


PATTERN FOR DIAMOND TIE KNITTING TIME - 15 Min.



PATTERN FOR DIAMOND TIE

MATERIAL: Crochet Wool, 11/2 Balls

1¼ Ball, Color A ¼ Ball, Color B

Tension 1

Cast on 43 stitches, knit straight 90 rows. From 91 start pattern, knitting with 2 balls color A, 1 ball color B. Lay yarn across the first 21 needles. Color B across 1 needle and the remaining 21 with Color A. Knit diamond over 15 needles, making sure to twist yarn as to avoid holes. When the first diamond is completed, start second on following row, knit diamond over 13 needles, start third diamond on following row. Knit third diamond over 11 needles.

(DURING YOUR PATTERN, DECREASE ONE STITCH AT BOTH SIDES AS FOLLOWS):

Row 261 – 463 knit straight up on 25. Start to increase. From row 464 increase 1 stitch on both sides every 12th row 6 times and knit straight up on 37 needles until row 676, bind off.

Finishing:

Fold side edges and weave together. Steam with seam in back center. Sew ends with blind stitch together.

Size:

Tie should measure 53 inches.

PATTERN FOR SEPARATED DIAMONDS

Proceed as above. However, start 1st diamond at row 60 and knit 30 rows even between each diamond.
