
The patterns in this book are designed to show you the versatility of the Bond Ribber - with simplicity in mind! Here are nine more rib stitch ideas for the more adventurous knitter. Your Bond Ribber offers limitless creative possibilities of which these are just a few - why not create your own.



## DROP STITCH RIDGES

Transfer all stitches onto Ribber bed.

Rows 1 - 6: Knit on Ribber bed only.

Row


 Introduce every corresponding needle on main bed into Working Position with latches open. Knit row. Press off every needle on main bed to give drop stitch.

Row 8

8: Knit on Ribber bed only.

Repeat rows 7 and 8 twice more.


These 12 rows are repeated throughout.



## 2 x 1 RIBBED STRIPES


This is a 3 stitch repeat.

Rows 1 - 4: Transfer the 1st and then every following 3rd stitch onto Ribber bed below.




Rows 5 - 8: Leave rib stitches in place.

Transfer the 3rd stitch and
every following 3rd stitch
onto Ribber bed as below.



Rows 9 - 12: Transfer all rib stitches back onto main bed and knit on main bed only.



### CABLE

Worked over 6 stitches.


Start with all stitches on Ribber bed then transfer stitches for cables in groups of six back onto main bed. Use a Keyplate on main bed one size larger than on Ribber bed.

Rows 1 - 7: Knit.

Row

8: Pull Ribber bed down so that it rests on the top of the metal clamps. Using the transfer tools, transfer the 3 stitches on the left of the main bed needles over the 3 stitches on the right, thus forming the cable. Push Ribber bed back to knitting position. Push the main bed needles into Working Position with stitches behind open latches and knit row slowly.

The 8 rows form the pattern and are repeated throughout.



## EIFFEL TOWER STITCH

This is a 4 stitch repeat.

Start with all stitches on main bed only.

Rows 1 - 6: Place the 1st and then every following 4th stitch onto the adjacent left hand needle. Pick up loop between each transferred stitch and hook over opposite rib needle as below.



X = 2 stitches on one needle V = loop transferred onto Ribber bed.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

Rows 7 - 12: Place the 3rd and then every following 4th stitch onto adjacdent left hand needle. Pick up loop between each transferred stitch and hook over opposite rib needle as below.



Main bed Ribber bed

Transfer rib stitches back to main bed.

These 12 rows form the pattern and are repeated throughout.

## OPEN EDGE CAST ON

This method is particularly useful when you wish to produce a tighter rib at the bottom of a garment by using an increased number of stitches for the body.

Start by casting on using the open-edge cast on method on the main bed and knit several rows in waste yarn. Remove usual carriage, attach Ribber (see page 3 of Instruction Book) and transfer stitches as required for the rib stitch pattern you wish to knit. Select the relevant Keyplates, thread main yarn through Ribber carriage and you are ready to start knitting the body.

Note: Do not knit the rows of waste yarn in rib as ribbed fabrics will only unravel from the last row knitted.

## KNITTING A RIB ONTO AN OPEN-EDGE CAST ON

With wrong side of work facing, hook the first row of open loops in main varn back onto main bed needles (you may wish to place two stitches onto one needle several times across the row to reduce the width further). Remove waste varn. Hang weighted hem so that hem and stitches are infront of latches. Attach Ribber, select Keyplates one size smaller than those used for body and thread main yarn through Ribber carriage. Knit one row with all stitches on main bed. Transfer stitches for 1 x 1 rib (every alternate stitch) onto Ribber. Knit the number of rows required to give the correct length of rib. Cast off in chain stitch (see page 5, No 3, of the Instruction Book).

An alternative method of casting off is to transfer all rib stitches back onto main bed. Remove Ribber bed and cast off in back stitch in usual way.

## ALTERNATIVE CLOSED-EDGE CAST ON

Using the closed-edge cast on method for main bed (see Book 3, page 3, A & B), cast on the required number of stitches on the main bed only - remember to thread yarn through Ribber carriage first. Hang weighted hem and using usual carriage with a Keyplate one size smaller than the one to be used for body, knit 1 row. Attach Ribber, select keyplates as before and position Ribber carriage. Transfer stitches for 1 x 1 rib (every alternate stitch). Knit the number of rows required for rib.

### **BUTTONHOLES**

To form a buttonhole over a ribbed fabric, take a length of waste yarn about 15 cms long and knit manually over the number of stitches required for the buttonhole (usually 3 or 4 stitches depending upon the size of button to be used). Using the hook tool, pull the ends of the waste yarn down between the needle beds and continue to knit in rib until the next buttonhole.


To finish off, remove the waste yarn and with right side facing, back stitch through the bottom and then the top row of open loops using main yarn. Sew in ends of yarn neatly.

## INCREASING AT BOTH ENDS OF A ROW

Transfer the end stitch onto the next needle (either onto the main bed or the Ribber bed depending upon the type of rib pattern being knitted). Using the hook tool, pick up the loop below the second stitch and place on the empty needle. (See Book 3, page 10 of main bed Instruction Books).



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## LADY'S CABLE AND RIB SWEATER



#### **BACK AND FRONT ALIKE**

#### CENTRE PANEL

Make 2.

Note: The purl side of this fabric is the right side. Set machine up with Ribber then remove Ribber from brackets. Thread WY through Ribber carriage and pull through plenty of slack yarn. Thread through main carriage in the usual way. Using the open edge cast on method and WY, cast on 28 (32, 38, 40) sts and k several rows using Keyplate 2.

Remove main carriage and place Ribber back onto brackets. Transfer sts for 2 x 1 rib as below:

#### Shape Neck

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next 2 rows. Cast off 2(2,3,3) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Cast off 1(1,2,2) sts at beg of next 2 rows. Dec 1 st at both ends of next row and the 3 foll alt rows. 52(56,58,60) sts. K 19 rows. COR.

Transfer rib sts to main bed Remove Ribber. Cast off using back stitch.

#### CABLE BANDS

#### Make 4.


Use main bed only.

Using the open edge cast on method and WY, cast on 14 sts in centre of machine and k several rows.

Change to B and k 5(5,6,3) rows.

Step One: Using the 3 x 1 transfer tool, transfer the 3 sts on the LHS of the centre 'O' over the 3 sts on the RHS to form cable. Step Two: K 10 rows.

Repeat these 2 steps 13(13,13,14) times



altogether. K 5 (5,6,3) rows. Cast off using back stitch.

#### LHS FRONT AND RHS BACK

(Work 2 pieces alike).

Use main bed only.
Using the open edge cast on method, cast on 30(32,34,36) sts with WY and k several rows using Keyplate 2. COR.

Change to MC

Step One: Dec 1 st at beg of next row.

Step Two: K 9 rows. COR.

Repeat these 2 steps 13 times altogether. Repeat Step One again. 16(18,20,22) sts.

K 3(5,5,7) rows. Cast off in back stitch.

#### RHS FRONT AND LHS BACK

(Work 2 pieces alike).

Work as for LHS Front and RHS Back but reverse shapings.

#### SLEEVES

(Work 2 pieces alike).

Use main bed only.

Using the open edge cast on method, cast on 54(54,58,58) sts with WY and k several rows using Keyplate 2. COR.

Change to MC and k 5 rows.

Step One: Inc 1 st at beg of next 2 rows.

Step Two: K 3 rows.

Repeat these 2 steps 20 times more. 96(96,100,100) sts. COR.

96(96,100,10 K 8 rows.

Cast off using back stitch.

#### TO MAKE UP AND RIBBING

With wrong sides facing, pin cable band to the shaped edge of both the LHS and RHS Fronts and Backs with cast off edge at shoulder. Back stitch into place. With wrong side facing, pin the cable edge of the RHS and LHS Fronts along the corresponding edges of the Front panel. Repeat for Back panel and back stitch into place.

#### **Back Ribbing**

Set machine up with Ribber then remove Ribber from brackets.

Thread MC through Ribber carriage and pull through plenty of slack yarn.

Thread through main carriage in the usual way.\*

With wrong side facing, plce the first row of loops not in WY back onto needles, placing 2 sts onto ev alt needle. 78(83,90,94) sts. Remove WY.

Hang weighted hem.

Using Keyplate 2, k 1 row. COL. Remove main carriage.

Place Ribber back onto brackets. Transfer sts for 1 x 1 rib.

Using Keyplate 1 on both beds, k 19 rows. Transfer rib sts back to main bed. Cast off in back stitch.

Work Front Ribbing to match.

#### Cuffs

Work as for Back Ribbing to \*

With wrong side of sleeve facing, place the first row of loops in MC back onto 40(40,44,44) needles, placing 2 sts onto one needle 14 times evenly along the row. Remove WY, Hang weighted hem.

Using Keyplate 2 k 1 row. COL. Remove main carriage and place Ribber back onto brackets.

Transfer sts for 1 x 1 rib.
Using Keyplate 1 on both beds, k 13 rows.
Transfer rib sts back to main bed.
Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

Join shoulder seams and edges of neckband. Turn neckband in half onto inside and slip stitch into place. Set in sleeves, placing edges 27(27,28,28) cms down from shoulder seam. Join side and sleeve seams.

#### BACK

Using the closed edge cast on method (See page 4 of Instruction Book), cast on 65(69,73,79,83,87,91,95,101,105) sts and work 14(14,14,14,16,16,16,20,20,20) rows in 1 x 1 rib, using Keyplate 2 on both beds. COR.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

Starting with the centre st, transfer this and then ev foll 10th st on RHS and LHS back onto Ribber.

Change to Keyplate 3 on both beds. K 46(50,54,64,66,68,68,78,82,82) rows. COR. Working from centre st on Ribber, transfer ev foll alt st on RHS and LHS onto Ribber for 1 x 1 rib.\*

Still using Keyplate 3 on both beds, k 34(36,38,40,50,50,52,58,58,60,) rows. COR.

Transfer all rib sts back to main bed.

Remove Ribber bed and cast off in back stitch.

#### FRONT

Work as for Back to \*
Still using Keyplate 3 on both beds, k
24(26,26,28,34,34,36,40,40,42) rows. COR.
Break yarn.

#### Shape Neck

Push the 28(30,32,35,36,38,40,41,44,46) sts on RHS on both beds to HP.

K several rows in WY on rem LHS sts and then remove them from needles. Keep the last 2 sts on LHS hooked on to main bed to keep weighted hem hanging level.

Push RHS sts back to WP.


Re-thread main yarn through carriage, COR. K 1 row. COL.

Cast off 3 sts at beg of next and the foll alt row. K 1 row.

Dec 1 st at beg of next and the 1(1,2,2,3,3,3,4,4,4) foll alt rows. COR. 20(22,22,25,26,28,30,30,33,35) sts. K 2(2,2,2,4,4,4,4,4,4) COR.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

## WITH RIBBED YOKE



Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

Leave 2 sts on RHS hooked on to main bed to keep weighted hem hanging level. Replace the LHS sts on WY back onto main

bed needles.

Transfer rib sts back onto Ribber. COR. Cast off 9(9,9,9,11,11,11,13,13,13) sts at

beg of next row. K 1 row. Cast off 3 sts at beg of next and the foll alt

row. K 1 row. Dec 1 st at beg of next and the 1(1,2,2,3,3,3,

Dec 1 st at beg of next and the 1(1,2,2,3,3,3,4,4,4) foll alt rows.

K 1(1,1,1,3,3,3,3,3,3) rows. COR. Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### SLEEVES

Using the closed edge cast on method, cast on 37(37,39,39, 41,41,43,45,45,47) sts and work 14(14,14,14,16,16,16,20,20,20) rows in 1 x 1 rib, using Keyplate 2 on both beds. COR.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

Starting with the centre st, transfer this and then ev foll 10th st on RHS and LHS back onto Ribber.

Change to Keyplate 3 on both beds. Step One: K 5(5,5,5,2,2,2,2,2,2) rows. Step Two: Inc 1 st at beg of next 2 rows.

Repeat these 2 steps 6(8,8,10,16,16,16,20, 20,21) times more, remembering to transfer every 10th st onto Ribber. 51(55,57,61,75, 75,77,87,87,91) sts.

K 7(3,9,5,16,16,16,10,10,6) rows without shaping, COR.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### NECKBAND

Using back stitch, join right shoulder seam. With wrong side facing (See Note ii), pick up 32(32,36,36,40,40,40,46,46,46) sts along back neck, pick up 14(14,18,18,22, 22,22, 24,24,24) sts along right side of neck, pick up 11(11,11,11,13,13,13,15,15,15) sts across centre front and pick up 14(14,18,18,22,22, 22,24,24,24) sts along left side of neck. 71(71,83,83,97,97,97,109,109,109) sts.

Re-hang weighted hem, with hem and sts in front of latches.


Attach Ribber and using Keyplate 2 on main bed. k 1 row. COL.

Transfer ev alternate st to Ribber for 1 x 1 rib. Use Keyplate 2 on both beds. K 16(16,16,16, 18,18,18,22,22,22) rows.


Using WY, k several rows and remove sts from needles.

#### TO MAKE UP

Join remaining shoulder seam and edges of neckband. Fold neckband in half towards inside and slip st into place through open row of loops. Set in sleeves, placing outside edges at beginning of 1 x 1 rib yoke on back and front. Join side and sleeve seams.

Lister Richmond 5 6 6 7 7 8 8 Tweed DK 50 gm balls 5 buttons

#### CARDIGAN

Lister Richmond 5 6 6 7 7 8 8 DK 50 gm balls 5 buttons

TENSION

Use Keyplate 2 in both beds to give 23 sts and 25½ rows to 10 cms (4") measured over 5 x 2 rib.

#### ABBREVIATIONS See inside front cover

NOTE

An extension kit is required for the 4th -7th sizes.

### CARDIGAN

#### BACK

Using the closed edge cast on method (See page 4 of Instruction Book), cast on 86 (93, 100, 107, 114, 121, 128) sts and work 14 (14, 14, 14, 20, 20, 20) rows in 1 x 1 rib, using Keyplate 1 on both beds. COR.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed.\* Starting from RHS, transfer the 5th and 6th

sts and then ev foll 6th and 7th sts back onto Ribber.

Change to Keyplate 2 on both beds. K 80 (84, 90, 94, 96, 96, 100) rows. COR.

#### Shape Armholes

Cast off 3 (3, 4, 5, 5, 5, 6) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Cast off 2 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

Dec 1 st at both ends of next and the 1 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) foll alt rows. 72 (75, 78, 83, 86, 93, 98) sts. K 37 (39, 43, 47, 53, 55, 57) rows. COR.

#### Shape Shoulders

Cast off 7 (7, 8, 8, 7, 7, 8) sts at beg of next 2

Cast off 7 (7, 7, 8, 6, 7, 8) sts at beg of next 2

Cast off 6 (7, 7, 8, 6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next 2

#### 5th, 6th and 7th sizes only

Cast offr (6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

#### All eizes

32 (33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38) sts.

Transfer rib sts back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### POCKET LININGS (2)

Use main bed only and Keyplate 2.
Using the closed edge cast on method, cast on 20 (20, 20, 21, 23, 24, 24) sts and k 30 (30, 30, 34, 34, 34, 34) rows using Keyplate 1. K several rows in WY and remove sts from

needles.

#### LEFT FRONT

Using the closed edge cast on method, cast on 48 (50, 54, 57, 59, 62, 64) sts and work as for Back to \*.

Starting from LHS, transfer the 4th and 5th sts and then ev foll 6th and 7th sts back onto Ribber

\*\* Change to Keyplate 2 on both beds. K 26 (26, 26, 30, 30, 30, 30) rows. COR.

#### Place Pocket

Transfer all rib sts back onto main bed and remove Ribber. Using a darning needle, thread the centre 20 (20, 20, 21, 23, 24, 24) sts onto a length of WY and remove from needles.

With wrong side facing, hook the 20 (20, 20, 21, 23, 24, 24) sts of pocket lining on to the empty needles and remove WY. Re-hang weighted hem, with hem and sts in front of latches.

Attach Ribber and transfer ev 6th and 7th sts back onto Ribber as before. K55 (59, 65, 65, 67, 67, 71) rows. COL.

#### Shape Armhole and 'V' Neck

Cast off 3 (3, 4, 5, 5, 5, 6) sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row. K 1 row.

Cast off 2 (3, 4, 4, 5, 5, 5) sts at beg and dec 1 st at end of next row. K 1 row.

Dec 1 st at both ends of the next and the 1 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3) foll alt rows. K 1 row. COL. 37 (36, 38, 40, 39, 42, 43) sts.

Dec 1 st at end (neck edge) of next and the 16 (11, 11, 8, 1, 0, 0) foll alt rows.

#### 2nd - 7th sizes only

K 3 rows.

Dec 1 st at end of next and the (2, 3, 6, 11, 12, 11) foll 4th rows.

#### All sizes

20 (21, 22, 24, 25, 28, 30) sts. K 3 (3, 3, 1, 1, 1, 7) rows. COL.

#### Shape Shoulder

Cast off 7 (7, 8, 8, 7, 7, 8) sts at beg of next row. K 1 row.

Cast off 7 (7, 7, 8, 6, 7, 8) sts at beg of next row. K 1 row.

#### 1st - 4th sizes only

Cast off rem 6(7, 7, 8) sts.

#### 5th-7th sizes only

Cast off (6, 7, 7) sts at beg of next row. K 1 row.

Cast off rem (6, 7, 7) sts.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Using the closed edge cast on method, cast on 48 (50, 54, 57, 59, 62, 64) sts and work as for Back to \*.

Starting from RHS, transfer the 4th and 5th sts and then ev foll 6th and 7th sts back onto Ribber

Now work as for Left Front from \*\*, working 1 row less before armhole shaping and reading COL for COR and COR for COL.

#### SLEEVES

Using the closed edge cast on method, cast on 38 (44, 44, 50, 54, 58, 62) sts and work as for Back to \*.

Starting with centre 2 sts, transfer these and then ev foll 6th and 7th sts on RHS and LHS back onto Ribber.

Change to Keyplate 2 on both beds. COR. K 4 rows.

Inc 1 st at both ends of next and the 17 foll 4th (4th, 4th, 5th, 5th, 5th, 5th) rows. 74 (80, 80, 86, 90, 94, 98) sts. K 13 (17, 21, 10, 10, 10, 12) rows. COR.

#### Shape Top

Cast off 3 (4, 4, 5, 6, 6, 7) sts at beg of next 2

Cast off 2 (3, 3, 4, 4, 4, 4) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

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Dec 1 st at both ends of the next 13 (13, 11, 9, 5, 3,1) rows. K 1 row.

Dec 1 st at both ends of next and the 6 (7, 9, 12, 17, 21, 24) foll alt rows. 24 sts. K 1 row. Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### **BUTTON AND BUTTONHOLE BANDS**

(A short hem or gripper weights is better than the long hem)

Using the closed edge cast on method, cast on 11 sts and work 4 (4, 3, 3, 4, 4, 4) rows in 1 x 1 rib, using Keyplate 1 on both beds.

\*Make buttonhole: Using a small length of WY, k 1 row manually on centre 3 sts and tuck ends of WY down between needle beds (the buttonhole is then finished off by hand, see inside front cover).

K 24 (25, 27, 29, 30, 30, 31) rows.

Repeat from \* 3 times more.

Make 1 more buttonhole then k 2 (2, 1, 1, 2, 2, 2) rows.

Place a marker at end of last row to indicate start of 'V' neck.

K 54 (58, 62, 66, 72, 74, 76) rows and place a marker to indicate left shoulder.

K 40 (40, 42, 42, 46, 46, 48) rows and place a

marker to indicate right shoulder. K 54 (58, 62, 66, 72, 74, 76) rows and place a marker to indicate end of 'V' neck.

K 102 (106, 112, 120, 126, 126, 130) rows. Transfer rib sts back to main bed.

Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### **POCKET TOPS**

With wrong side of work facing, hook the 20 (20, 20, 21, 23, 24, 24) sts of pocket opening back onto main bed needles and remove WY. Inc 1 st at both ends of row.

Hang weighted hem so that hem and sts are in front of latches.

Attach Ribber and using Keyplate 2 on main bed only, k 1 row.

Transfer sts for 1 x 1 rib. Change to Keyplate 1 on both beds.

K 9 rows, Transfer rib sts back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### TO MAKE UP

Slip stitch pocket linings into place and neatly attach edges of pocket tops. Join shoulder seams. Set in sleeves. Join side and sleeve seams.

\*\*\*Attach button and buttonhole band with buttonholes on left front and matching markers. To finish buttonholes, remove WY and back stitch first through the top row of open loops and then the bottom row. Attach buttons to correspond with buttonholes.

NOTE: To make a woman's version, just attach the band with buttonholes onto the Right Front.

#### WAISTCOAT

Work as for Cardigan for Back, Pocket Linings, Right and Left Fronts, Button and Buttonhole Band and Pocket Tops.

#### ARMBANDS (2)

Join both shoulder seams.


With wrong side facing, pick up 44 (46, 50, 52, 56, 60, 64) sts around both front and back armhole. 88 (92 100, 104, 112, 120, 128) sts. Hang weighted hem so that hem and sts are in front of latches. Attach Ribber. K 1 row using Keyplate 2 on main bed only. Transfer sts for 1 x 1 rib.



Push the 19 (22, 24, 26, 29, 32) sts on RHS on both beds to HP.

K several rows in WY on rm LHS sts and then remove them from needles. Keep the last 2 sts on LHS hooked on to main bed to keep weighted hem hanging level. Push RHS needles back to WP. Re-thread MC through carriage. COR.

Keeping continuity of pattern, k 1 row. COL. Dec 1 st at beg of next and the 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) foll alt rows. 13 (16, 18, 19, 22, 25) sts. COR. K 4 rows. Transfer all sts on Ribber back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

Leave 2 sts on RHS hooked on to main bed to keep weighted hem hanging level. Replace the LHS sts on WY back onto main bed needles. Transfer purl sts back onto Ribber. COR. Cast off 10 (12, 16, 16, 18, 20) sts at beg of next row. K 1 row.

Dec 1 st at beg of next and the 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6) foll alt rows. 13 (16, 18, 19, 22, 25) sts. COL. K 3 rows. Transfer all sts on Ribber back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### Ribbing

Work as for Back ribbing.

#### ARMBANDS

Each armband is worked in 2 halves - back and front.

With right side of Front facing, pick up and place onto main bed needles 33 (37, 45, 51, 57, 61) sts along armhole edge.

Now work as for Back ribbing from \*
Repeat for Back.

#### **SLEEVES**

Use main bed only.

Using the open-edge cast on method and Keyplate 4, cast on 32 (36, 38, 40, 44, 46) sts and k a few rows ending with COR. Change to MC and k 4 rows.

Inc 1 st at both ends of next and the 3 (3, 7, 11, 12, 13) foll 13th (13th, 8th, 5th, 5th, 5th) rows. 41 (45, 55, 65, 71, 75) sts.

K 8(20,11,16,15,14) rows without shaping. Cast off in back stitch.

#### Cuffs

With wrong side facing, place the first row of loops in MC back onto 22 (26, 28, 30, 34, 36) main bed needles, placing 2 sts onto 1 needle 10 times evenly across row. Now work as for Back Ribbing from \*.

#### Crew Neckband

Join right shoulder seam.

With wrong side facing, pick up and place onto main bed needles 22 (26, 28, 30, 32, 34) sts across back neck, 18 (18, 18, 22, 22, 22) sts along right side of neck, 10 (12, 16, 16, 18, 20) sts across centre front and 18 (18, 18, 22, 22, 22) sts along left side of neck, 68 (72, 80, 90, 94, 98) sts.

Re-hang weighted hem so that hem and sts are in front of latches.

Attach Ribber and k 1 row using Keyplate 4 on main bed.

Transfer sts for 1 x 1 rib. Using Keyplate 3 in both beds, k 17 (17, 19, 19, 21, 21) rows. COR. Transfer rib sts back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### **BUTTON-THROUGH COLLAR**

Instructions for 3rd, 4th and 5th sizes only. Join left shoulder seam.

Place a marker of WY 21/2" (6 cms) down from shoulder seam on left front edge.

#### Front Collar

With wrong side facing, pick up and place onto main bed needles (6, 10, 10) sts from WY marker along left side of neck, (18, 18, 20) sts across centre front and (22, 26, 26) sts along right side of neck. (46, 54, 56) sts. "Re-hang weighted hem so that hem and sts are in front of latches.

Attach Ribber and k 1 row using Keyplate 4 on main bed.

Transfer sts for 1 x 1 rib. \*\*

Using Keyplate 3 on both beds, k 13 rows in 1 x 1 rib.

Transfer rib sts back onto main bed.

Starting from RHS, transfer the 4th, 5th and 6th sts and then ev foll 4th, 5th and 6th sts back onto Ribber for 3 x 3 rib.

Change to Keyplate 4 in both beds. K (22, 26, 30) rows.

Transfer rib sts back onto main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch. Remove first WY marker and place a 2nd marker 1/4" (1 cm) down from shoulder seam on left front edge.

#### Back Collar

With wrong side facing, pick up and place onto main bed needles (42, 46, 50) sts from WY marker across back neck. Now work as for Front Collar from \* only transferring sts for 3 x 3 rib from LHS and not RHS.

#### **BUTTON BAND**

With right side of Back facing, pick up and put onto main bed needles (40, 43, 46) sts along LHS edge of back collar. Now work as for Front Collar from \* to \*\*. K 6 rows. Transfer rib sts back onto main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### **BUTTONHOLE BAND**

With right side of Front facing, pick up and put onto main bed needles (40, 43, 46) sts along RHS edge of Front Collar. Now work as for Front Collar from \* to \*\*. K 3 rows.

Make Buttonholes: Using a separate length of WY for each group of sts and starting from RHS, k 1 row manually over the 4th, 5th and 6th sts and over 3 sts following every (7, 8, 9) sts until there are 4 buttonholes is total. Tuck ends of WY down between needle beds (the buttonholes are then finished off by hand, see inside front cover) K 3 rows. Transfer rib sts back to main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

Sew buttonhole band to neck edge and attach button band neatly to neck edge on top of buttonhole band. To finish buttonholes, remove WY and back stitch first through the top row of open loops and then the bottom row. Attach buttons to correspond with button holes.

Join right shoulder seam and edges of collar, reversing seam for last (41/4, 43/4, 5) ins/(11, 12, 13) cms of collar to allow for turnback.

#### TO MAKE UP



Transfer rib sts back to main bed.\* Break yarn and remove Ribber. Re-thread yarn through usual carriage and using Keyplate 3, k 42 (46, 50, 56, 62, 62, 66, 66, 78, 78, 78) rows. COR.

#### Shape Armhole

Cast off 5 (5, 5, 5, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7, 7) sts at beg of next 2 rows, 48 (52, 56, 60, 64, 70, 72, 76, 80, 84, 86) sts. Break yarn.

Attach Ribber and re-thread yarn through Ribber carriage. Transfer all sts onto Ribber. Use Keyplate 3 on both beds. COR.

K 2 (3, 3, 5, 7, 7, 8, 8, 8, 8) rows. Transfer all sts back to main bed. K 1 row. Now work the 12 rows of pattern from chart, transferring sts as required.

Transfer all sts back to main bed. \*\*



#### COLLAR



Set in sleeves and join sides of sleeve to cast off edge of armhole. Join side and sleeve seams.

#### BACK

Using the open-edge cast on method and Keyplate 3, cast on 51 (55, 59) sts on main bed only and k a few rows in WY ending with COR

Attach Ribber and starting from RHS, transfer the 4th st and then ev foll 4th st onto Ribber. Thread MC through Ribber carriage and starting with COR, k 12 rows with Keyplate 3 on both beds. Transfer rib sts back onto main bed.

Starting from RHS, transfer the 2nd and then every foll 4th st onto Ribber and k 12 rows. Transfer rib sts back onto main bed.

These 24 rows form the pattern and are repeated throughout\*. K 112 (116, 120) rows more in pattern. Transfer rib sts back onto main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### RIGHT FRONT

Using the open-edge cast on method and Keyplate 3, cast on 43 (47, 51) sts and work as for Back to \*, K 52 (56, 60) rows more in pattern. COR.

#### Shape Neck

Keeping continuity of pattern, dec 1 st at RHS (neck edge) of next and the 17 foll 3rd rows. 25 (29, 33) sts. K 8 rows more without shaping. COR.

Transfer rib sts back onto main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### LEFT FRONT

Work as for Right Front, working one row more before commencement of neck shaping and then reading RHS and COR for LHS and COL.

#### SLEEVES

Using the open-edge cast on method and

Keyplate 3, cast on 59 (63, 67) sts on main bed only and k a few rows in WY ending with COR.

Attach Ribber and starting from RHS, transfer the 4th st and then every foll 4th st onto Ribber. Thread MC through Ribber carriage and starting with COR, work in pattern throughout as for Back, shaping as follows and working extra sts into pattern: K 2 rows. Inc 1 st at both ends of next and the 14 foll 3rd rows. 89 (93, 97) sts. K 2 rows. COL.

#### Divide for Cable

Using a small length of MC, cast off centre 11 sts and remove from needles. Push empty needles back to NWP. Push the 39 (41, 43) needles on RHS into HP. Using WY, k several rows on LHS sts then push these needles to HP. Push RHS needles back to WP and k several rows on these sts in WY. Now remove all sts from needles. Remove Ribber and weighted hem. Now work RHS of sleeve as follows: Place the sts of RHS on WY back onto the centre 39 (41, 43) needles and remove WY.

\*Re-hang weighted hem, with hem and sts infront of latches. Attach Ribber. Keeping continuity of pattern, transfer every 4th st back onto Ribber along with weighted hem. COR

Inc 1 st at RHS of next and the 6 foll 3rd rows. 46 (48,50) sts. COL. K 17 rows in pattern without shaping. Transfer rib sts back onto main bed.

Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch. Place the sts of LHS on WY back onto the centre 39 (41, 43) needles and remove WY. Now repeat from \* once more, reading COR and COL for COL and COR, and RHS and LHS for LHS and RHS.

#### Cuffs

With wrong side facing (See Note), place the open row of loops in MC, back onto 40 (44, 48) main bed needles, placing 2 sts onto one

needle 19 times evenly across the row.

\*Thread MC through Ribber carriage and pull through plenty of slack yarn. Thread yarn through usual carriage. Using Keyplate 3, k 1 row. Attach Ribber. COL. Transfer every alt st onto Ribber for 1 x 1 rib. Using Keyplate 2 on both beds, k 17 rows. Transfer rib sts back onto main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

#### TO MAKE UP AND CABLES

#### Centre Back Cable

Use main bed only.

Using the open-edge cast on method, cast on 14 sts and k a few rows in WY ending with COR. Change to A and using Keyplate 3, k 5 (4, 6) rows.

\*Using the transfer tools, make a cable by transferring the 3 sts on the LHS of the centre 'O' over the 3 sts on the RHS. K 8 rows. Ladder down the 4th st in from RHS and LHS and convert to rib using the latchet tool. Place sts back onto needles.\*\* Repeat from \* 18 (19, 19) times more. Make one more cable. K 5 (4, 6) rows more. Convert the 4th sts in from RHS and LHS to rib. Cast off.

Join one back piece to each side of cable with all WY edges at bottom.

#### **Back Ribbing**

With wrong side facing, place the open row of loops in MC and A, back onto 84 (92, 100) main bed needles, placing 2 sts onto one needle 32 times evenly across the row. Now work as for Cuffs from \*.

#### Right and Left Front Ribbing.

With wrong side facing, place the open row of loops in MC back onto 43 (47, 51) needles. Remove WY. Hang weighted hem so that hem and sts are infront of latches. Attach Ribber and transfer every alt st onto Ribber for 1 x 1 rib. Using Keyplate 2 on both beds and MC, k 17 rows. Transfer rib sts back onto

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main bed. Remove Ribber and cast off in back stitch.

Join Back and Fronts together at shoulder seam.

#### Sleeve Cable

(Make 2 pieces alike) Use main bed only.

Using the closed-edge cast on method and A, cast on 14 sts and k 5 rows using keyplate 3. Now repeat as for Centre Back Cable from \* to \*\* 4 times. Make one more cable. K 5 rows. Convert the 4th sts in from RHS and LHS to rib. Cast off.

Back stitch sleeve cable into gap at top of sleeve. Set in sleeves, placing centre of sleeve at shoulder seam and edges 24 (25, 26) cms down on Back and Front. Join side and sleeve seams.

#### Front and Neck Border Cable

Use main bed only.

Using the closed-edge cast on method and A, cast on 14 sts and k 4 (8, 4) rows using Keyplate 3. Now repeat as for Centre Back Cable from \* to \*\* 13 (13, 14) times. Place a WY marker at end of last row to indicate start of "V" neek.

Repeat from \* to \*\* 10 times more. Place a WY marker at end of last row to indicate right shoulder.

Repeat from \* to \*\* 7 times more. Place a WY marker at end of last row to indicate left shoulder.

Repeat from \* to \*\* 10 times more. Place a WY marker at end of last row to indicate end of 'V' neck

Repeat from \* to \*\* 13 (13, 14) times more. Make one more cable. K 4 (8, 4) rows. Convert the 4th sts in from RHS and LHS to rib.

Cast off.

With right sides together, back stitch cable band around Front and neck edge, matching markers.

#### SKIRT

(Make 4 pieces alike)

Thread MC through Ribber carriage and pull through plenty of slack yarn. Thread through usual carriage. Using the closed-edge cast on method, cast on 51 (55, 59) sts on main bed. Hang weighted hem. K 1 row using Keyplate 2. Attach Ribber and transfer the 4th and then every foll 4th st onto Ribber. Using Keyplate 3 on both beds, k 150 rows. K several rows in WY and remove sts from needles.

#### Centre Back and Front Cables

(Make 2 pieces alike)

Use main bed only.

Using the closed-edge cast on method and A, cast on 14 sts and k 4 rows using keyplate 3. Now repeat as for Centre Back Cable of Jacket from \* to \*\* 19 times. Make one more cable.

K 2 rows. Convert the 4th sts in from RHS and LHS to rib. K several rows in WY and remove sts from needles.

Join one skirt piece to each side of centre Front and Back cable with WY edges at top.

#### Waistband

Worked in 2 pieces.







Pull Ribber bed down so that it rests on the top of the metal clamps. Using the hook tool, pick up the centre stitch on each of the rib stitch sections from the 4th row (8 rows down) and place back onto needle.

Row 13 - 16: As rows 7 - 10.


These 16 rows form the pattern.



## DIAGONAL MOCK CABLE


This is a 6 stitch repeat.

Rows 1 - 4: Transfer the 1st and 2nd stitches and then every following 5th and 6th stitches Main bed onto Ribber bed as below.



Rows 5 - 8: Transfer all rib stitches back onto main bed. Transfer the 5th and 6th stitches and then every following 5th and 6th stitches onto Ribber bed as below.




Rows 9 - 12: Transfer all rib stitches back onto main bed. Transfer the 3rd and 4th stitches and then every following 5th and 6th stitches onto Ribber bed

These 12 rows for the pattern and are repeated throughout.




### FISHERMAN'S RIB

Set up Ribber with stitches transferred for 1 x 1 rib.

Row 1: Push main bed needles to Holding Position and knit row from right to left

Row 2: Push main bed needles back into Working Position and knit row from left to right.

Repeat these two rows throughout.



## **DROP STITCH RIB**


This is an 8 stitch repeat.

Transfer the 1st and 2nd stitches and then every following 3rd and 4th stitches onto Ribber bed.

Rows 1 - 6: Bring forward to Working
Position the needle on the
main bed which lies between
the second set of rib stitches
and then every following
alternate set, making sure

the latch is open.


