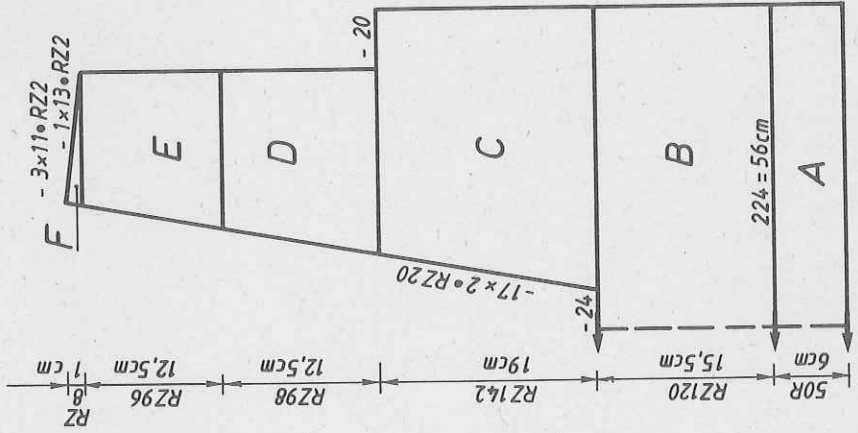

Sew neckband to outside neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew in place on inside (overlap lower edge as shown in photo). With right sides facing, set in sleeves. Sew side seams.

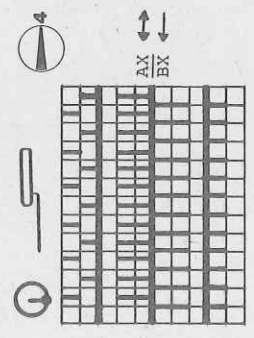

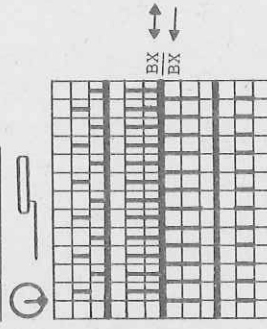


Diagram 2 : Pattern

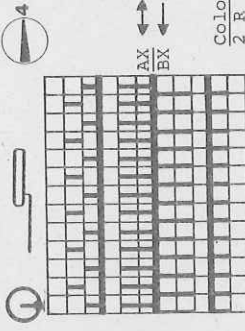

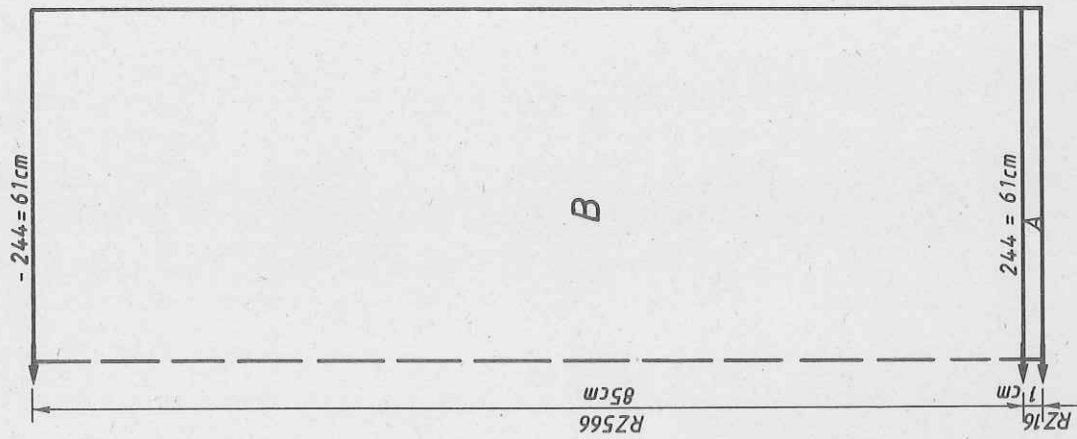

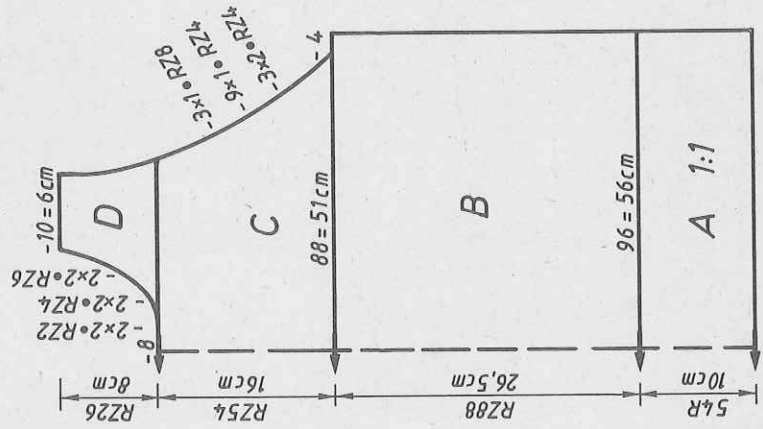

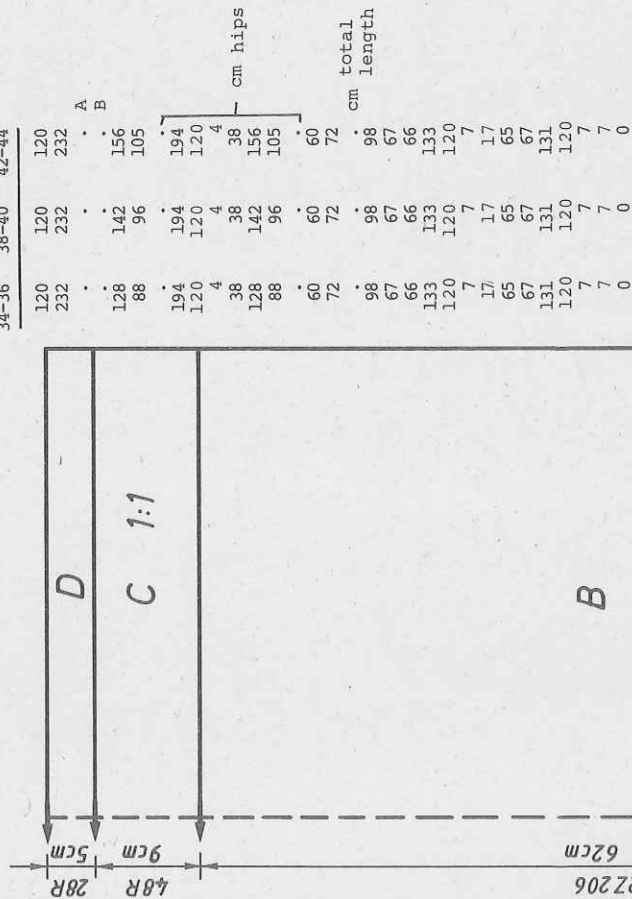

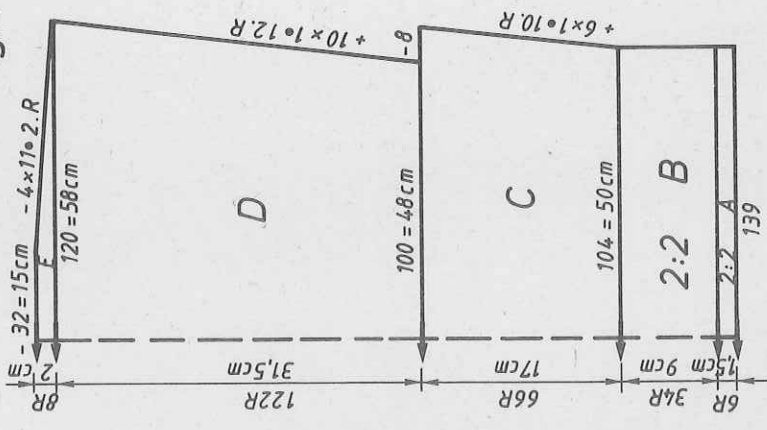

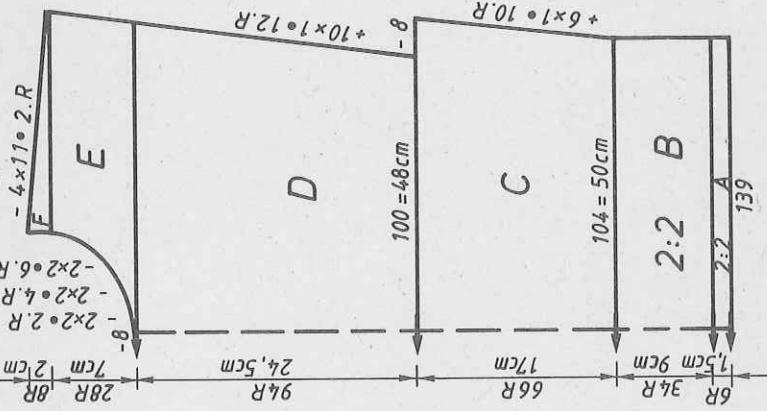

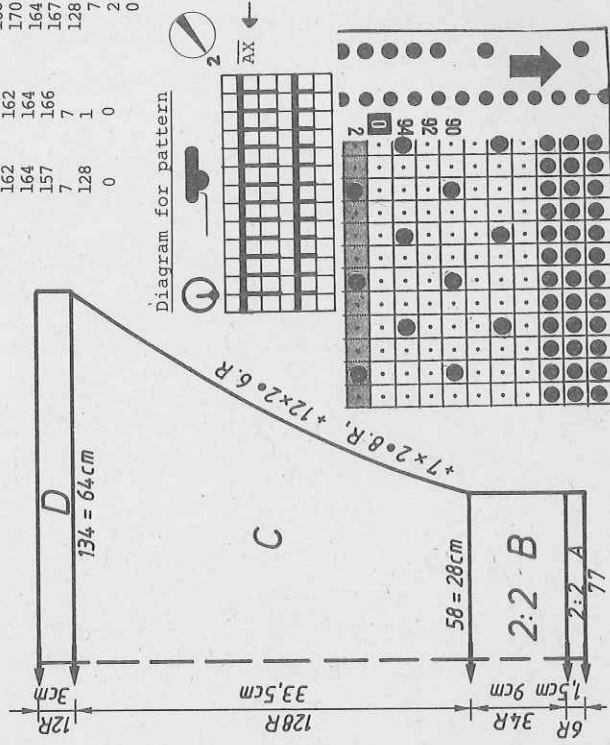
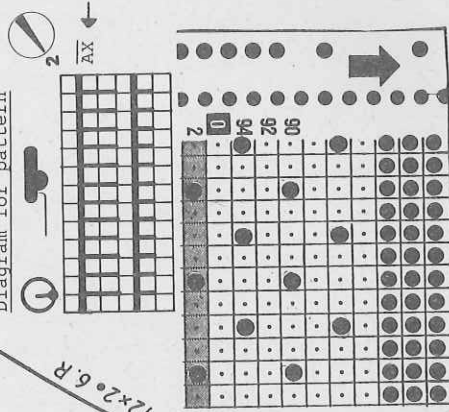


Diagram for pattern

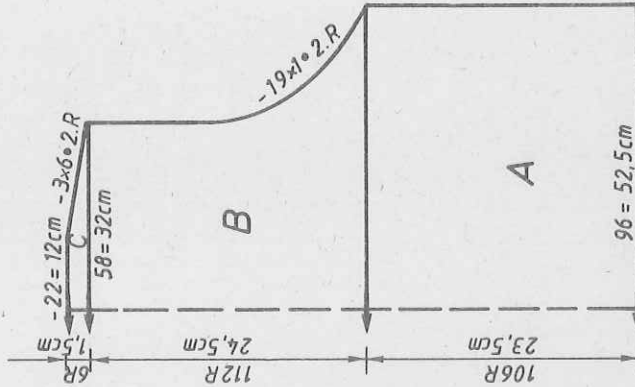

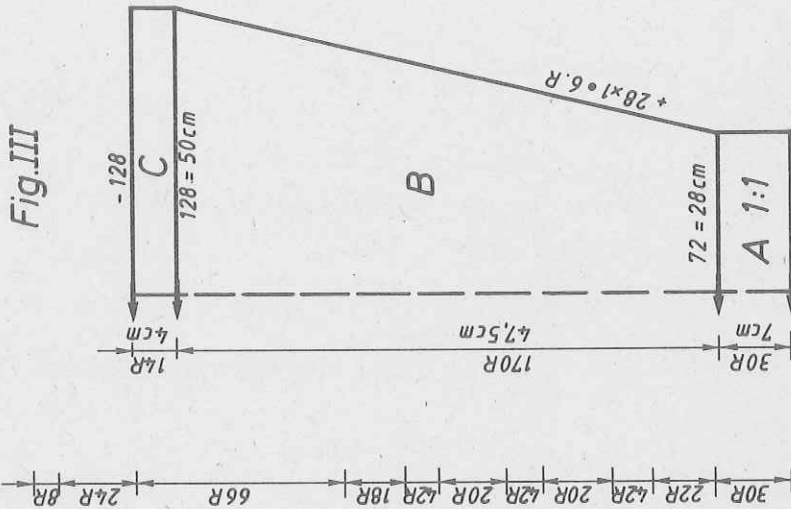
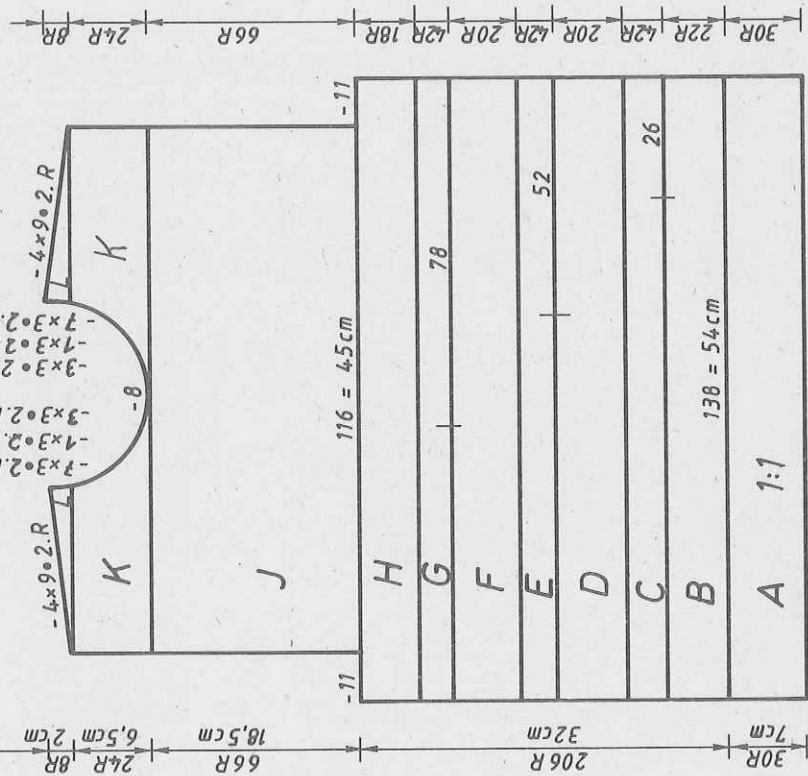

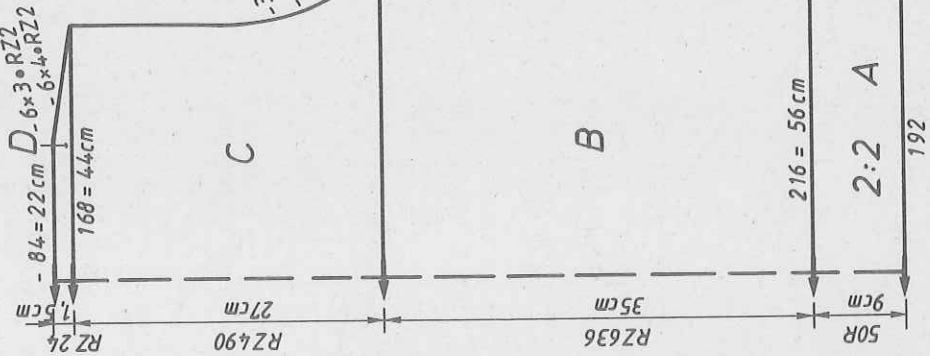

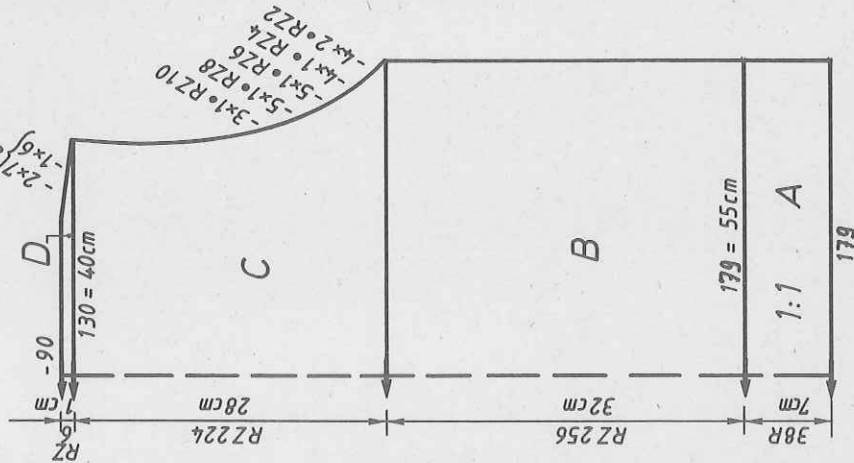

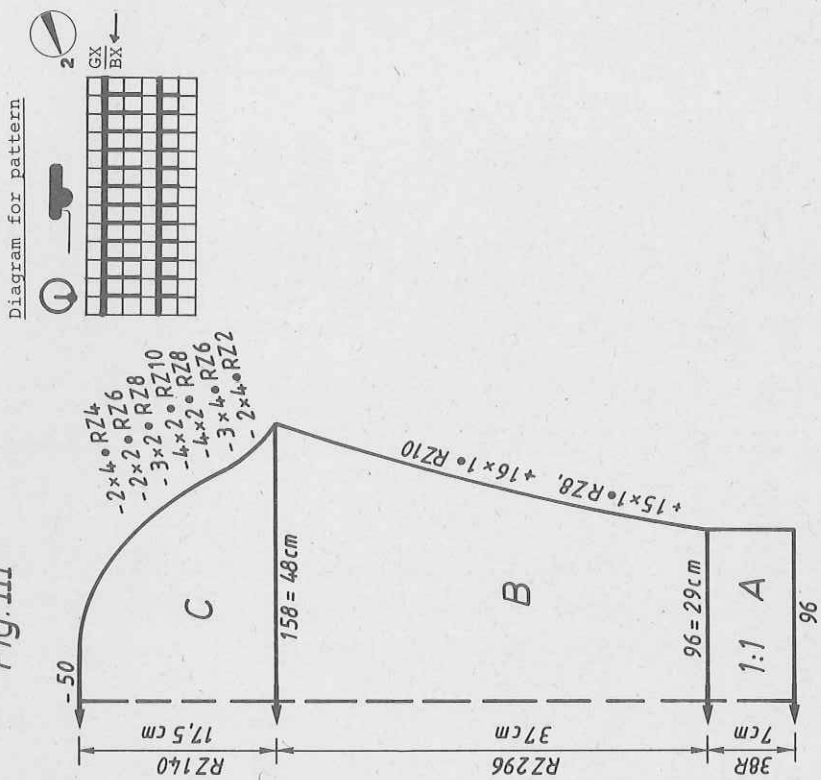
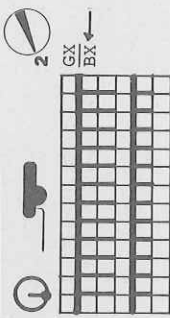


Diagram for pattern

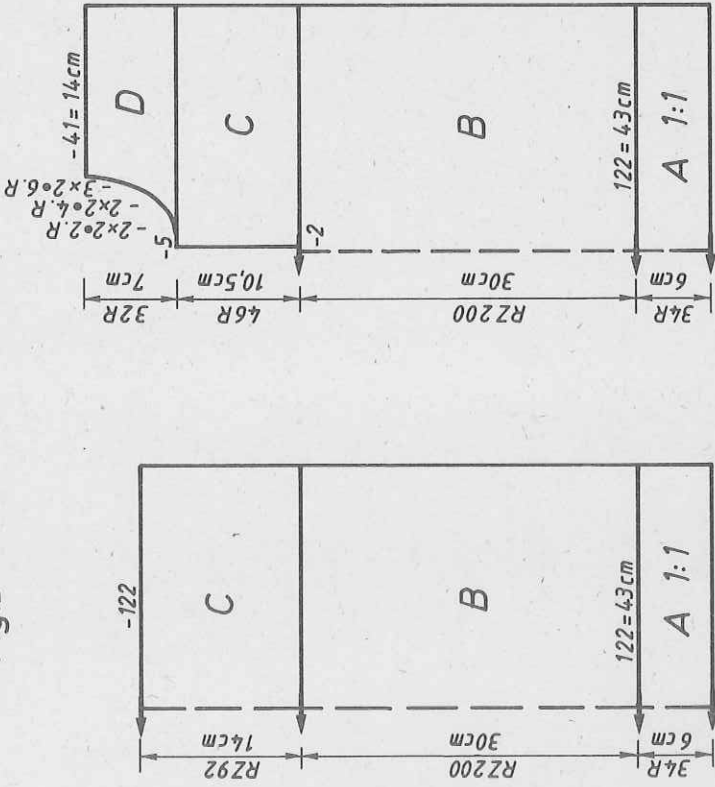
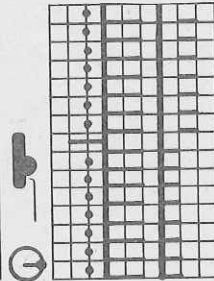


Diagram for intarsia



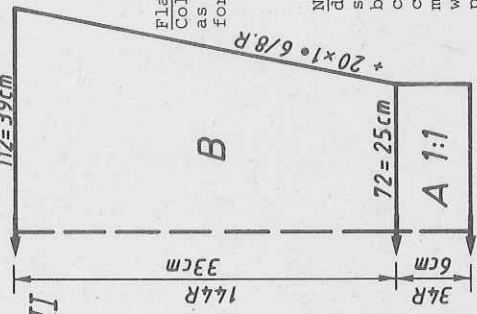

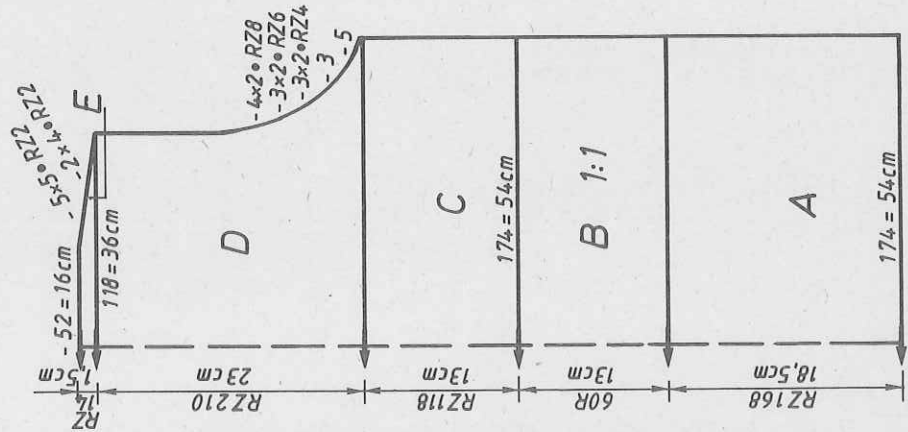

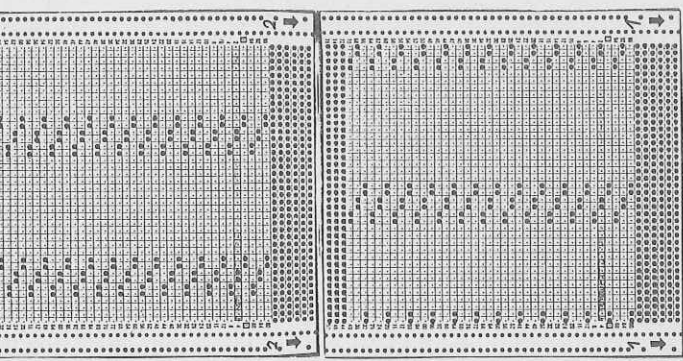

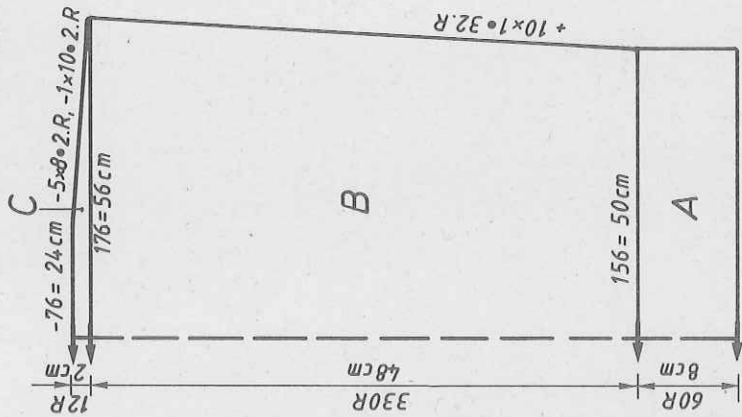

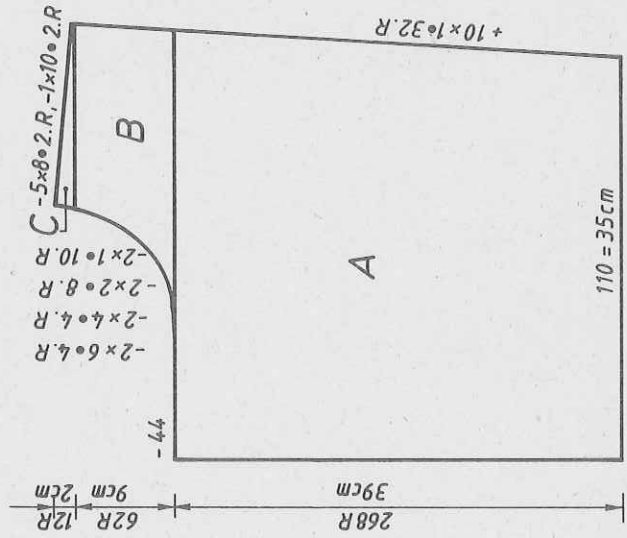

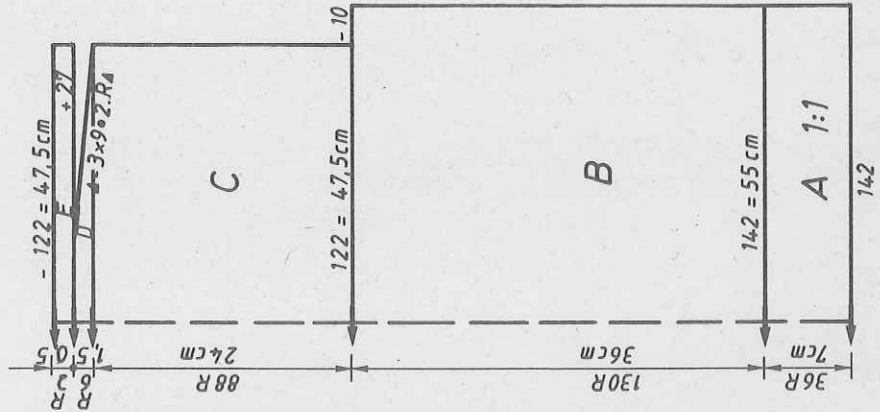

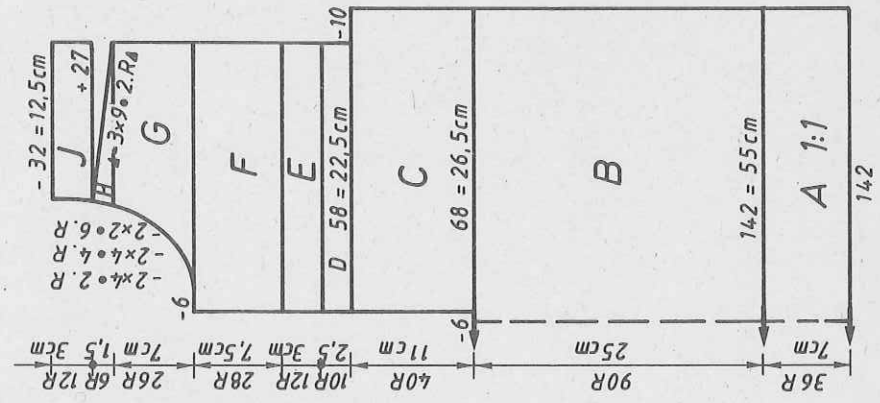

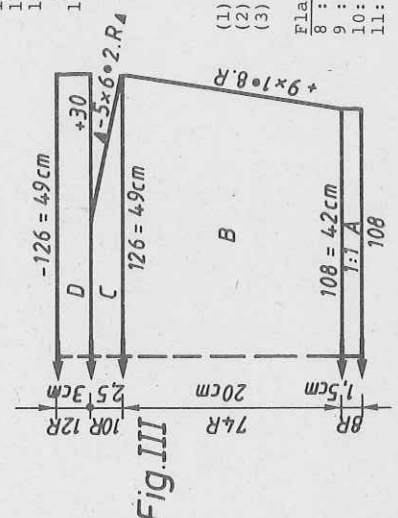

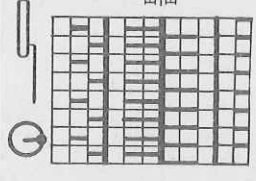

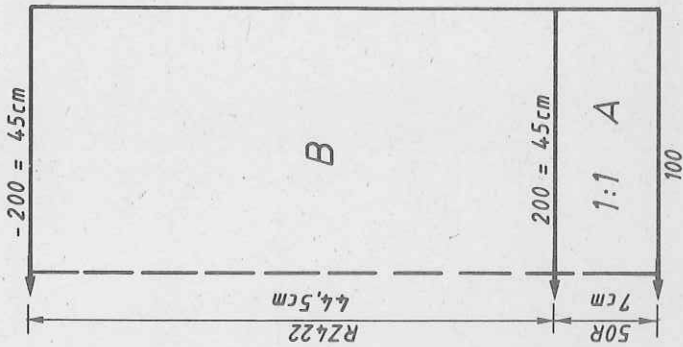

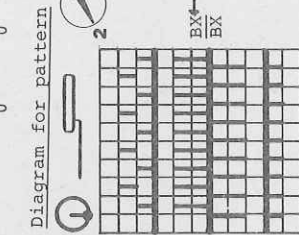

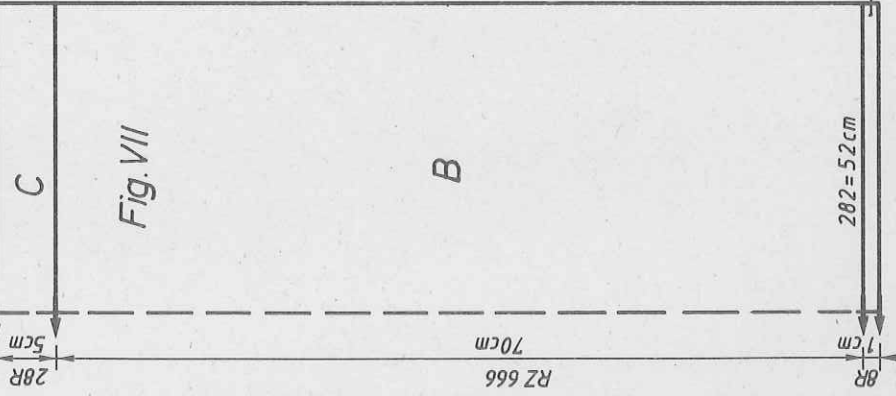

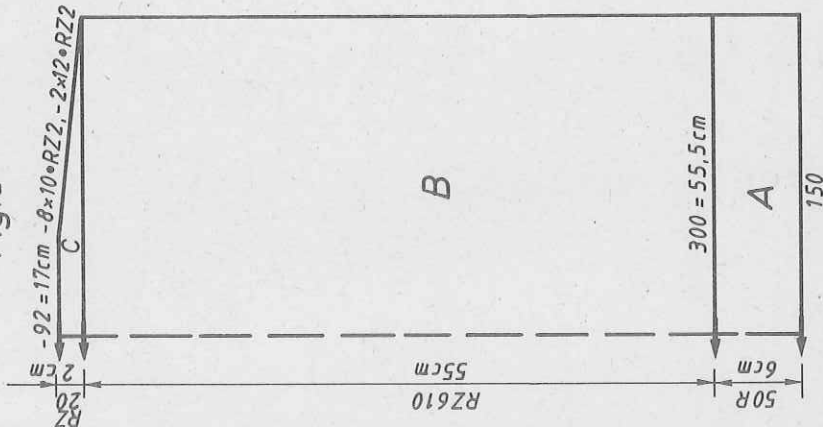

Diagram 2 for pattern 2

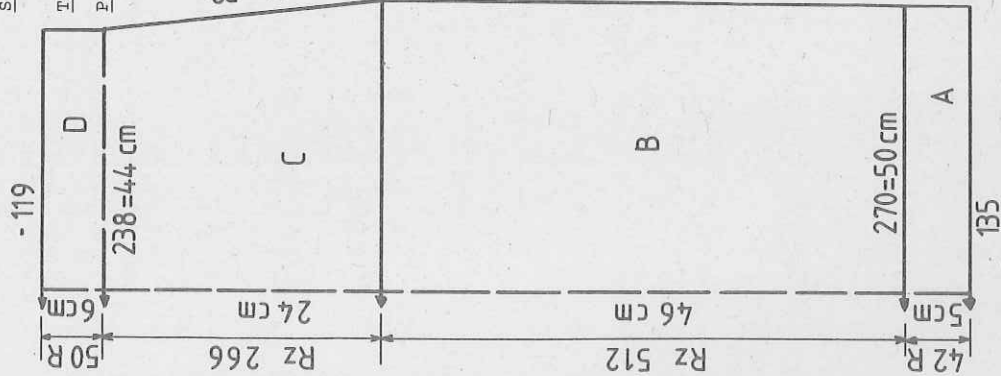

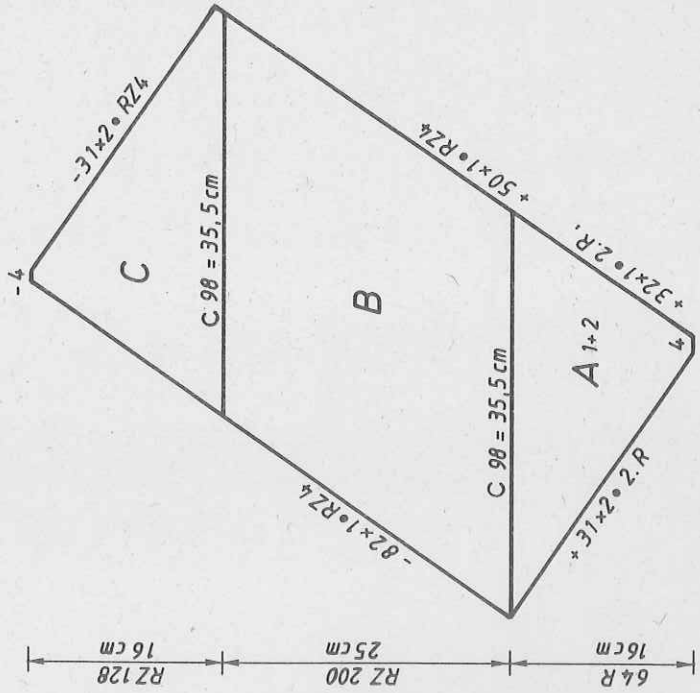

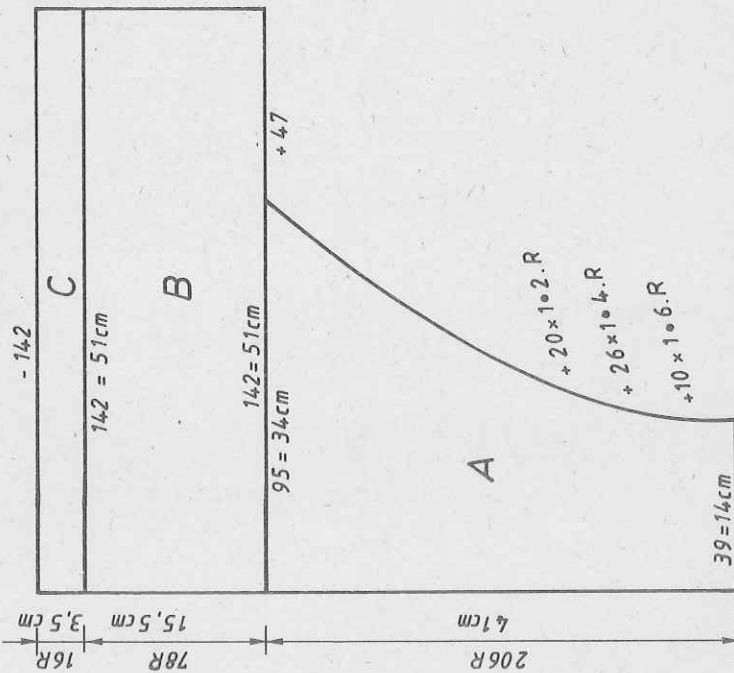

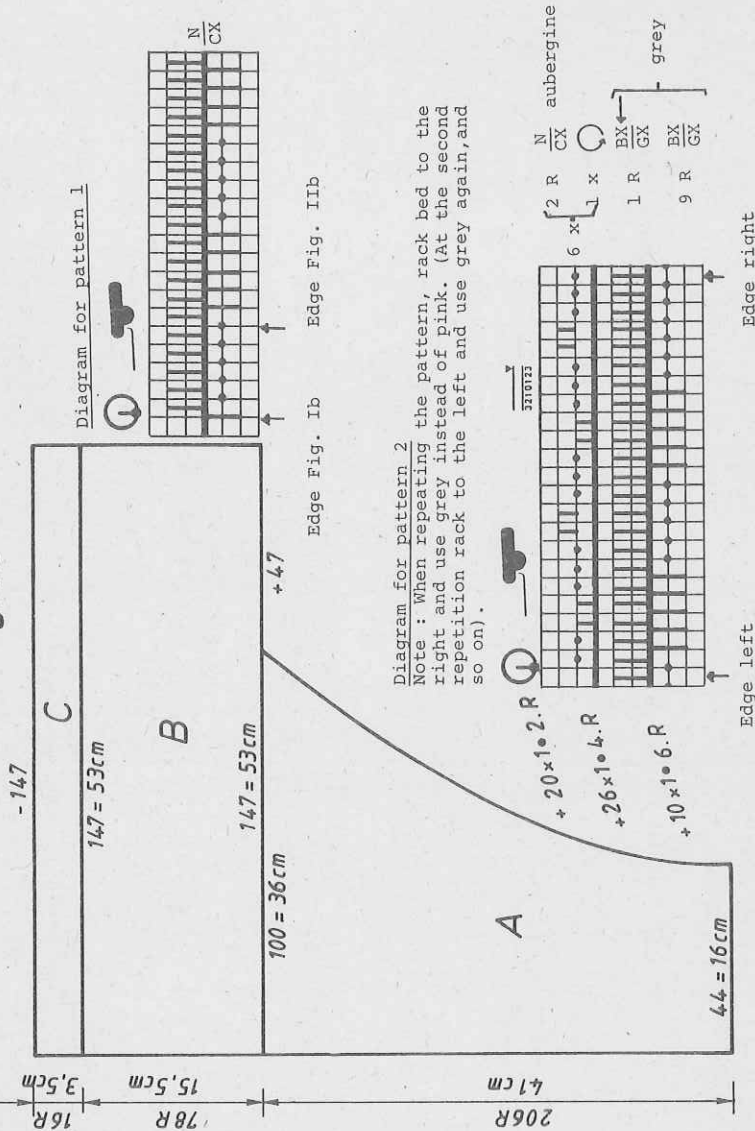


Diagram for pattern 2

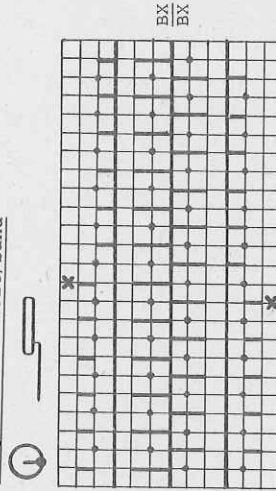

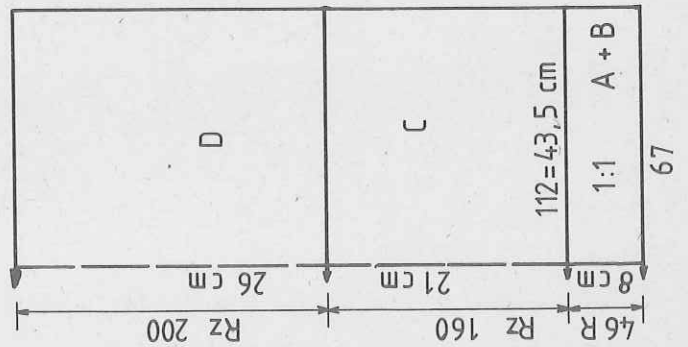

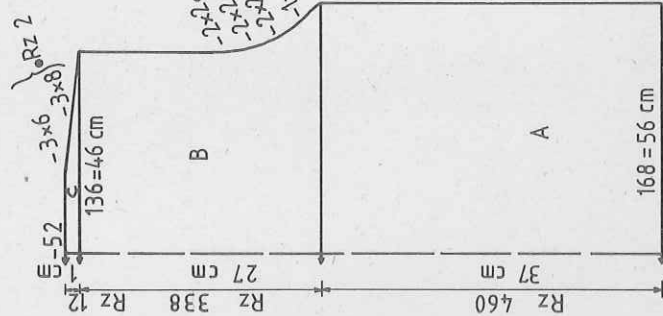

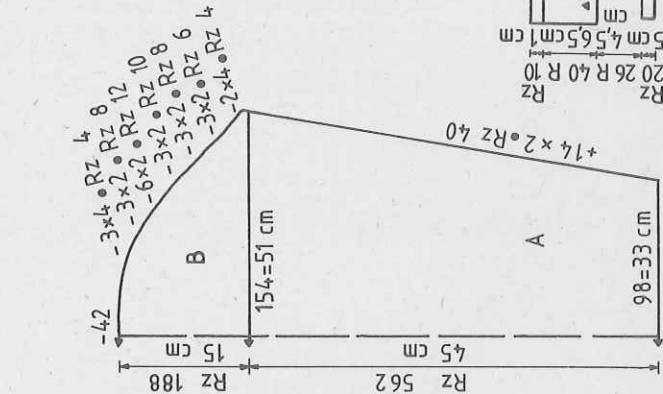

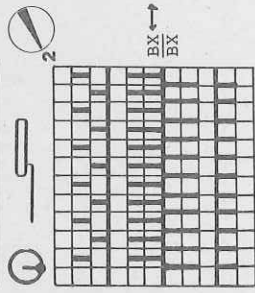

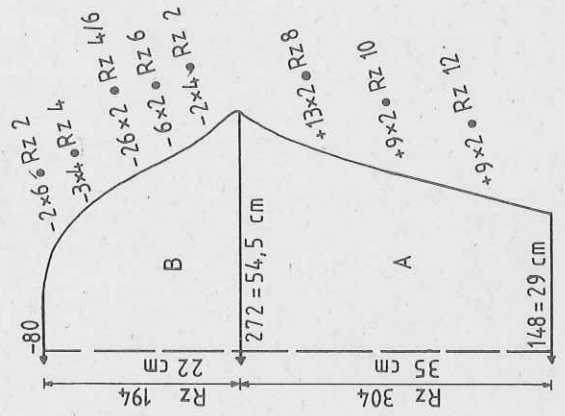
