Remarks relating to the FORM COMPUTER

While knitting with the FORM COMPUTER, have you ever noticed or even used the programme for "straight knitted neckband" ?

You may not be aware that this programme can, in fact, be used for many other knitted parts rather than just neckbands. Any rectangular piece, be it a shawl, stole, straight knitted back or front part of a sweater or parts of a baby jumper can be knitted with this programme.

If you want to use this programme for a tubular, straight skirt, then you enter at the place marked "cm neck opening" the measurements for half the width of the skirt, and at the place marked "cm height of band" the desired length of the skirt.






But this programme can be used for even more things : you can also follow it for trapeze-shaped pieces of knitting. Contrary to the advice on page 3, it is quite possible to enter different measurements at the two places provided for "cm neck opening". At the first 'dot' you enter the measurement that your piece of knitting is going to have when you cast on, at the second 'dot' you enter the measurement the piece is going to have when you cast off.

For a slightly flared skirt, you therefore enter at the first 'dot' of "cm neck opening" e.g. 68 cm and at the second 'dot' 40 cm.

Of course, you can also programme knitted pieces that are narrower at the bottom than at the top, like e.g. sleeves without a shaped sleeve head but straight across the top.

One more small tip : the computer automatically displays the last increase or decrease in the very last row before casting off, so it is best to adjust the measurement at the top accordingly.

Please note the new abbreviations for the pattern descriptions

2 R	Knit 2 rows
4 R	Knit 4 rows
1 	Racking handle one full turn to the right
2 	Racking handle two full turns to the right
1 	Racking handle one full turn to the left
	Transfer stitches from back to front
	Transfer stitches from front to back

Patterns: The drawings refer to half width, the indications of stitch numbers refer to whole width of each part.

If the centre line of the half width is dotted and shows arrows, the other half is worked simultaneously with reversed shapings, i. e. decreasing or increasing is made on the left as well as on the right side.

If the centre line is drawn in one firm line, the other half is worked separately with reversed shapings, i. e. first knit one part according to diagram (increasing or decreasing at right), then the second part the opposite way (decreasing or increasing at left).

Abbreviations:

○	= tubular (or) = half tubular	+	= increase
●	= every (in every row)	-	= decrease, cast off
X	= times	▲	= graduations (short rows)

Stitches are only given by a number (without accompanying letter "st"). The stitch number always refers to the total of stitches, i. e. to all needles which are in Working Position on back and front bed.

Exception: For tubular or half tubular the necessary stitches are only given for one bed. The same number of needles must therefore be put into Working Position on the other bed. In these cases the sign for tubular ○ respectively (or) for half tubular is set before the relevant stitch number.

Examples for increasing and decreasing:

First increase or decrease always occurs in the first row of a section.

+ 3 × 2 · 8 · R	means: increase 2 stitches 3 times in every 8th row (1 stitch at back, 1 stitch at front).
- 19 × 3 · 7 · R	means: decrease 3 stitches 19 times in every 7th row (back 2 stitches, front 1 stitch or vice versa).
- 17 × 1 · 2 / 3 · R	means: decrease 1 stitch 17 times, alternately once after 2 rows and once after 3 rows.
▲ - 4 × 8 · 2 · R	means: work graduations, i. e. short rows (on DUO with pushers and lock BX). Step by step put 8 nds (and their respective pushers) into Rest Position 4 times after every 2nd row (for double bed 4 nds each back and front). Once all graduations are finished, continue knitting normally, i. e. all nds in Working Position (pushers in Neutral Position).

Graduations can be knitted two ways, either from outer edge towards centre (gradual decreasing with the minus-sign "-" after the black triangle) or from the centre towards outer edge (gradual increasing with the plus-sign "+" after the black triangle.)
Number of stitches and centimetres :

136 = 20 cm means: a total of 136 sts (for K/K 68 stitches each on back and front) make a width of 20 cm.

○ 146 = 43 cm means: cast on 146 sts each on back and front bed for tubular which makes a width of 43 cm.

Stitch size: These indications are only recommended by us. They must always be tested by you, by making your own test square for your own wool.

IF YOU KNIT WITH THE FORM COMPUTER

Enter the measurements of your test square as follows :

- A Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of your test square
- B Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 sts of your test square
- C Enter here the measurement in mm of 40 rows of the band. Note : It is possible for 'C' to appear twice in a programme, in which case the same measurement has to be entered twice.

Flashing figures :

For the flashing figures 1 to 5 you will no longer find separate explanations in the descriptions. What has to be done when these flashing figures appear, you have to look up in the general explanations which you should in any case study carefully before you start to knit.

The general meaning of the flashing figures is as follows :

- 1 Cast-on over the indicated number of needles on the front bed.
- 2 Transfer from band to pattern.
- 3 Divide work into two equal halves for neck opening.
- 4 End of first shoulder, to knit second shoulder press key GO.
- 5 End of knitting.

For many garments you will find for the neck or armhole band, or even front bands for a jacket, the remark :

"Use the programme for straight knitted band", which is the following programme :

Important : In both places where it says "width of band or neck opening", always enter the same measurement in both places.

Width of band or neck opening always means the width you obtain from the stitches you have cast on.

Height of band always means the measurement you obtain from the rows you have knitted.

Lady's jacket

Size : To fit 88 to 92 cm bust
Material : 590 g mixed yarn (Romanza by Paton). 100 g cotton thread (20/2 by zürcher). 5 buttons, 9 small buttons.
Stitch size : Pattern 1 + 2 = front 7, back 6 3/4
Test square : 100 sts = 43,5 cm (sts counted on back bed alone)
 100 R = 17 cm
Pattern : Acc. to needle diagram 1. Welt, cuff, collar acc. to needle diagram 2.

Fig. I : Back
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib, then arrange nds acc. to nd-diagram 1, align stripes with centre, knit in pattern 1. B = inc. at each end. C = dec. at each end. Cast off.

Fig. II : Front, knit two parts with reversed shapings

A = as for Fig. I. Ensure that the front edge ends with 6 sts on the back bed. B = inc. at right. C = dec. at right. D = dec. at each end.

Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two with reversed shapings

A = tubular cast on in 1:1 rib, then arrange nds acc. to nd-diagram 1, knit in pattern 1, inc. at each end. B = dec. at each end. C = dec. at left.
 Collar : Tubular cast on in 1:1 rib with 19 sts, then transfer sts acc. to nd-diagram 2, knit 400 R. Cast off loosely.

Welt : As given for collar but knit 540 R.
Cuffs : Knit two, as for collar but 150 R.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. With right sides facing sew on sleeves. Along front edge, fold purlstitch part to inside and sew in position loosely. With right sides facing, attach collar, fold to inside, close with invisible sts at the front, hem in position on inside. Attach cuffs, with right sides facing, to sleeve end. Sew sleeve and side seams. Fold cuffs to inside, attach. With right sides facing, sew welt to jacket edge, gathering jacket part, fold welt in half to inside, sew in position, close open edge. Attach buttons, overlapping parts so much that the front has the same width as the back. Make loops on the front edge, if desired sew small buttons under the larger buttons on the inside. Make loop on welt and collar underlap, sew on buttons to match.

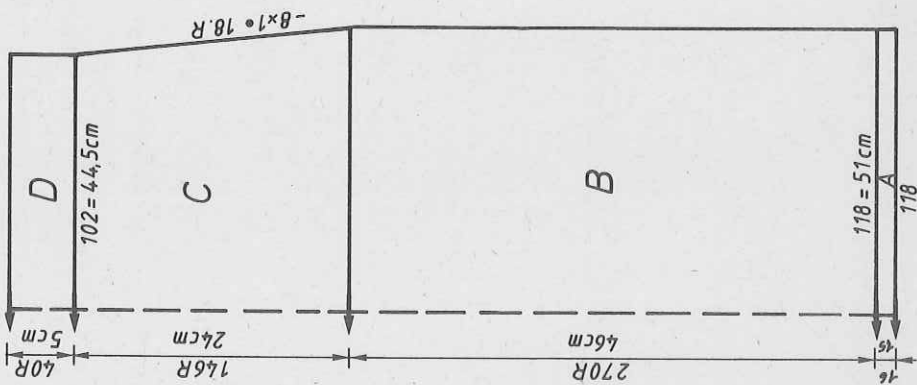

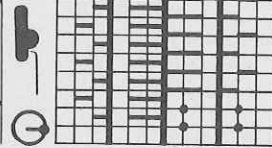

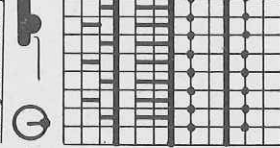

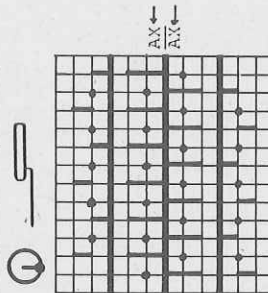

Size : To fit 88-92 cm bust
Material : 340 g cotton yarn jeans-blue (Jeans by Schulana).
 50 g Lurex thread. 1 remnant cotton yarn brick. 7 poppers
 (i.e. press studs)
Stitch size : Pattern = 7. Welt = 4. Armhole band = 7. Neckband = 7 to 6.
Test square : 100 sts = 35 cm. 100 R = 16 cm
Pattern : Acc. to nd-diagram in col/yarn sequence. Bands in 1:1 rib.

Fig. I : Back
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib in jeans-blue, knit straight. B = transfer all
 sts to front bed and knit in pattern acc. to nd-diagram and col/yarn sequence.
 C = dec. at each end. D = after 2 R in Lurex thread, knit 2 rows in cotton
 yarn brick, knit without arrow key. Cont. to knit in pattern beginning with

 few R contrast yarn, release.
Neckband : Knit one piece
 As for armhole band but with 152 sts, beginning with St.S 7, then decreasing
 the Stitch Size by 1/4 every 6 R until St.S 6, then increase St.S by 1/4
 every 6 R again.
Button band : Knit one piece
 As armhole band but with 120 sts.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and press lightly. Sew shoulder seams,
 wrong side out. Sew buttonband to front part, st by st, backstitching through
 the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew in position on inside.
 Attach neckband in the same way, at front edge join with invisible stitches.
 Sew armhole band in position, st by st, backstitching through the open loops
 and unravelling contrast yarn. Sew side seams. Sew armhole band in position
 on inside. Set in press studs as shown in photo, folding 3 cms of the band
 to inside as facing on right part.

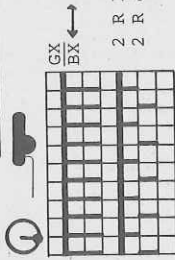
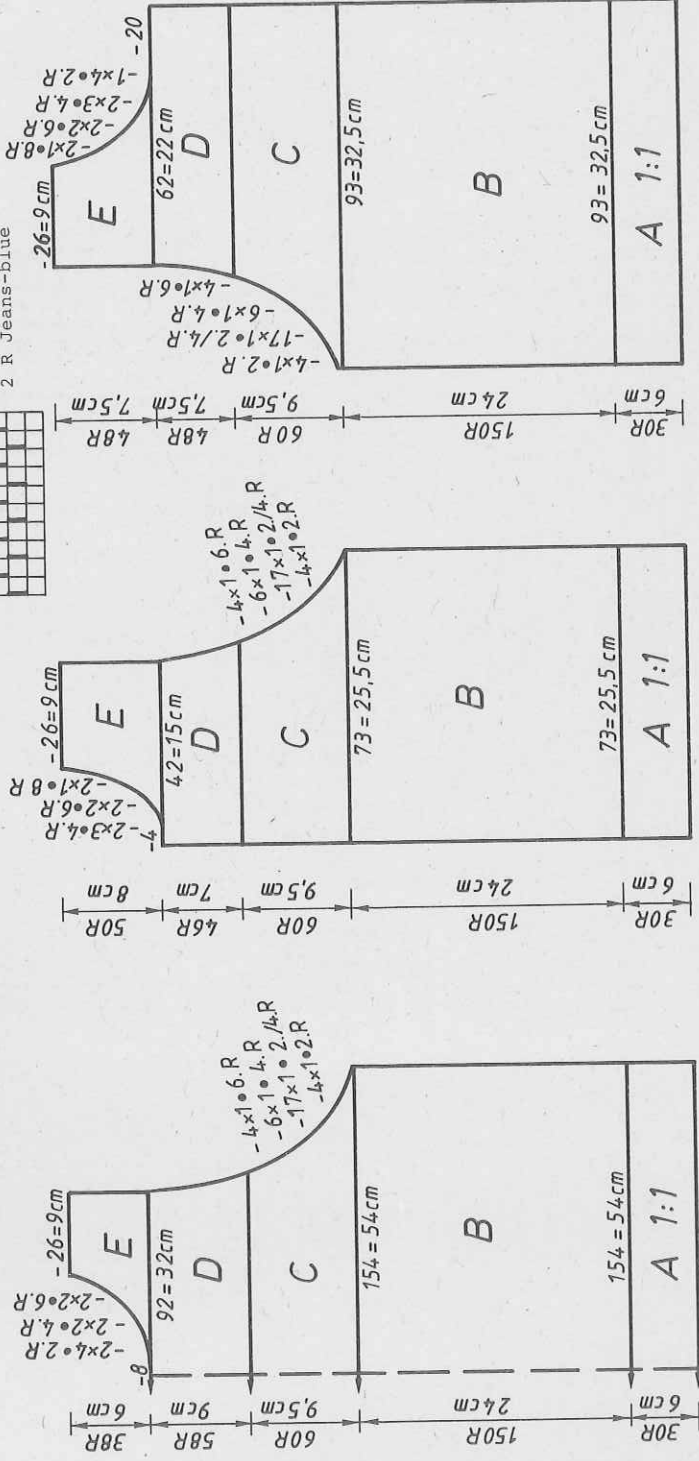

Test square : 100 sts = 34,5 cm. 100 R = 22 cm

Pattern : Tuck stitch acc. to needle diagram. Welt 1:1 rib. Collar 2:2 rib.

A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib. B = arrange sts acc. to nd-diagram, cont. to knit in pattern. C = dec. at each end, cast off.

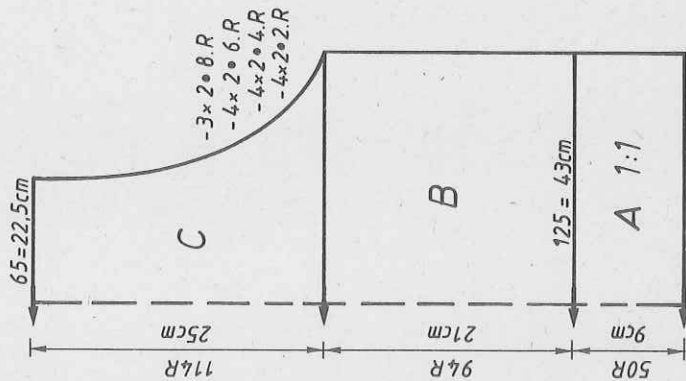

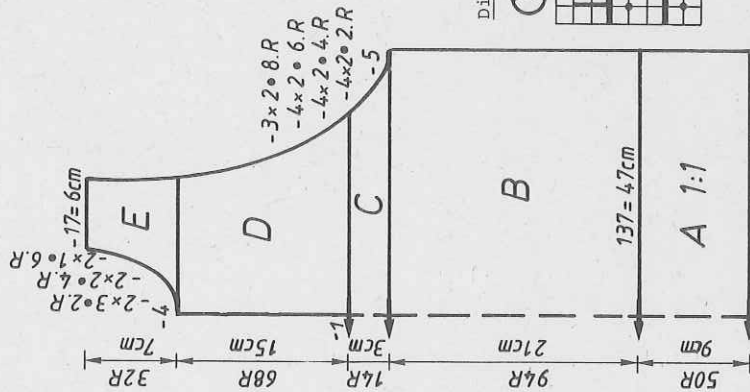
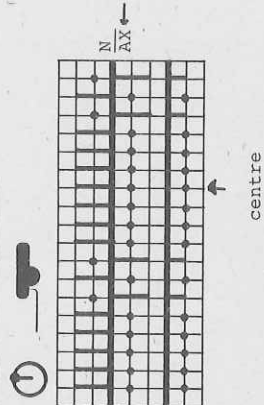


Diagram for pattern



Collar : Tubular cast on for 2:2 rib with 208 sts across a width of 156 nds. Knit 36 R. With Lock front and back CX, knit 10 R. End with a few R contrast yarn, release.

Armhole binding : Knit two pieces

Closed cast on for tubular with 122 sts, knit RC 16. End with a few R contrast yarn, release.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew shoulder seams. Sew collar to outside neck edge, st by st, backstitching through the open loops and unravelling contrast yarn, sew to inside. Sew on armhole binding in the same way. Crochet round slit and collar front edge. Backstitch zipper in position. Sew side seams.

Lady's sweater, yellow, Fairisle

Size : To fit 88-92 cm bust

Material : Mohair/Acrylic (Ciuffetto Filippucci by TRIO) 240 g.
180 g shiny yarn. Fine Acrylic 110 g of each yellow and offwhite. 3 buttons.

Stitch size : Pattern = front 6, back 5. Cuffs and welt = 7. Trimming bands for neck, raglan seam and waist = 5

Test square : 100 sts = 31 cm (sts counted on back bed alone)
RC 100 = 8 cm

Pattern : Acc. to needle diagram and yarn(col) sequence with self-punched DECO card. Waist band and cuffs = stocking stitch, acc. to yarn (col) sequence. Trimming bands = st.st.

Fig. I : Back
A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with Acryl. then transfer all sts to back bed, knit in patt acc. to nd-diagram and yarn sequence with DECO card. B = dec. at each end. Cast off.

Fig. II : Front
A + B = as for Fig. I. C = divide work, place left half onto deckercombs. Knit right half, dec. at each end. Place left half back onto nds of machine and knit with reversed shapings.

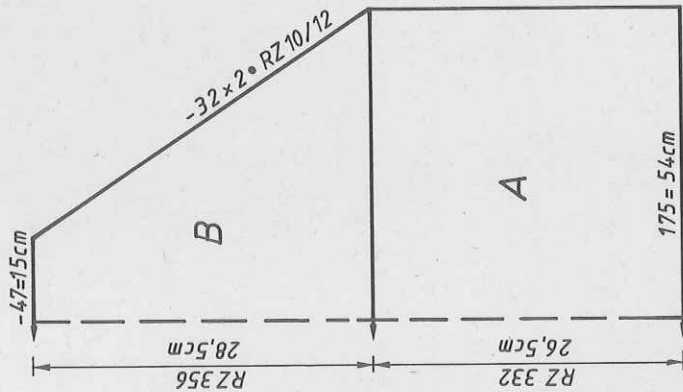
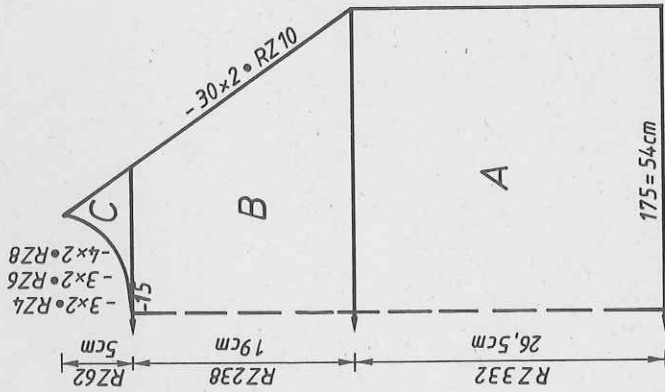

Waistband : Knit two pieces. Take Acrylic and Mohair yarn 2-fold. Shiny yarn singly. Tubular cast on in 1:1 rib with Mohair, 160 sts, transfer all sts to front bed and cont. to knit in st.st. acc. to yarn sequence i.e. 2 R shiny yarn, 2 R Mohair, 2 R Acrylic yellow, 2 R Acrylic offwhite, 2 R Mohair. 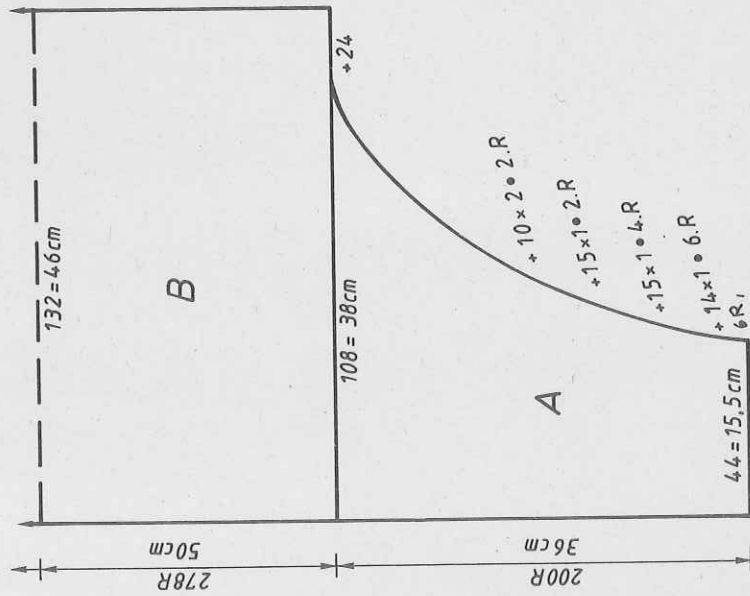

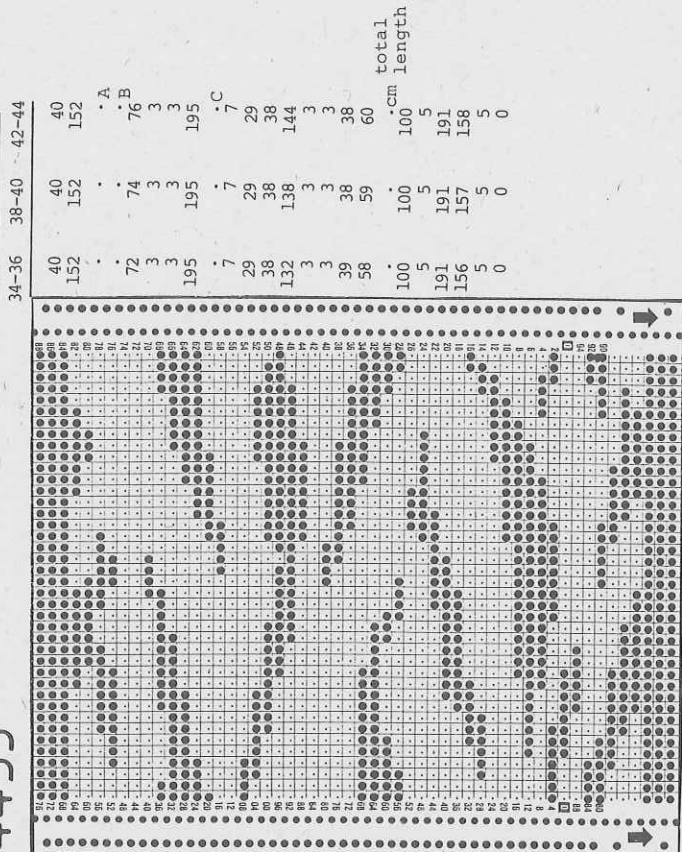

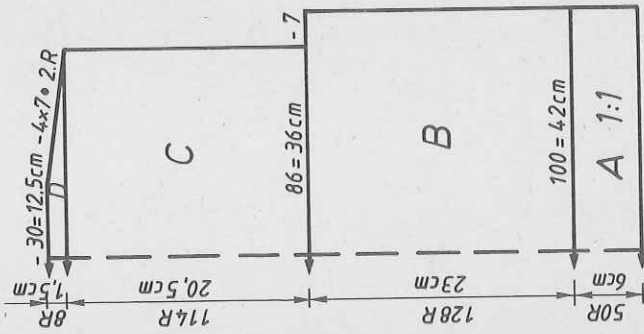

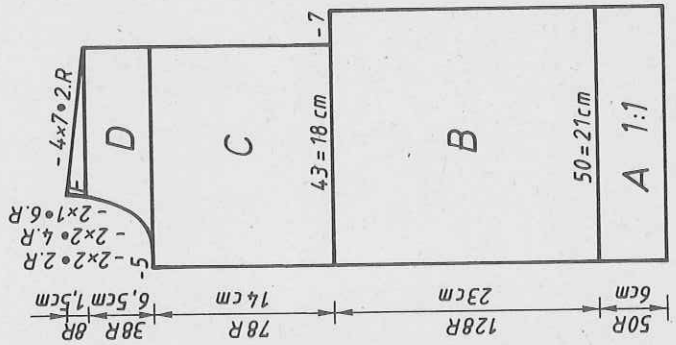


Diagram 1 for pattern

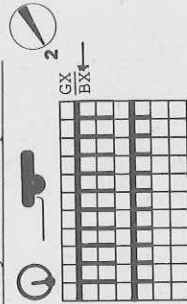


Diagram 2 for bands

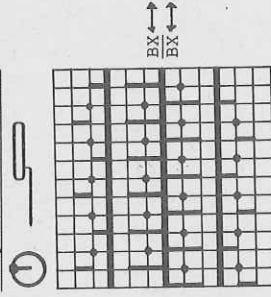


Fig. III 2 R Mohair 2 R Cotton thread

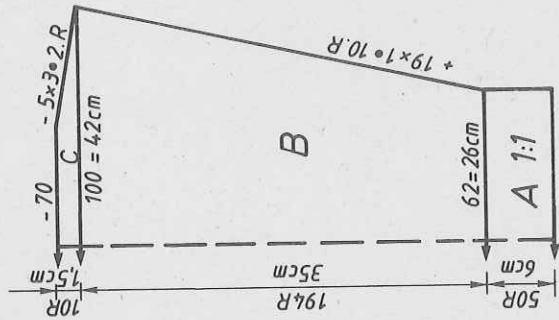
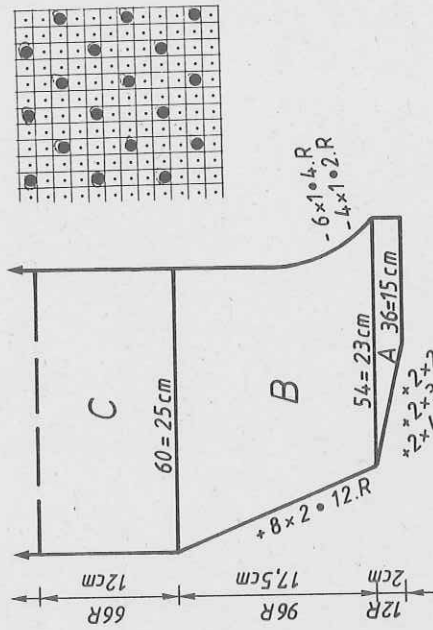

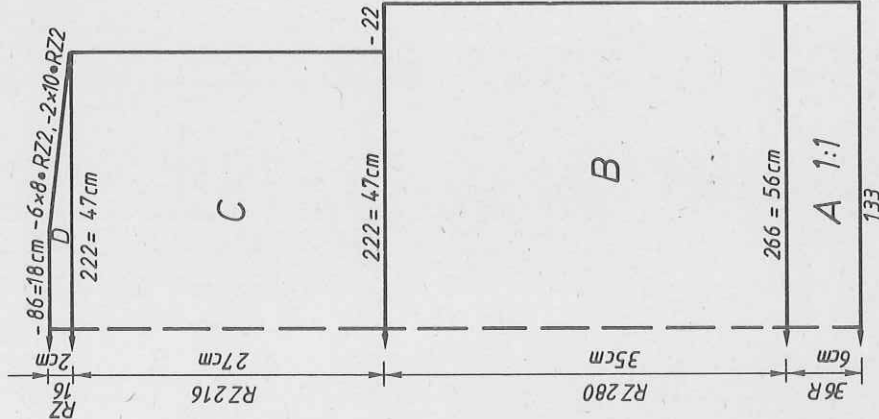

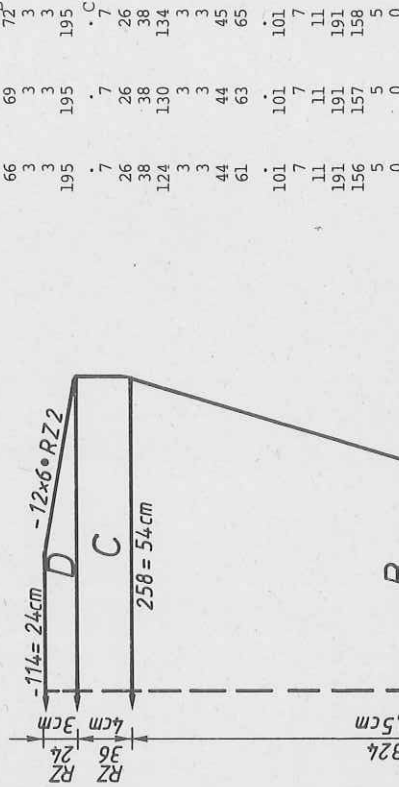
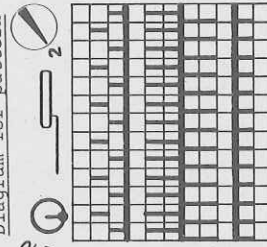


Diagram for pattern

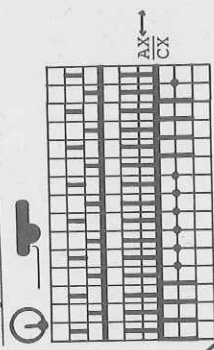

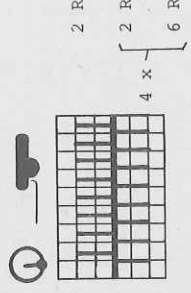
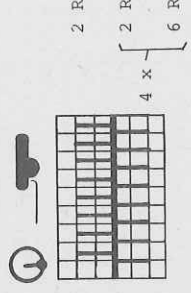


Diagram 2 for pin tuck

- Material : 310 g mixed yarn Acrylic/Viscose (VBS by Schaffhauser Wolle), 105 g shiny Viscose/cotton. Knitting in elastic.
- Stitch size : Pattern = 4 1/2. Welt and sleeve bands = 4. Collar and trimming bands = 8.
- Test square : 100 sts = 43 cm. RC 100 = 21 cm
- Pattern : Acc. to needle diagram and deco punchcard no.16. Welt and sleeve band in 1:1 rib. Collar and trimming band in st.st.

Fig. I : Back
 A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with mixed yarn. B = transfer all sts to back bed, knit in pattern acc. to nd-diagram with deco card, straight. C = dec. at each end, cont. straight. D = shape shoulders at each end. Cast off remaining sts loosely.

Fig. II : Front
 A, B, C as for Fig. I. D = divide work, place left half onto deckercomb, make note of deco card position. Cont to knit right half. Shape neck at left. E = shape shoulder at right. Place left half back onto nds of machine and knit with reversed shapings.

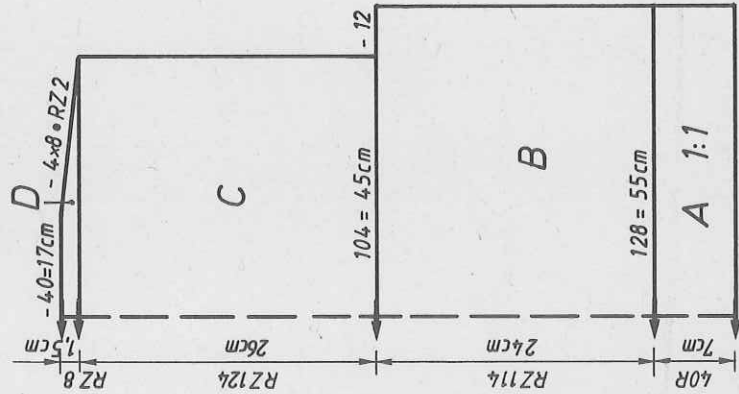

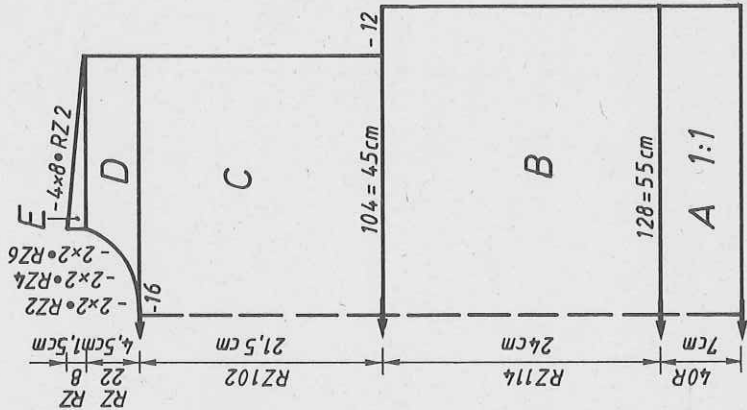
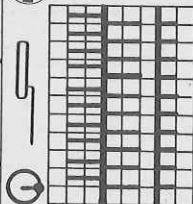


Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with mixed yarn at the same time using the knitting in elastic. B = transfer all sts to back bed, cont. to knit in pattern acc. to nd-diagram with deco card, inc. at each end. C = cont. to knit straight. D = shape sleeve head at each end.

Collar : Knit one piece Single-bed cast on with mixed yarn, 120 sts, knit 20 R. Bring nds into WP on back bed, cont. to knit half tubular RC 10. End with a few R contrast yarn, release.

Trimming band : Knit two pieces Single-bed cast on with mixed yarn, 80 sts, knit 22 R. Cast off loosely. To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew shoulder seams. Join collar, then sew to neck edge first on the outside, st by st, backstitching through the open loops, then on the inside, at the same time unravelling contrast yarn (see photo). With large, loose stitches sew the trimming band to the sleeve head (right side out). With right sides facing, set in sleeve. Sew side seams.

Size : To fit 88 to 92 cm bust

Material : 390 g Chenille black, 320 g Chenille olive, 290 g cotton yarn beige, 180 g cotton thread yellow (taken 3-fold). 5 buttons. 1 pair shoulder pads.

Stitch size : Pattern = front 3, back 4 1/2. Collar, welt, cuffs = 5

Test square : Pattern = 100 sts = 20,5 cm. RC 100 = 6 cm

Pattern : Collar : 100 sts = 27 cm. 100 R = 25 cm

Pattern : 3-coloured Fairisle acc. to needle diagram and col sequence with self-punched deco card. Collar, welt and cuffs = 1:1 rib

Fig. I : Back

A = tubular cast on in 1:1 rib with cotton yarn beige. Bring all nds to WP and cont. to knit in pattern acc. to nd-diagram and col sequence with deco card. B = dec. at each end. When 3 cards have been knitted, position the card reader 20 nds to the right or left. Cont. to knit. C = dec. at each end, cast off.

Fig. II : Front. Knit two parts with reversed shapings

A = Fig. I but with fewer sts. B = dec. at right. When 3 cards have been knitted, shift card reader by 20 nds. C = dec. at left. D = dec. at right.

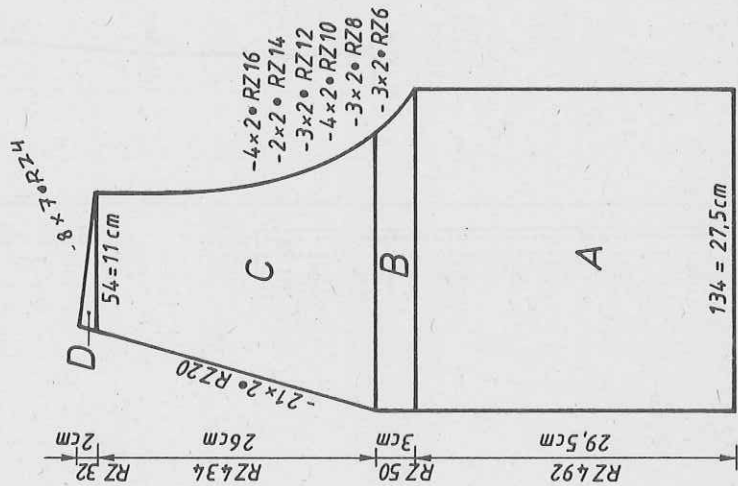
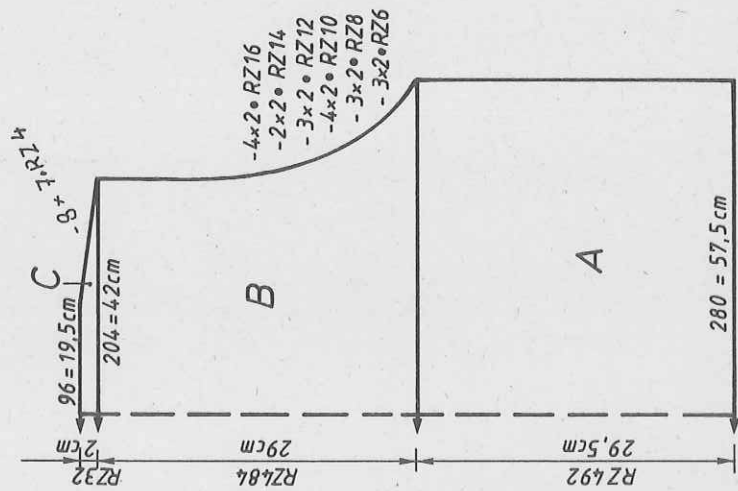

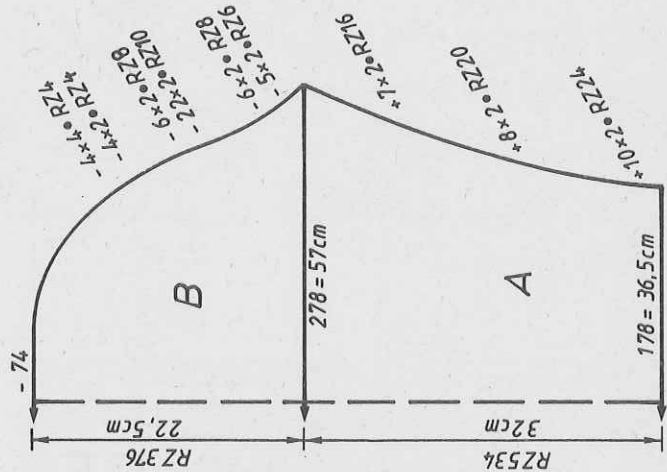

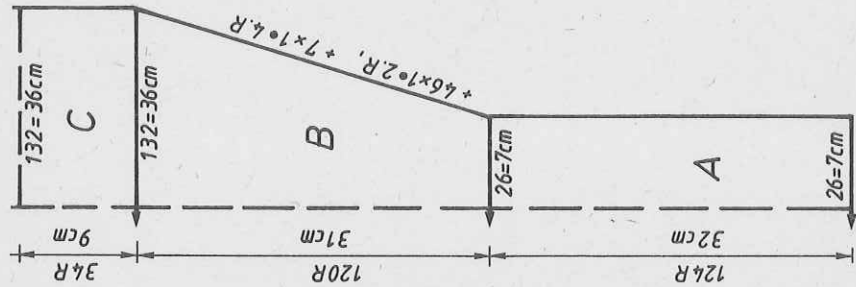


Fig. III : Sleeve, knit two alike

Fig. IV : Collar

A = tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with Chenille black, cont. straight, working buttonholes as follows : across sts 6-8 and 19-21 in R 4, 10, 48, 86 and 124. B = inc. at right. C = cont. straight. Knit D,E,F in reverse order and with reversed shapings, omitting buttonholes.

Cuffs : Knit two alike

Tubular cast on for 1:1 rib with Chenille black with 130 sts. Knit 80 R, cast off.

Welt : Knit one piece

As given for cuff but knitting 300 R.

To make up : Pin parts out to size and leave to dry under a damp cloth. Sew shoulder seams. With right sides facing, sew cuffs in position, gathering sleeve slightly. Set in sleeves, making pleats along sleeve head. Sew side seams. Sew welt into position, gathering main part slightly to fit welt.

Fold cuffs and welt in half to inside and sew on. With right sides facing, sew collar to neck edge, hem to inside. Neaten buttonholes. Attach buttons. Fix shoulder pads.

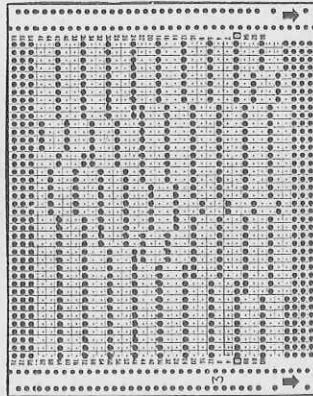
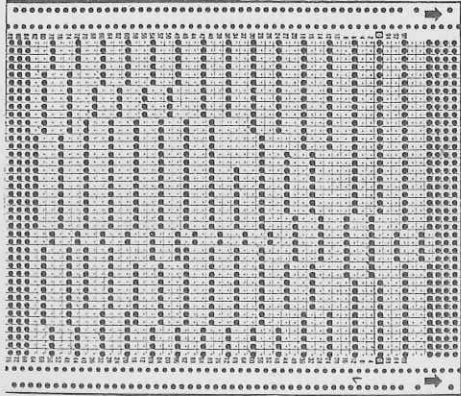
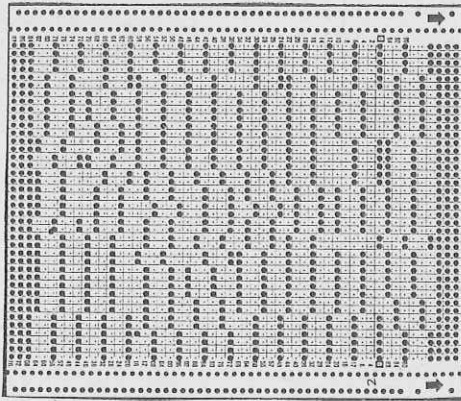
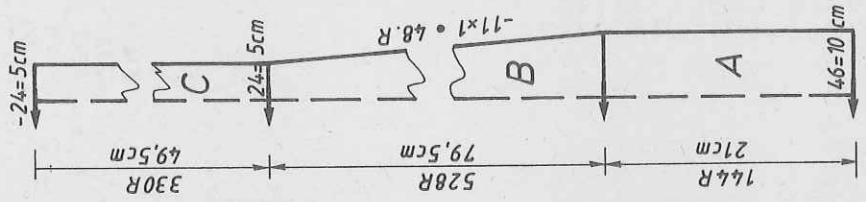
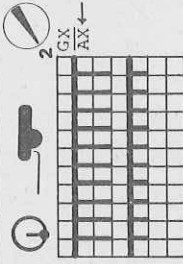

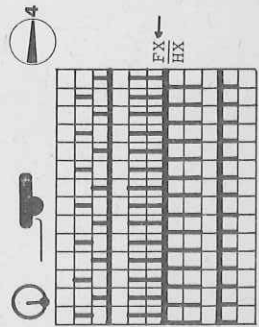
