Foreword

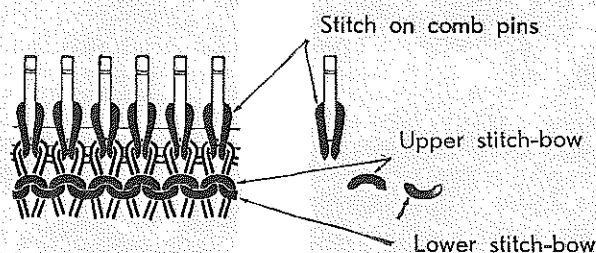
... "It is advisable to knit a test piece before knitting garments from popular pattern leaflets, due to possible variations in the wool. Select the comb to be used and cast on 20 stitches and then knit off 20 rows. This sample piece should then be removed from the comb and laid flat on a table and measured" —

20 stitches = inches, 20 rows = inches. The test piece should be kept until the garment has been completed and thus one is able to very easily calculate the measurements and so adapt the size of popular pattern leaflets for RECORD knitting.

For beginners it is recommended to choose popular hand knitting leaflets which have been already designed to work with 6/7 stitches per inch, as these can be followed stitch by stitch and the garment expertly produced on the RECORD. Thereafter, when the beginner has become more conversant and confident with the use of the machine, any garment can be made from popular knitting leaflets by knitting up a sample piece as suggested at the beginning of this paragraph and adapting the measurements accordingly.

Instructions for Knitting the Lovely Pattern Designs Illustrated in this Book

Before attempting to knit any of the patterns in this book, it is necessary to recognize and be able to distinguish between the following stitches:

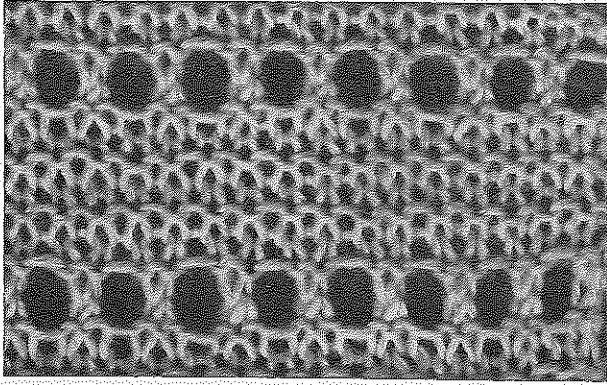


The patterns are accomplished by changing the position of the stitches on the comb pins or by lifting the upper or lower stitch-bows on to the comb pins with the use of the special crochet hook needle.

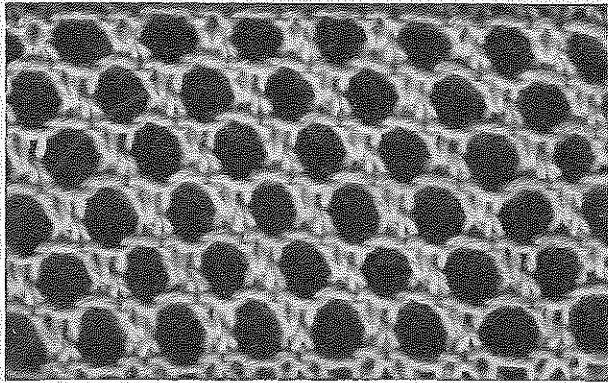
The majority of patterns are worked on the right side of the knitting.

When knitting patterns the tension should be a little looser than normally by making use of the tension adjusters situated on either of the side supports.

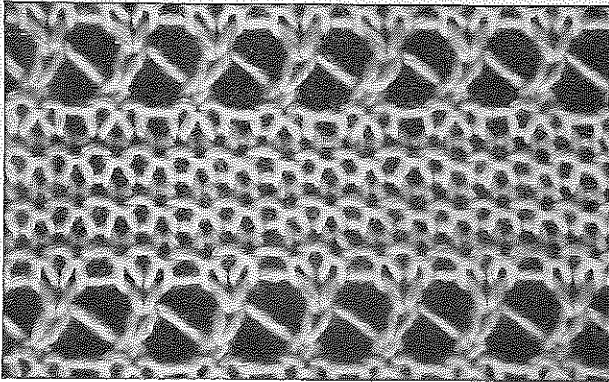
This book contains a number of patterns (greatly enlarged) which can be made both quickly and easily with the "Record" and at the same time they serve as a basis and first suggestion for further self pattern-designing.



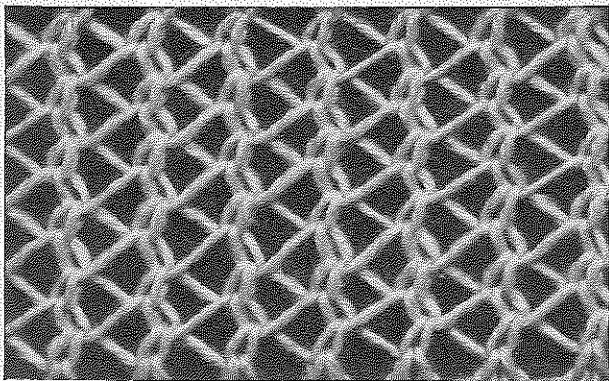
No. 1: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, e. g. 3rd on 4th stitch, skip 1 stitch, 6th on 7th and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Garter Stitch.
 Then repeat 1st and 2nd rows alternately to desired length.



No. 2: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, e. g. 3rd on 4th, skip 1 stitch, 6th on 7th and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Garter Stitch.
 3rd row. Place stitch which is front of the hole on the hole stitch. This is the stitch above the hole and so on, knit off pattern row.
 4th row. Garter Stitch.
 Then repeat from 1st row to desired length.

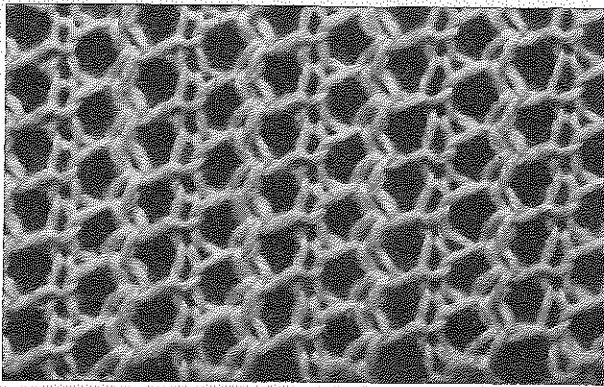


No. 3: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, e. g. 3rd on 4th 5th on 6th and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Place stitch which is front of the hole on the hole stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.
 3rd to 7th row. All Garter. Stitch and then repeat process from the 1st row to desired length.



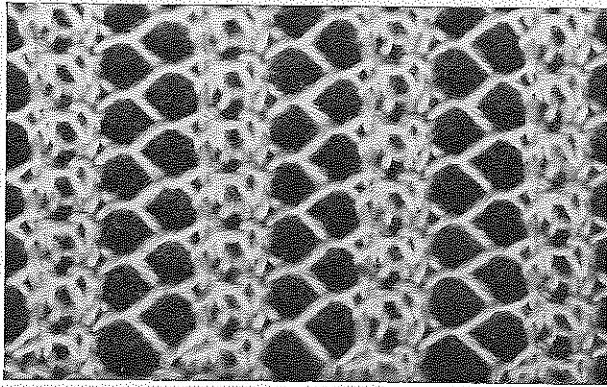
No. 4: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, e. g. 3rd on 4th, 5th on 6th and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Place stitch which is in front of the hole on the hole stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

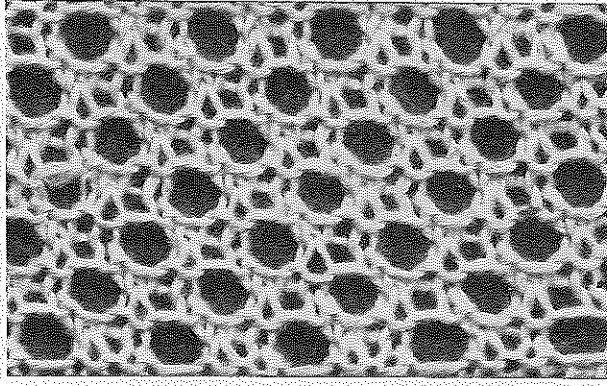
No. 5: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, skip 1 stitch, place 2 stitches together and then e. g. 3rd on 4th, 6th on 7th and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Place stitch which is in front of the hole on the holiestitch and so on, knit off pattern row.



No. 6: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, skip stitches, e. g. 3rd on 4th, 7th on 8th and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Place stitch following the hole stitch on the next stitch and so on, knit off pattern row. Continue this 2nd row to desired length.

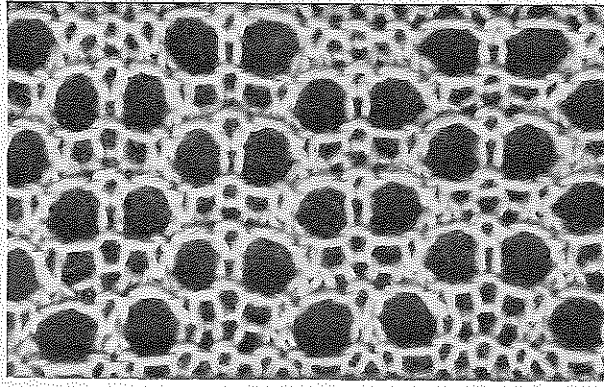


No. 7: 1st row. Place 2 stitches together, skip 1 stitch, place 2 stitches together and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place stitch which is in front of the hole onto the holiestitch, skip 1 stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.
Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to desired length.

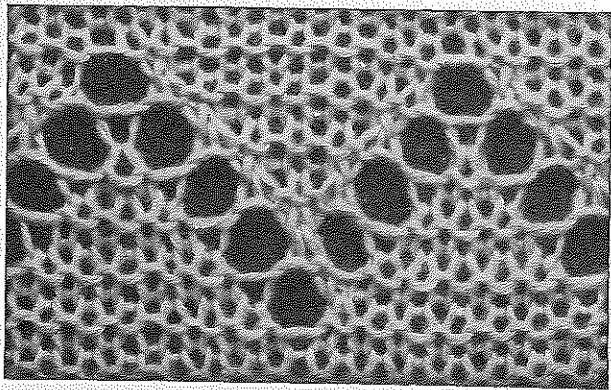


No. 8: 1st row. Place 1 stitch on the stitch to the left, skip 1 stitch and place 1 stitch on the stitch to the right, skip 1 stitch, place 1 stitch on the stitch to the left, e. g. 4th on 3rd, 6th on 7th, 10th on 9th and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place the stitch following the second holiestitch on the stitch to the left, skip 1 stitch, and place the next stitch on to the holiestitch to the right and so on, e. g. 7th on 6th, 9th on 10th, 13th on 12th and so on.

4th row. Garter Stitch.
Repeat from 1st row to desired length.



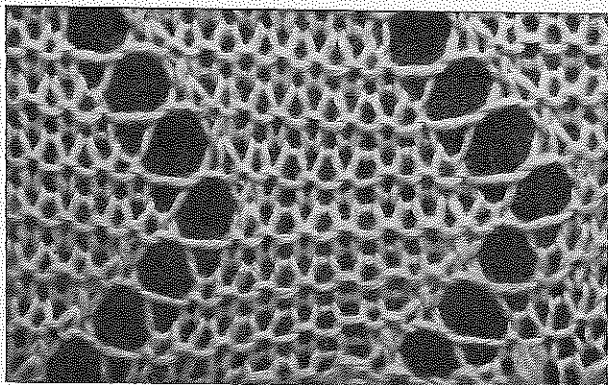
No. 9: 1st row. Skip 10 stitches, place 2 stitches together, e. g. 11th on 12th, skip 10 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place the stitch which is on the left of the hole-stitch on the stitch to the left, place the stitch to the right of the hole on to the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately until holes meet in one hole.



No. 10: 1st row. Skip 6 stitches, place 2 stitches together, e. g. 7th on 8th, skip 6 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place stitch next to the hole-stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

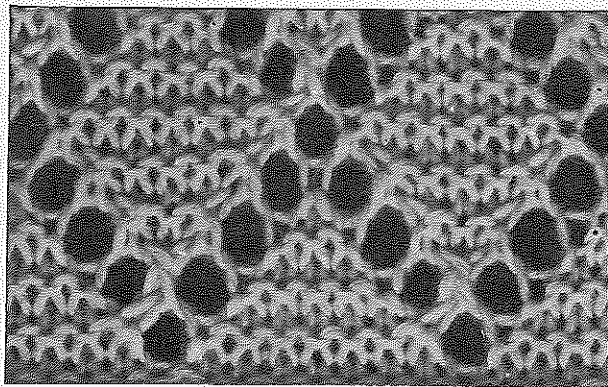
4th row. Garter Stitch.

Continue 3rd and 4th rows alternately until 6 hole rows have been worked.

13th row. Place stitch on the left of the hole-stitch to the left and so on, knit off pattern row.

14th row. Garter Stitch.

Continue 13th and 14th rows alternately until 5 hole rows have been worked. Repeat from 1st row to desired length.



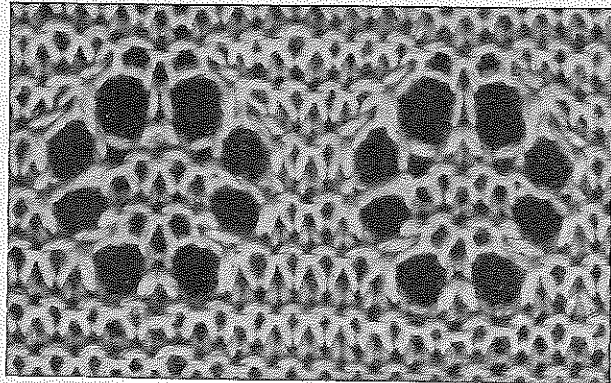
No. 11: 1st row. Skip 6 stitches, place 2 stitches together, e. g. 7th on 8th, skip 6 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place the stitch which is on the left of the hole-stitch on the stitch to the left, place the stitch to the right of the hole on to the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately until holes meet in one hole.



No. 12: 1st row. Skip 6 stitches, place 2 stitches together to the left, e. g. 8th on 7th, skip 1 stitch place 2 stitches together to the right, e. g. 10th on 11th, skip 6 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place the stitch on the left side of the hole-stitch to the left, skip 3 stitches, place the stitch to the right side of the hole-stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

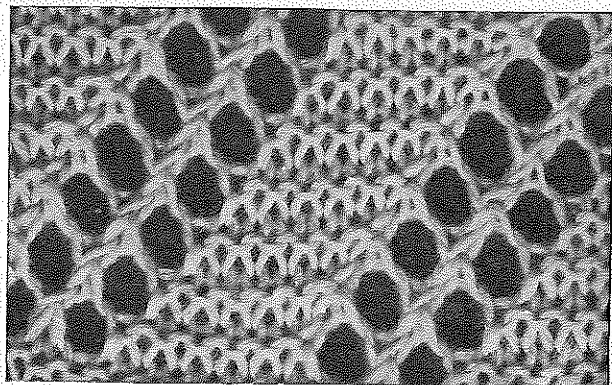
4th row. Garter Stitch.

5th row. Place the hole-stitch on the stitch to the left, skip 3 stitches, place the hole-stitch on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

6th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat as from 1st row to desired length.

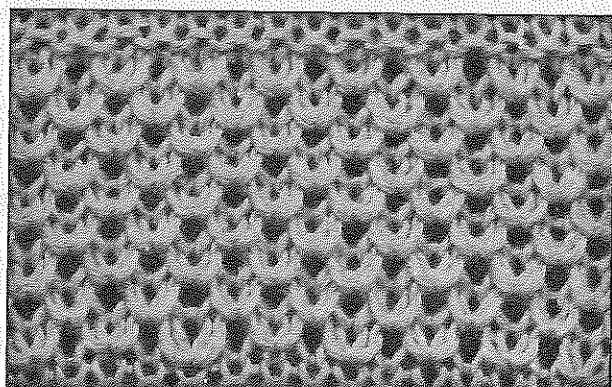
No. 13: 1st row. Skip 6 stitches, place 2 stitches together, e. g. 7th on 8th, place again next 2 stitches together, e. g. 9th on 10th, skip 6 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place stitch which is on the right side of the first hole on the second hole-stitch, place the stitch which is on the right side of the second hole again to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat from 1st row to desired length.



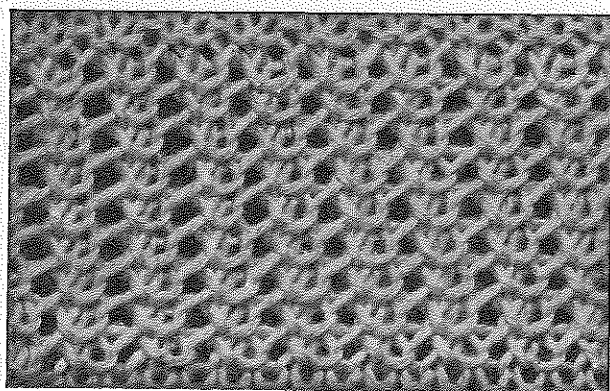
No. 14: 1st row. Place the upper stitch-bow over its own stitch, skip 1 stitch; place the next upper stitch bow over its own stitch and so on; knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Lift the single (not double) upper stitch-bow over its own stitch, skip the double stitch-bow and so on; knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat from 1st row to desired length.



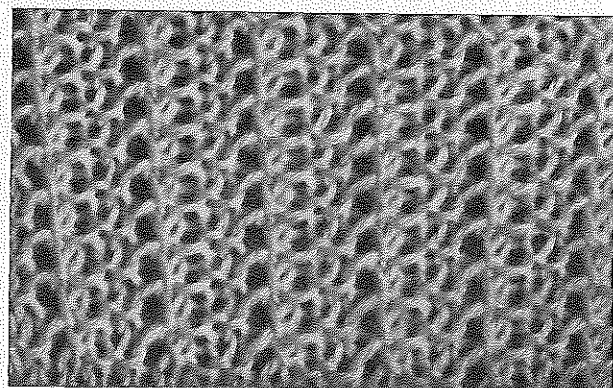
No. 15: 1st row. Place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, skip 1 upper stitch-bow, place next upper stitch-bow to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place single upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to the desired length.



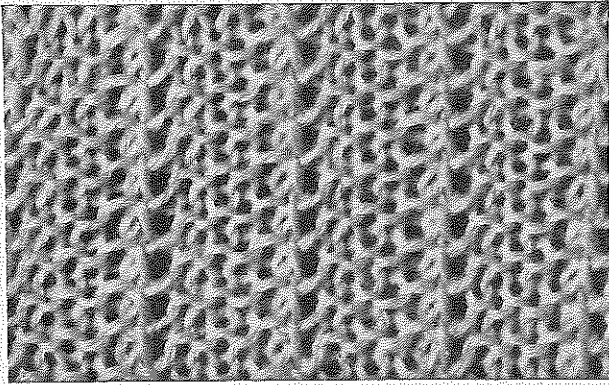
No. 16: 1st row. Place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, skip 2 upper stitch-bows, place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place single stitch-bow which is left of the double stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to the desired length.



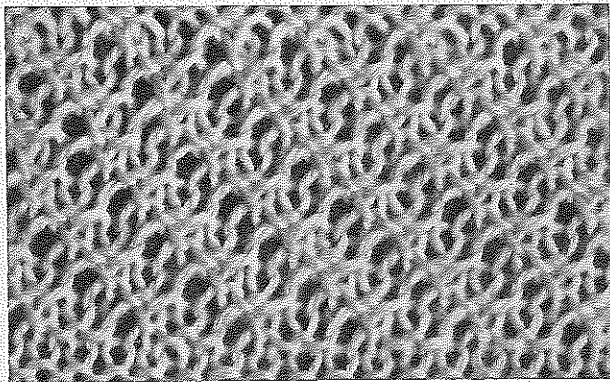
No. 17: 1st row. Place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, skip 3 upper stitch-bows, place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place single stitch-bow which is left of the double stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to the desired length.



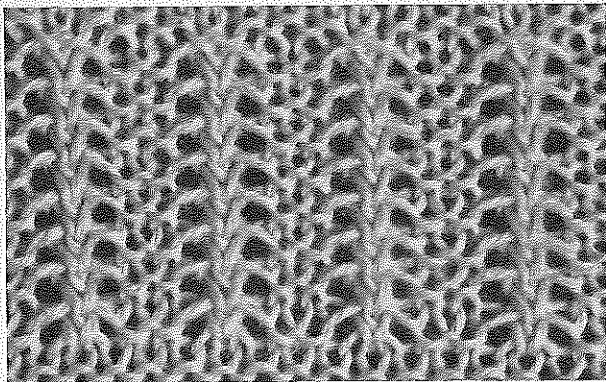
No. 18: 1st row. Place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, skip 2 stitches, place upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place single upper stitch-bow which is to the right of the double stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to the desired length.



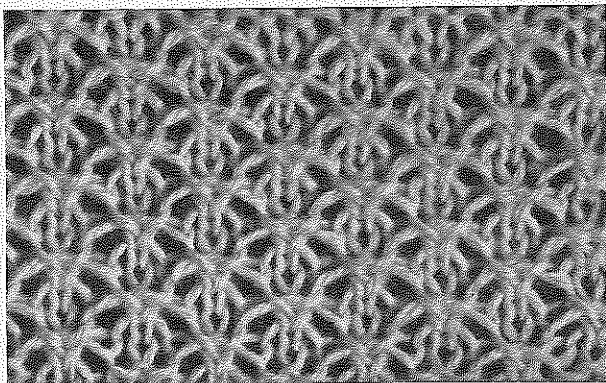
No. 19: 1st row. Place first upper stitch-bow to the right, place 3 upper stitch-bows on the next stitch to the left, skip 1 upper stitch-bow and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place the stitch-bow on either side of the double stitch-bow on to the middle stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to desired length.



No. 20: 1st row. Place second upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, lift the third upper stitch-bow to the left and place on the same comb pin, skip 1 upper stitch-bow and so on, knit off pattern row.

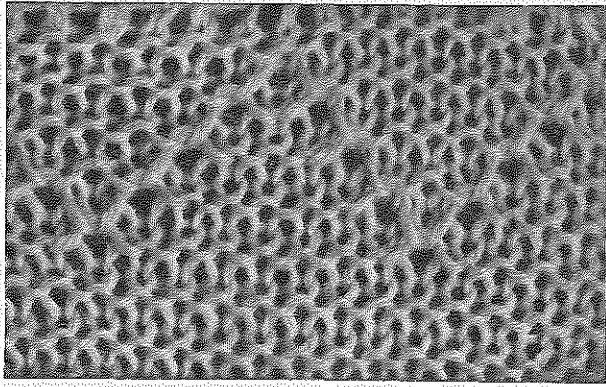
2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place first upper stitch-bow which is to the right of the double stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and the third upper stitch-bow on the same stitch to the left and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to desired length.

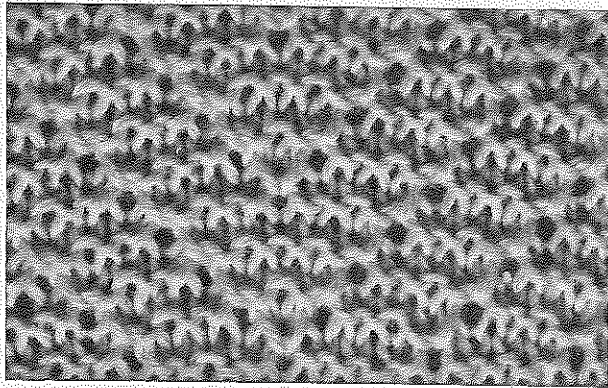
No. 21: 1st row. Skip 6 stitches, lift 7th upper stitch-bow over its own stitch, skip 7 stitches, lift every 8th upper stitch-bow over its own stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Skip 5 stitches, lift 6th upper stitch-bow over its own stitch, skip 1 upper stitch-bow, lift the next upper stitch-bow over its own stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

5th row. Similar to 3rd row but decreasing, e. g. skip 4 stitches, lift 5th upper stitch-bow over its own stitch and so on until stitches meet, remembering to knit a row of Garter Stitch between pattern rows.

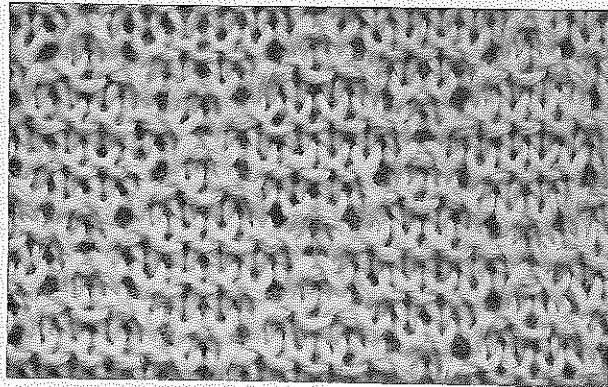


No. 22: 1st row. Start from the centre of the row. lift the centre upper stitch-bow over its own stitch, skip 4 stitches and lift the next upper stitch-bow over its own stitch and so on. The foregoing should be worked left and right of the centre of the row, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Start from the centre of the row, lift over the single stitch-bow found after the double stitch-bow over its own stitch, the foregoing should be worked left and right of the centre of the row and so on, knit off pattern row.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately to desired length.

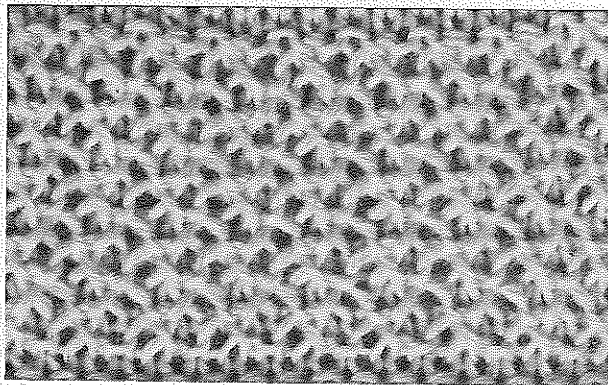


No. 23: 1st row. Skip 7 stitches, lift over next upper stitch-bow over its own stitch, skip 7 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Lift the single upper stitch-bow on either side of the double stitch-bow over its own stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately until the stitches meet and continue to desired length.



No. 24: 1st row. Place every 2nd upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

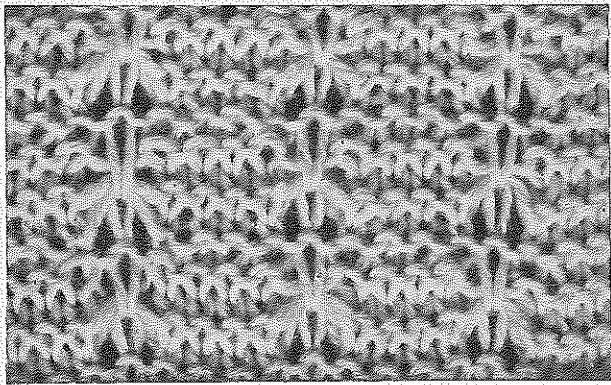
2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Lift over single upper stitch-bow over its own stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

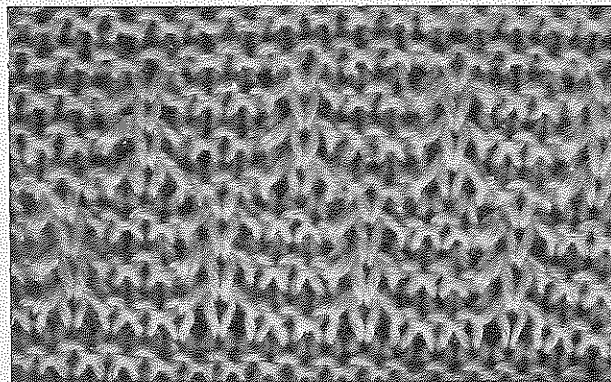
5th row. Place every single upper stitch-bow over the stitch to the left and so on, knit off pattern row.

Repeat pattern from the 2nd row to desired length.



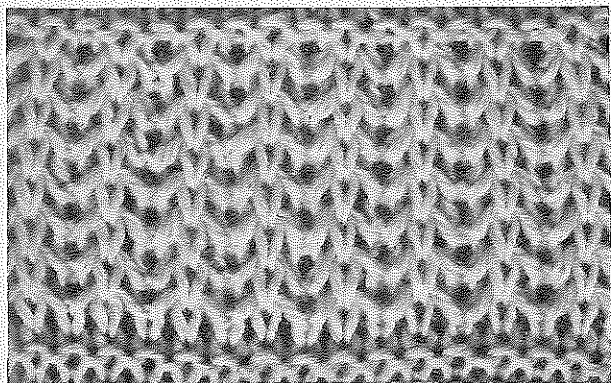
No. 25: Rows 1—4. Garter Stitch.

5th row. Skip 4 stitches, let drop the 5th stitch over 3 rows and hang up these 3 spans and the dropped stitch, skip 4 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.
Repeat from 1st row to desired length.



No. 26: 1—6 rows. Garter Stitch.

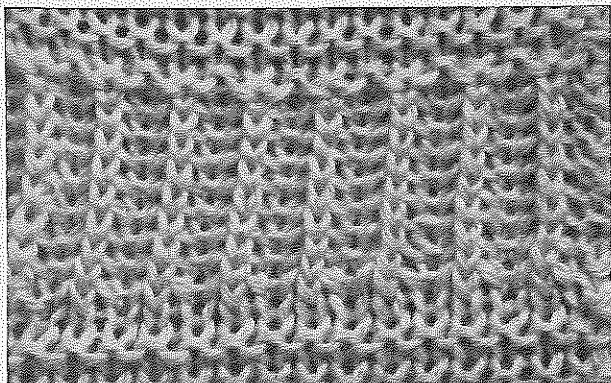
7th row. Skip 3 stitches, drop the 4th stitch over all of the 6 rows, skip the upper span and crochet the dropped stitch through the lower span only, skip 1 stitch and so on.
Repeat from beginning to desired length.



No. 27: 1—6 rows. Garter Stitch.

7th row. Skip 3 stitches, drop the 4th stitch over all of the 6 rows, skip the upper stitch-bow and crochet the dropped stitch straight through the lower span, skip 1 stitch and so on.

8—13th rows. Garter Stitch.
Continue as above, but skip 2 stitches, drop 3 stitches so as to transfer the pattern to the centre and so on.
Repeat from the beginning to desired length.



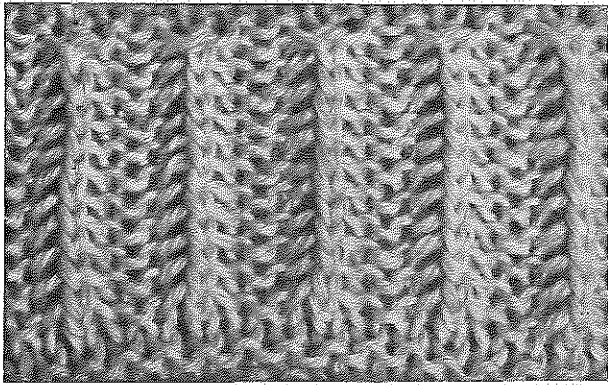
No. 28: 1st row. Lift over the 1st and 2nd lower stitch-bow over the centre stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

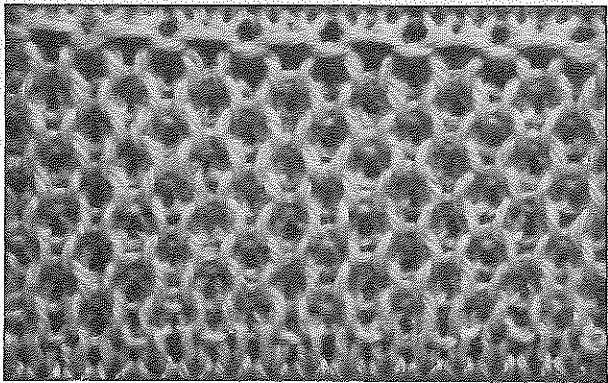
3rd row. Lift the lower stitch-bow left and right from the thick upper stitch-bow over the stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.
Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to desired length.

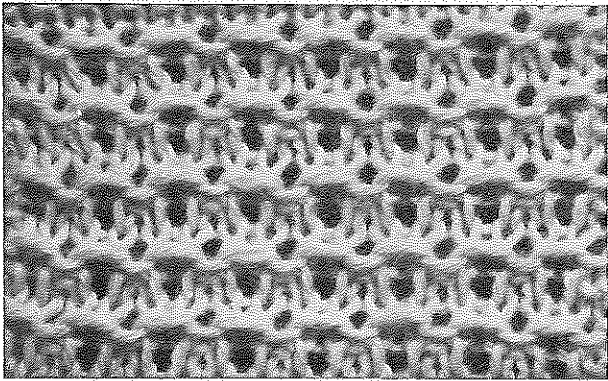

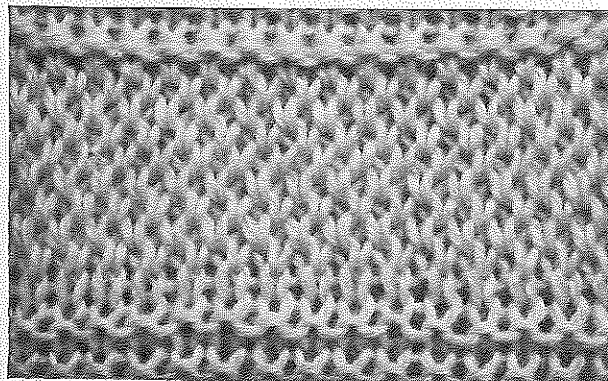
No. 29: 1st row. Lift every 2nd and 3rd lower stitch-bow over the centre stitch, skip 1 lower stitch-bow and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Garter Stitch.
 3rd row. Lift the lower stitch-bow from the left to the right of the upper stitch-bow over the centre stitch-bow and so on, knit off pattern row.
 4th row. Garter Stitch.
 Repeat from beginning to desired length.



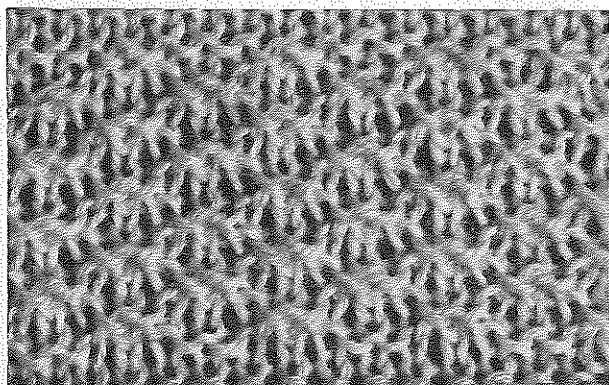
No. 30: 1st row. Lift every 2nd lower stitch-bow over the left and right stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Garter Stitch.
 3rd row. Lift every lower stitch-bow over 2 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.
 4th row. Garter Stitch.
 Repeat from beginning to desired length.



No. 31: 1st row. Lift every 2nd lower stitch-bow over the left and right stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2—4th row. Garter Stitch.
 Repeat from beginning to desired length.



No. 32: 1st row. Lift every lower stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.
 2nd row. Garter Stitch.
 3rd row. Lift every lower stitch-bow on the stitch to the left and so on, knit off pattern row.
 4th row. Garter Stitch.
 Repeat from beginning to desired length.

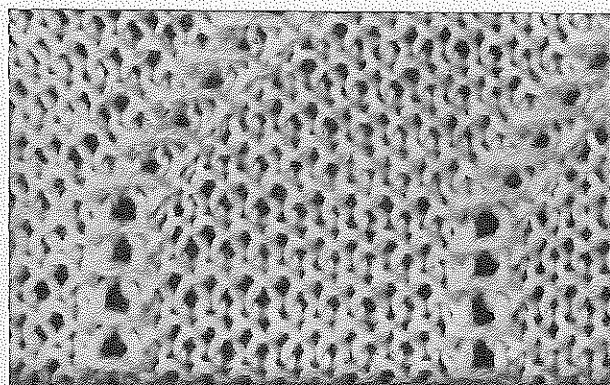


No. 33: 1st row. Lift every 3rd and 4th lower stitch-bow over the centre stitch, skip 2 lower stitch-bows and again lift the 3rd and 4th lower stitch-bow over the centre stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Working from the centre of each pattern, lift the 2nd and 3rd lower stitch-bow over the centre stitch and so on, knit off pattern row.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows to desired length.

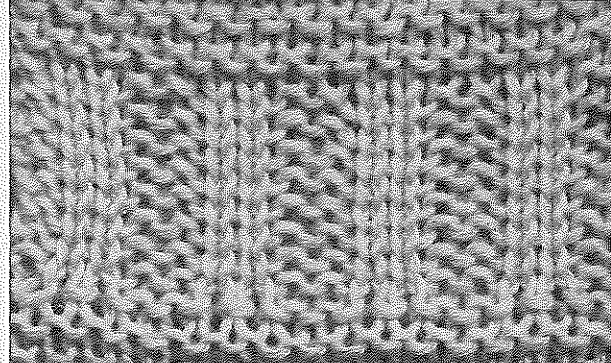


No. 34: 1st row. Skip 9 stitches and then lift the 1st lower stitch-bow over 2 stitches and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 1st and 2nd rows alternately to desired length.

If diagonal pattern is desired, transfer the pattern over 1 lower stitch-bow to the right and so on, knit off pattern row, then a row of Garter Stitch and repeat to desired length.

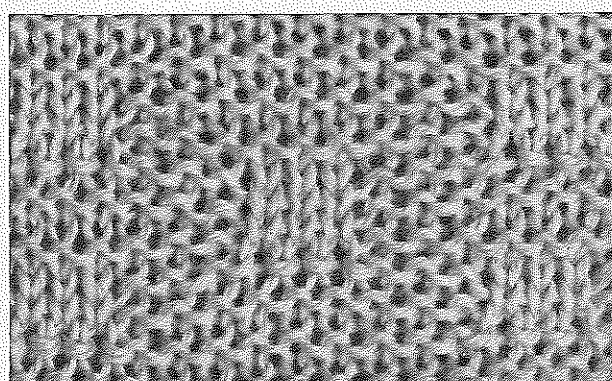


No. 35: 1—16 rows. Garter Stitch.

Crochet up the upper stitch-bow of the lowest row and then hang this on to the comb pin.

Repeat again with the next upper stitch-bow, skip 2 stitches and so on.

Repeat from beginning to desired length.



No. 36: 1—8th rows. Garter Stitch.

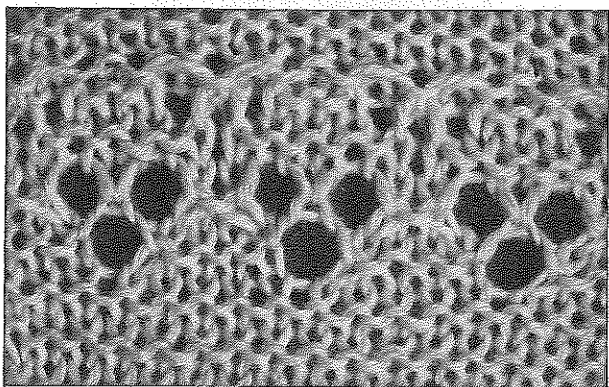
Following Pattern No. 35, crochet up 3 successive stitches, skip 9 stitches and so on

9—12th rows. Garter Stitch.

Then crochet up the stitches in the centre of each pattern and so on.

Repeat from beginning to desired length.

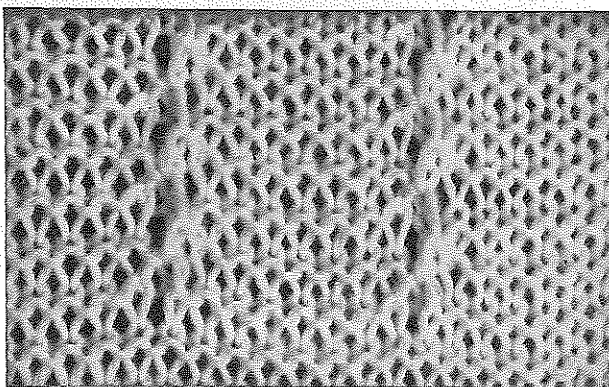
No. 37: 1st row. Place every 6th stitch on the next stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place every stitch from the left side of the hole to the left and every stitch on the right side of the hole to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

4 — 6th rows. Garter Stitch.

7th row. Lift the lower stitch-bow over 2 stitches above the left hole skip 2 lower stitch-bows and so on, knit off pattern row.
Repeat from beginning to desired length.



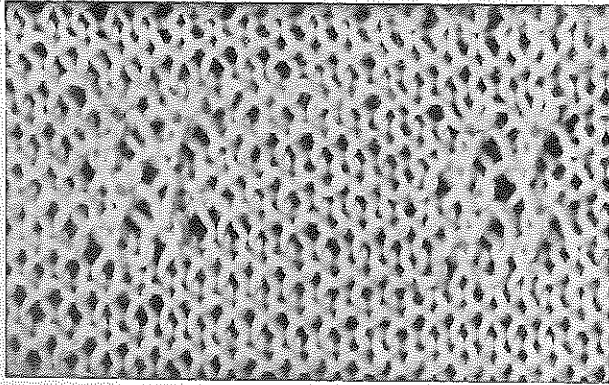
No. 38: 1st row. Skip 6 stitches, place lower stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Skip 6 stitches, place the lower stitch-bow on the stitch to the left and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat from beginning to desired length.



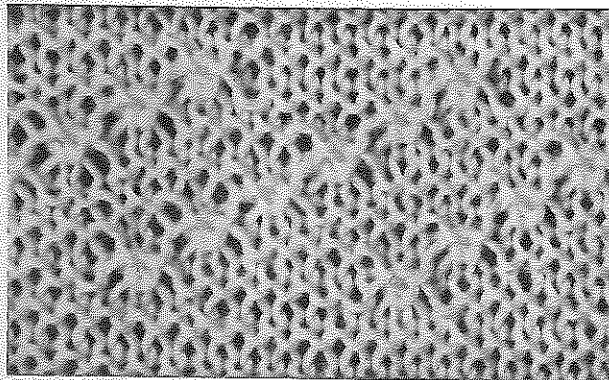
No. 39: 1st row. Place 1 upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, skip 1 upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right, skip 8 upper stitch-bows, place 1 upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the right and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Place 1 upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the left, skip 1 upper stitch-bow, place 1 upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the left, skip 8 upper stitch-bows, place 1 upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the left and so on, knit off pattern row.

4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat from beginning to desired length.



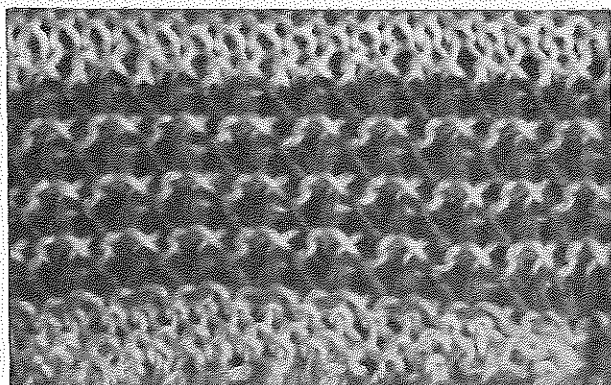
No. 40: 1st row. Place 1 upper stitch-bow to the right and 3rd upper stitch-bow on the stitch to the left, skip 5 upper stitch-bows and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Skip the first 2 upper stitch-bows and continue as 1st row.

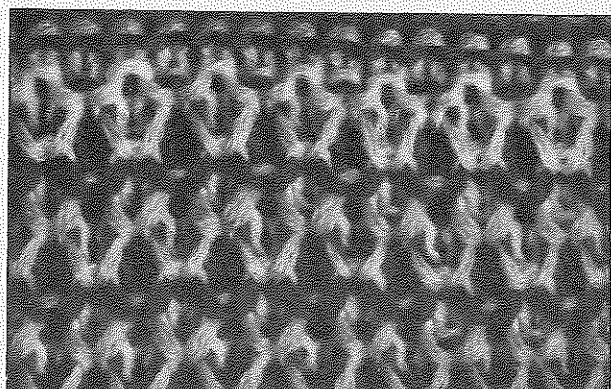
4th row. Garter Stitch.

Repeat 3rd and 4th rows alternately to desired length.



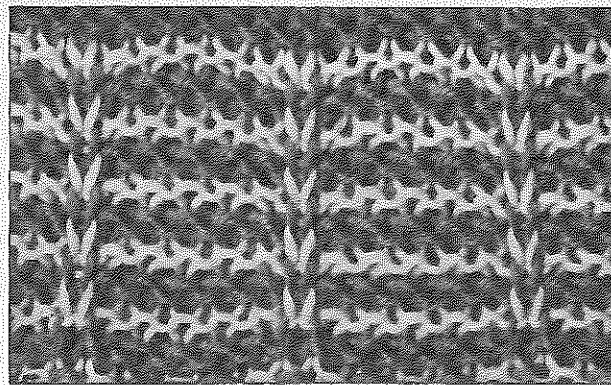
No. 41: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 24.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



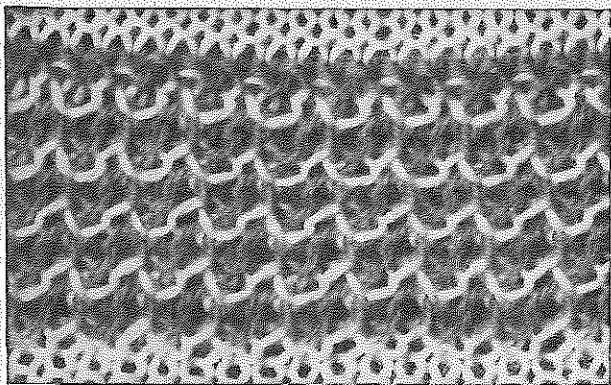
No. 42: Three-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 14.
Care should be taken that the second and third colours are always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



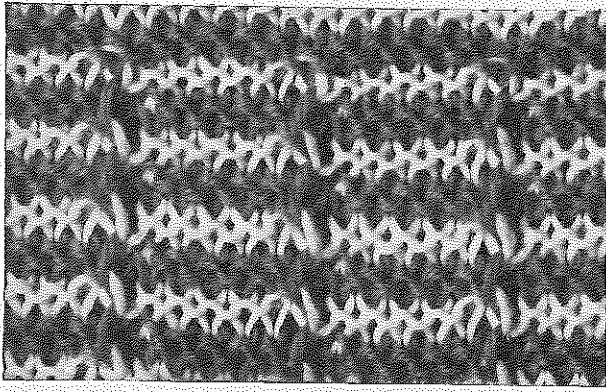
No. 43: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 35.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



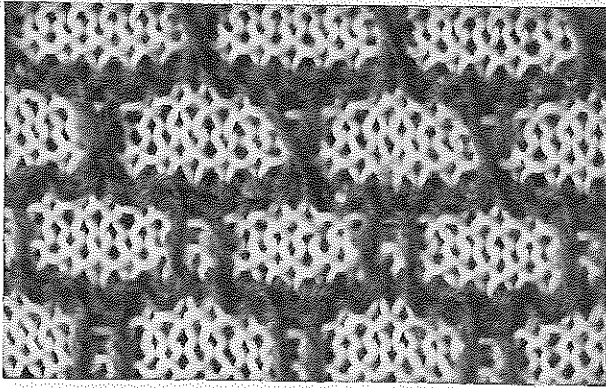
No. 44: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 15.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



No. 45: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 38.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



No. 46: Two-coloured pattern.

Note — Succession of colours: 2 rows dark colour, 4 rows main colour.

Care should be taken that BOTH colours are started on the reverse side of the work.

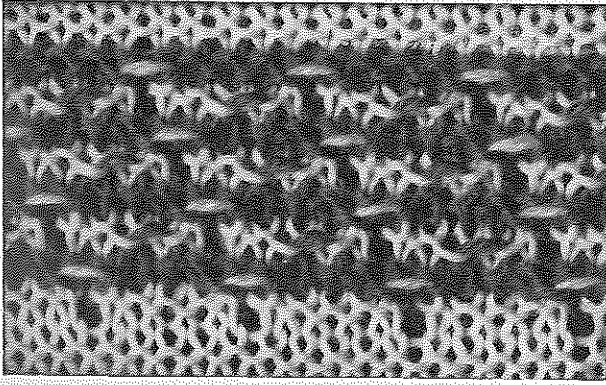
1 — 7 rows. Garter Stitch.

8th row. Lift up first upper stitch-bow over 2 ribs (4 rows), skip 3 upper stitch-bows and so on, knit off pattern row.

9 — 13th rows. Garter Stitch.

14th row. Similar to 8th row, but lift the upper stitch-bow found in the centre of each pattern over its own stitch.

The upper stitch-bow to be lifted may be hung straight over the comb pins or may be twisted to form a variation of the pattern. Repeat from 2nd row to desired length.



No. 47: Two-coloured pattern.

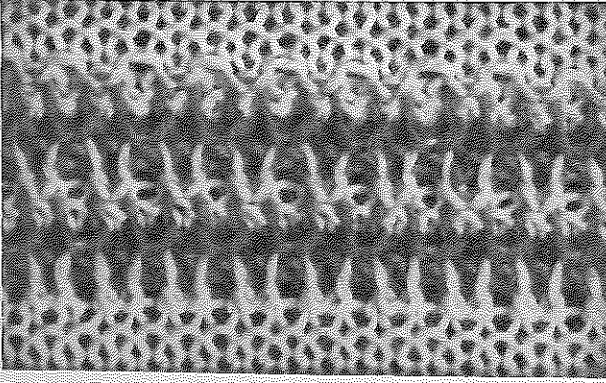
1st row. Lift the 1st lower stitch-bow over 2 stitches, skip 3 lower stitch-bows and so on, knit off pattern row.

2nd row. Garter Stitch.

3rd row. Lift middle lower stitch-bow over 2 stitches, skip 3 lower stitch-bows and so on, knit off pattern row.

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows alternately to desired length.

Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



No. 48: Two-coloured pattern.

1 — 4th rows. Garter Stitch.

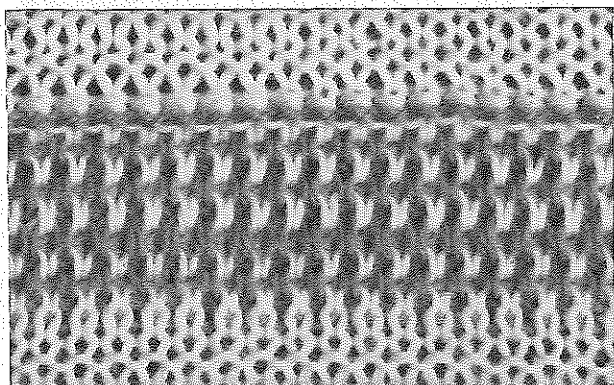
5th row. Lift up every second upper stitch-bow over 1 rib (2 rows), knit off pattern row.

6 — 8th rows. Garter Stitch.

9th row. Lift every single upper stitch-bow over 1 rib (2 rows) and knit off pattern row. Repeat from 6th row to desired length.

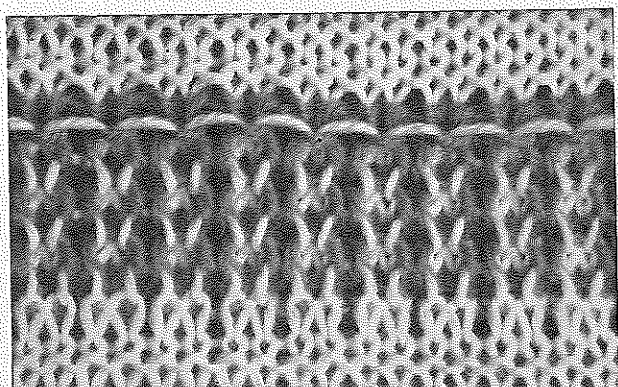
Succession of colours: Begin with ground colour, insert second colour 4 times and ground colour 4 times.

Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



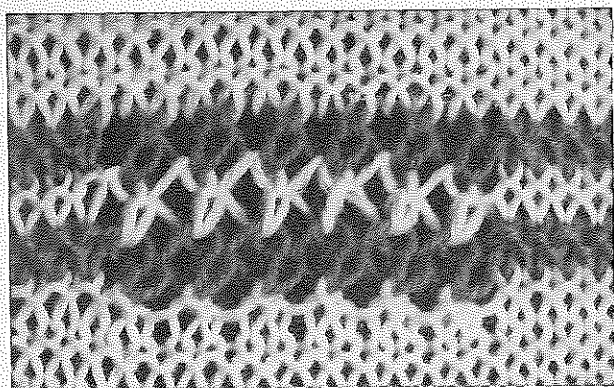
No. 49: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 32.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.



No. 50: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 30.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.

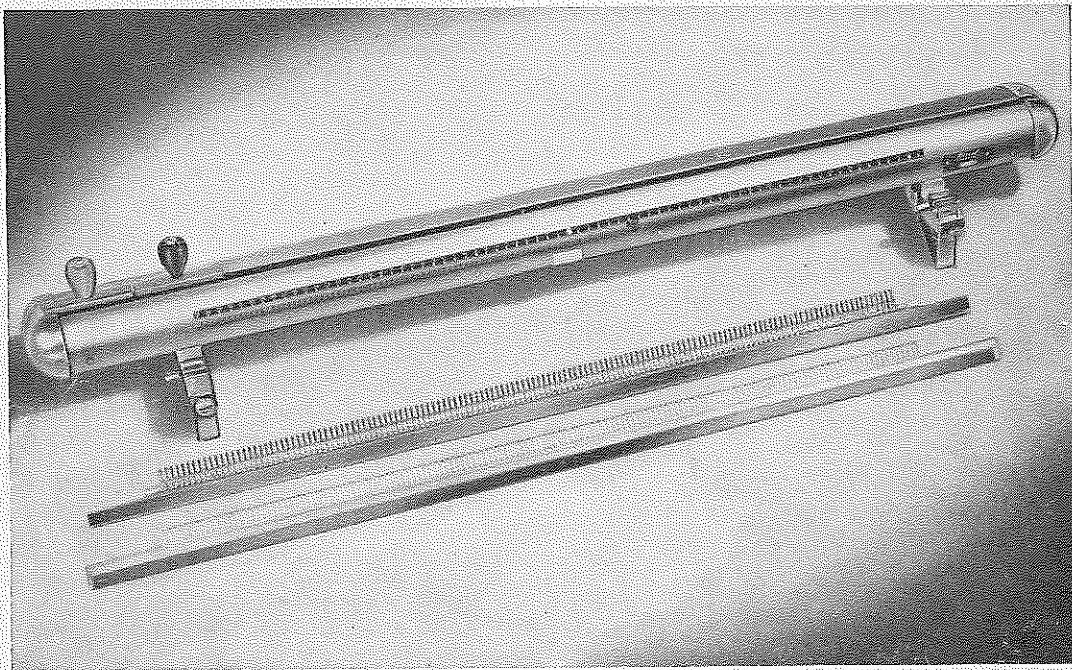


No. 51: Two-coloured pattern.

Worked according to Pattern No. 4.
Care should be taken that the second colour is always started on the reverse side of the work, always insert the same colour twice in succession.
